LAST TIME OUT

The Pelicans won their second-straight game against Charleston on Saturday night 5-1. It was the pitching that was the highlight for Myrtle Beach as five different arms collected a season high 13 strikeouts, including RHP Scott Kobos, who struck out five of the six batters he faced. Luis Verdugo led the team offensively with a 2-4 night including a double and a team-leading two RBI's.

KING OF THE HILL

In the first five games, OF **Darius Hill** has gone 8-24 (.333), with a double and five RBIs. Last night marked the fourth time in the first five games that Hill has collected at least one RBI

KKKKKUBUC

The Coastal Carolina alumnus Scott Kobos had the most impressive pitching performance last night, as he entered the game with two runners on base and nobody out in the bottom of the sixth. Kobos struck out the next three batters, and collected two more the next inning to put down five of the six batters he faced on the strikeout. Kobos now has seven K's on the year which leads the team.

BUDDY'S BACK

A familar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2021 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his second stint in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18, and will be coaching his 15th season in the Cubs organization. During his first three years with the Pelicans, Bailey recorded 216 wins, three half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,140. 2021 will be his 33rd season as a minor league manager.

A NEW ERA

After competing in the former Carolina League since the club's founding in 1999, the Myrtle Beach Pelicans will join the Low-A East, South Division for the 2021 season. The move is apart of a larger restructuring of Minor League Baseball that saw a downsizing from 160 total teams to 120. The Pelicans will remain an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs for the seventh season.

TOP CUBBIE

Highlighting the Pelicans' roster in 2021 is the Cubs' first-round draft pick **Ed Howard**. Howard was the first

shortstop taken in the five-round 2020 MLB draft as the Cubs selected him 16th overall. The Chicaco native was ranked as the fourth-best prospect in the Cubs system by Baseball America and fifth on MLB's Cubs 2021 Prospect Rankings despite his lack of professional experience. Howard was put on the national stage when playing for the Jackie Robinson West team that reached the 2014 Little League World Series. Known for his defense, Howard will join the Pelicans this summer after graduating from Mt. Carmel High School in 2020.

I'LL TRADE YOU THIS

As a key piece in the trade that sent four-time MLB All-Star starting pitcher Yu Darvish from the Cubs to the Padres in December, shortstop **Yeison Santana** will begin his tenure with the Cubs organization in Myrtle Beach. The Dominican Republic product batted .346 with 30 RBIs in the 2019 season with the Padres' Arizona League team.

I LOVE COLLEGE

The roster also features talent from some of the best college baseball programs in the country, as seven Power-5 schools are represented throughout the club. The Pelicans will have two-former members of the Big 12 in infielder Ryan Reynolds (Texas) and outfielder Darius Hill (West Virginia). Hill was a two-time All-Big 12 Second Team member in 2016 and 2018. Two members of the ACC will also join the Pelicans as left-handed pitcher Adam Laskey (Duke) and infielder Grayson Byrd (Clemson) will bring their talents to Myrtle Beach. The Big Ten will send two players to the beach as 2019 All-Big Ten First Team outfielder **Jordan Nwogu** will trade out the maze and blue of the University of Michigan for the Pelicans blue and gold, and right-handed pitcher Sam Thoresen (Minnesota) will also help out the pitching staff. Nwogu was the third-round selection for the Cubs in the 2020 draft. **Jake Reindl** (Arkansas) comes out of the SEC where he pitched for the Razorbacks from 2016-18.

PELICAN POINTS

The opening series against the RiverDogs is the first regular-season series played between the two-South Carolina teams. They met for the "Battle of the Beaches" exhibition series from 2017-2019.

The Pelicans' home-opener is slated for May 11th against the Augusta GreenJackets at 7:05 PM.

- Pelicans opening night starter on 5/4/21
- Espinoza was signed as an international free agent on July 31, 2017.
- -The 20-year-old spent did not play in 2018, but joined the Cubs Arizona League roster in 2019. He went 5-2, in 11 appearances with seven starts.
- -The Mexico-native ended 2019 with a 2.49 ERA over 47 innings pitched, giving up just one home run and nine walks during that time.
- Many players were kept away from game competition in 2020, but Espinoza went back to his hometown to play for Tomateros De Culiacan in the Mexican Pacific League during the pandemicridden year.
- -He started four games with a 3.93 ERA, 4-4 record, 1 HR allowed, 4 BB, and 16 SO over 18.1 IP

2019 SEASON

- -The righty started his tenure in the Cubs' organization strong with an impressive 2019 season in the Arizona League.
- In Espinoza's first start, he went five innings giving up just three hits and zero earned runs. He struck out three and didn't walk any against the AZL Diamondbacks.
- He collected a career-high eight strikeouts on 8/2/19 against the AZL Angels in a four inning start.
- Espinoza would finish with a 5-2 record and a 2.49 ERA over 47 innings pitched. The most impressive number was his strikeout to walk ratio, which stood at 4:1.
