Tonight's Game: The Sounds play the Tides in game three of the six-game series tonight. Norfolk has taken the first two in fairly convincing fashion, having outscored Nashville 18-8. Right-hander Tyler Woessner makes his Triple-A debut tonight for the Sounds. He'll go up against Norfolk right-hander Justin Armbruster.

Tyler Woessner: The 24-year-old makes his Triple-A debut tonight. He was promoted to Nashville from Biloxi earlier in the day after making four starts with the Shuckers this season. Woessner boasts a 2.66 ERA (20.1 IP/6 ER) with an 0-1 record. At the time of his promotion, Woessner was tied for second in the Southern League with 29 strikeouts. He last pitched on April 25 at Pensacola and took the loss, his only decision of the season. He struck out eight over 5.1 innings while allowing four runs (3 ER) on six hits and two walks. In 2023, Woessner led the Midwest League with 112 strikeouts and innings pitched (121.0) and tied for third in starts with the High-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. He made four appearances (3 starts) in his first professional season in 2022. Woessner attended Central Arizona College where he helped lead them to an NJCAA Division 1 title his senior year. He was selected in the sixth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft by the Brewers.

Justin Armbruster: The 25-year-old makes his fifth start and sixth appearance with Norfolk this season. He's 0-2 with an 8.38 ERA (19.1 IP/18 ER). Armbruster last worked in relief on April 26 vs. Gwinnett, tossing four scoreless innings while allowing a hit and three walks. He fanned six Strippers and totaled 63 pitches (38 strikes). Armbruster followed Kyle Bradish in his start, who was on rehab assignment. Armbruster made his Triple-A debut against the Sounds on June 22, 2023, in game two of a doubleheader at First Horizon Park. He took the win, holding Nashville hitters to a couple of hits in five scoreless innings. Armbruster is one of the many prospects on the Tides roster, checking in at No. 20 on the Orioles' MLB Pipeline prospect list. He was selected in the 12th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft by Baltimore out of the University of New Mexico.

Roster Moves: In addition to Tyler Woessner getting called up to Triple-A, Owen Miller has reported after being optioned by the Brewers on Tuesday. Miller began the season with Nashville before getting called up to Milwaukee on April 16. In his two weeks with the Brewers, the infielder hit .083 (1-for-12) in limited action (7 games). He also made his pitching debut, allowing four runs in what was already a blowout against the Yankees on April 27. At the time of his callup from Triple-A, Miller was one of the hottest hitters in the Sounds lineup, boasting a .353 average (18-for-51). He's still on a nine-game hitting streak and 13-game on-base streak. Catcher Eric Haase is currently on the Milwaukee taxi squad - while technically still on the Sounds roster, he does not count towards the 28 active players.

Soup's On: Noah Campbell walked in his first plate appearance last night to extend his on-base streak to 20 games in the minors this season. Campbell is batting .309 (17-for-55) with three doubles, two triples, six RBI, 16 walks and seven runs scored. His 20-game on-base streak is tied for the longest active streak in minor league baseball - Mike Ford of Louisville and Tayden Hall of Single-A Carolina also have streaks of 20 games.

Awesome Ashby: Aaron Ashby pitched his best outing of the season last night in a no-decision. The southpaw fanned six Tides across five one-run innings in his sixth outing of 2024. He worked around four walks and gave up just a couple hits. Ashby's outing was the second by a Sounds starter to allow two hits or less in 5.0 innings or more, with the other being Chad Patrick's quality start on April 19 vs. Omaha (6 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 4 K). It was the first time Ashby had a start of five innings with two hits or less since tossing 5.2 one-run innings with Milwaukee at Pittsburgh on April 27, 2022.

Franky Files: Francisco Mejia added two more RBI last night, adding two singles in the loss. He's logged multiple RBI in each of his past three games and at least one in the last four. His four-game RBI streak is tied for the fourth-longest in the league - it's also his first four-game RBI streak since June 27-30, 2018 with Columbus.

Big Z: Reliever Rob Zastryzny worked another scoreless inning with a 1-2-3 ninth inning last night, adding a strikeout. After allowing runs in both of his outings in Louisville, Zastryzny has now not allowed a run in nine appearances. His 0.35 WHIP through 11.1 innings is the lowest WHIP for pitchers who have worked at least 7.0 innings at the Triple-A level.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 696-599 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,288-2,119 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).
