

**ABOUT SUNDAY AFTERNOON:** The Cyclones dropped the series finale with the Winston-Salem at Maimonides Park, leaving 10 men on base in a 5-2 defeat at the hands of the Dash. OF **Matt Rudick** crushed his third home run with Brooklyn and INF **Shervyen Newton** went 1-for-3 with a sacrifice fly. Winston-Salem INF **Bryan Ramos**, Chicago's No. 8 prospect, drove in two runs and scored two more, salvaging a series split. Brooklyn starter RHP **Luis Moreno** lasted just three innings, throwing 50 pitches and allowing one run.

**DIVISION ON THE LINE:** Including today, the Cyclones have 30 games remaining and five series: six at Wilmington, six vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League.

**MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN:** The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn leads the North Division with a +24 run differential and leads Hudson Valley by a half game heading into Tuesday. The Cyclones have allowed just 126 runs over 36 games (3.5 runs/ game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.3 runs per game in the second half.

**PROMOTIONS:** C/INF **Nic Gaddis** and OF **Rowdey Jordan** were both promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Monday. Gaddis, the Mets' 16th round selection in 2019 earned his second promotion to Double-A, while Jordan, New York's 11th round pick in 2021, leaps up to Double-A for the first time.

HELP IS ON THE WAY, DEARY: Three players were promoted from Low-A St. Lucie to High-A Brooklyn ahead of this week in Delaware. No. 25 Mets prospect RHP Christian Scott, INF William Lugo, and

RHP Jeffrey Colon have all been added to the roster.

**PEROZA PRODUCING:** Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .659 over his past 22 games with an eight-game hitting streak. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 20 of the past 22 games, hitting .304 with a .391 OBP.

**RA-RA RAMIREZ:** No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks second in the Mets organization with 105 hits behind Triple-A INF **Brett Baty** who has 106. The 19-year-old Dominican leads the organization with seven triples.

**CLONES FLEXING THEIR MUSCLES:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 56 home runs in the past 68 games (0.8 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).

**PROSPECT POP:** Brooklyn is home to eight of the Mets Top 30 prospects. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, No. 21 prospect RHP **Mike Vasil** and No. 25 prospect RHP **Christian Scott**.

**RETURN:** The Mexican right-hander was on the injured list, keeping him from games between June 18-July 22. Rojas was injured on June 17 at Wilmington and returned July 23 at Jersey Shore.

**GB RATE:** Rojas has a 46.6% ground ball rate, the highest since 2018. This year, Rojas' fly-ball rate is 25%. Last season, Rojas' ground ball rate was 35.6% and his fly ball rate was 37.9%. The reduction in fly ball has meant a reduction "indicates relief appearance in home runs. Last year, Rojas allowed 18% of his fly balls to leave the yard, while just 8% of his fly balls have left the yard this season.

OSCAR THE GROUCH: Rojas' 2021 campaign with Low-A St. Lucie was impressive, collecting two shutouts and three complete games with the Baby Mets.

METS CAREER: Rojas has pitched 41 times over a Mets minor league career that began in 2017. The Mexican missed 2019 due to injury, but pitched in the Mexican Winter League the following season -- during the 2020 shutdown of the Minor League season -- tossing 35.1 innings over 13 appearances for Guasave.
