Today's Game: The Sounds and Jumbo Shrimp continue their six-game set this afternoon at 121 Financial Ballpark in downtown Jacksonville. Last night, Brewer Hicklen crushed two home runs, Eric Haase added another and the Sounds took a convincing 12-2 win in the series opener. Right-hander Taylor Clarke will make his second appearance as an opener on MLB rehab assignment today. Chad Patrick, today's scheduled starter, will follow. Left-hander Kent Emanuel will get the ball for Jacksonville.

Taylor Clarke: The 31-year-old makes his second appearance and second start as an opener on MLB rehab assignment. This is his second outing in the Brewers organization after Milwaukee traded for him on December 14, 2023 in exchange for former Sounds shortstop Cam Devanney along with right-handed pitcher Ryan Brady. He allowed a run in his one inning on the mound, a solo shot hit by rehabbing Tampa Bay infielder Jonathan Aranda on Sunday at Durham. Clarke was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 25, 2024 with a right meniscus tear after making three appearances with Milwaukee in big-league spring training. He underwent surgery on March 30. Clarke went 3-6 with a 5.95 ERA (59.0 IP/39 ER) across 58 appearances (2 starts) with the Royals in 2023. He made the second-most appearances by Kansas City relievers and worked the seventh-most innings. Clarke is married and his wife's name is also Taylor...the couple has twin boys and a daughter. He was born with right-side facial paralysis, a weakness of the muscles that can cause some of his speech to be slurred. Clarke was originally selected by the Diamondbacks in the third round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

Kent Emanuel: The 31-year-old makes his sixth appearance and second start with Jacksonville this season. He's 0-1 with a 2.76 ERA (16.1 IP/5 ER) with the Jumbo Shrimp. He's also made two appearances with Miami - on April 3 vs. Los Angeles-AL (3.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 2 K) and on April 27 vs. Washington (3.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 0 BB, 2 K). Emanuel was signed as a free agent by Miami on February 7 to a minor league deal. He spent the 2023 season in the Pirates organization, pitching mostly with Triple-A Indianapolis. He also went 2-2 with a 2.37 ERA (49.1 IP/13 ER) in 10 starts with Lehigh Valley in 2022. Emanuel made his MLB debut with the Astros in 2021, going 1-0 with a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP/5 ER) in 10 appearances with the American League champions. He was originally drafted by Houston in the 2013 First-Year Player Draft in the third round out of the University of North Carolina.

Celebrate with a Brew: Brewer Hicklen broke out of his five game hitless skid in a big way, hitting a pair of homers with a career-high six RBI in the 12-2 win over Jacksonville last night. Hicklen is the only Sound to have multiple two home run games this season - he hit a pair of long balls in the series opener at Durham on May 7. It was the first six RBI performance by a Sound this season - the last to have six RBI in a game was Chris Roller at Charlotte on September 15, 2023. Though he did not have a stolen base last night, he is tied for second in the league with 17 stolen bases. He's also tied for seventh in runs scored with 29. Over his last eight games, the Huntsville, Alabama native has five home runs and 12 RBI.

Power Surge: Since the previous series began on May 7, the Sounds have hit 10 home runs over the past seven games - that's tied for the sixth most in the league in that span. Prior to the road trip, the Sounds had just 23 home runs as a team through May 5, the third lowest total in the league. Over 30 percent of the club's 2024 home run total have been hit on this road trip.

My Cousin Vinny: Vinny Capra logged four singles and scored three times in the 12-2 blowout win. He's the first Sounds hitter to have four hits in a game this season - it also was a new career high for the infielder. It was Capra's 10th multi-hit game in 2024 - he is one of five Sounds with a double-digit total of multi-hit games.

Battle of the Tylers: Tyler Woessner outdueled Jacksonville starter Kyle Tyler, getting his first win at the Triple-A level. The right-hander from Arizona struck out nine Jumbo Shrimp (career high) in a quality start, holding Jacksonville to a couple hits and one run in six innings. The quality start was the seventh of the season by a Sounds hurler. Woessner also turned in a quality start in his first outing of the season on April 7 with Biloxi vs. Montgomery.

Rob Z: Rob Zastryzny continued to dominate hitters out of the bullpen after working a scoreless sixth inning against his former team last night. Zastryzny has 10 scoreless appearances of at least three outs recorded on the season. Among relievers who have pitched at least 16 innings this Triple-A season, Zastryzny has the lowest WHIP (0.49) and highest strikeout to walk ratio (24.00).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 702-604 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,294-2,124 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

LAST OUTING: Patrick tossed his third quality start of the season on May 9 at Durham. Giving up one run (earned) on four hits, two hit batsmen and a walk, he struck out five on 92 pitches (56 strikes). Patrick is the first Sounds pitcher to reach three quality starts this season - he has not received a decision in any of them.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's first start against Jacksonville.
