RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (30-14) **Stockton Ports (22-22)**





LHP Sterling Patick (0-1, 6.50 ERA) vs. RHP Donny Troconis (3-0, 1.51 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their longest road trip of the year, as they take on the Stockton Ports (ATH) in the final game of a six-game set and game six of a 12-game, 13-day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the last of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the final of 12 at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes have dropped seven of 11 in Stockton in 2025, but after winning five of six at home, are now 9-8 against Stockton in 2025. In 2024, Rancho went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 in Stockton.

LAST GAME: Jaron Elkins enjoyed a career-night and Christian Zazueta fired scoreless baseball in Rancho's 9-2 win over the Stockton Ports on Saturday night at Banner Island Ballpark. Elkins had four hits and five RBIs, while Zazueta (5-1) scattered five hits, while striking out seven over 5.2 innings in the win. Stockton starter Jose Dicochea (3-4) took the loss, allowing three runs over just two innings. The win gives Rancho a shot at a six-game series-split on Sunday. **SERIES STUFF:** Friday's loss snapped a streak of five straight series-wins for Rancho, but a win today would prevent

them from losing just their second series of the year. Rancho's series record is 6-1-0 with the only loss coming in Stockton on their opening road trip of 2025, when they dropped four of six to the Ports.

DON'T WALK: Things were much better on Saturday, but Rancho pitching has struggled overall in this series, allowing 30 runs on 30 hits with 42 walks over the first 33 innings pitched. Last night, the Quakes issued just one walk until the ninth, when four Stockton batters received free passes, giving the Quakes 47 walks issued over 42 innings. The Quakes now have an ERA of 3.64, second behind San Jose's 3.45. 238 walks is now third most in the league.

OH, WHAT A NIGHT!?!: Jaron Elkins had a night to remember on Saturday, tying multiple career-marks. The first-year player had four hits for the second time in his career, five RBIs for the second time in his career and four runs scored for the second time. In addition, he enjoyed his first two-homer game and his first career grand slam. He also walked and stole two bases for good measure. He's now hitting .338 in the month of May, with 4 homers and 21 RBIs. UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY: The Quakes ended their two-game skid on Thursday night, avoiding tying their longest losing streak of the year. Consecutive losses to open this Stockton series was the first time Rancho had lost two straight since they dropped back-to-back games against San Jose on April 17-18. The Quakes have only had three losing streaks this season, two two-game streaks and their longest of the year, a three-game losing streak here in Stockton back in April. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history.

STERLING PATICK: 19-year-old Sterling Patick makes his fourth start and eighth appearance and fourth against the Ports. Patick started Tuesday's series-opener and allowed one run on four hits over two innings in a no-decision. In three games (two starts) against Stockton this year, Patick is 0-1 with a 7.88 ERA, allowing seven earned runs on 10 hits. Patick was a 2023 18th-round selection for the Dodgers out of South Hills High School in West Covina. **DONNY TROCONIS**: 19-year-old righty Donny Troconis makes his ninth appearance and seventh start overall, his fourth appearance and third start against the Quakes. In three games against Rancho, he's 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA, allowing three runs on six hits over 13.1 innings. In his last appearance overall, he allowed three runs on three hits over 4.1 innings in a no-decision on Tuesday. Troconis has only been scored upon in one outing this year, in a May 8th game where he gave up four runs at Inland Empire. Troconis signed with the Athletics in January of 2023 out of Venezuela. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
