SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 5-0. The game was completed early after five innings due to rain. Bowie scored all five runs in the third inning, including a grand slam by Billy Cook. Parker Dunshee threw two scoreless relief innings. Marco Luciano and Brandon Martorano had Richmond's only two hits.

TUDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This is the third series between the two teams this season and the second on City Island. The Senators won four-of-six in Harrisburg from April 11-16. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six at The Diamond from June 20-25. The two teams will meet for a six-game series at The Diamond from August 15-20.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 14-5 in their last 19 games since June 18 but dropped their last three games in last week's series against the Baysox. They went 14-2 from June 18-July 6, including taking five-of-six in series against Harrisburg and Reading, prior to losing their last three games. In their last 19 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .250 (150-for-599) with 22 homers, 28 doubles and have score 98 runs. In that same span, the Richmond pitching staff has combined or a league-best .280 ERA (53 ER/165.0 IP) with 217 strikeouts. Over the last 25 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a .2.85 ERA (27 ER/85.1 IP) and have allowed five home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.69 ERA is the best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 286.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 4111 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.17 ERA, which is second-lowest in Double-A and the fifth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

**THE SENATORS** lost five-of-six at Akron heading into the All-Star Break. After opening the second half 3-0, they have gone 2-7 in their last nine games. This year, the Senators are tied for 10th in the Eastern League in batting average (.230) and have scored th fewest runs (350) in the circuit. Harrisburg's roster includes seven players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF James Wood (No. 1, No. 4 overall), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 2), RHP Cole Henry (No. 13), 3B Trey Lipscomb (No. 17), HJP Mitchell Parker (No. 24), LHP Dustin Searz (No. 26) and OF Jacob Young (No. 27). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes Wood (No. 1), Hassell (No. 5), Henry (No. 12), Lipscomb (No. 18) and Parker (No. 22). Wood is rated as MLB. com's No. 5 prospect and Hassell is rated No. 95.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his 16th start of the season and his third against the Senators. He last pitched on Saturday at The Diamond against the Baysox and allowed four runs over two innings, the most runs he has allowed in his last seven starts since June 4. He made his first start of the year at Harrisburg on April 12 and surrendered four runs over our innings. Murphy last faced the Senators on June 22 in Richmond and allowed three runs over 2.2 innings. This year, he is O-1 with an 8.10 ERA against Harrisburg. Over his last seven starts since June 4. He made his first start of the year at Harrisburg on April 12 and surrendered four runs over our innings. Murphy last faced the Senators on June 22 in Richmond and allowed three runs over 2.2 innings. This year, he is O-1 with an 8.10 ERA against Harrisburg. Over his last seven starts since June 4. Murphy has gone 0-3 with a 3.75 ERA (10 ER/24.1 IP). Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the high-est-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 27 Giants prospect and No. 25 by MLB.com. *For more on Murphy, see page two*.

by MLB.com. For more on murphy, see page two. FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Alex Troop makes his 16th start of the season and his fifth against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Troop threw seven scoreless innings and struck out seven in a no-decision at Akron last Friday. He also made his season debut against the Flying Squirrels on April 11 at FNB Field and allowed five runs (four earned) over 3.1 innings. In his second start of that series on April 16, he pitched five innings and allowed three runs against Richmond. He made two starts at The Diamond in the last series between these two teams. On June 20, he worked five scoreless inning and allowed one hit with a season-high 10 strikeouts. In the series finale on June 25, he surrendered four runs and a season-high nine hits over five innings in a loss. In his career, Troop has pitched eight games (six starts) against Richmond, combining to go 1-2 with a 5.10 ERA (17 ER/30.0 IP/40 SO/13 BB). Troop was selected by the Nationals in the ninth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Michigan State. He first reached Double-A in 2021 for four relief outings and pitched 28 games for the Senators in 2022, going 7-5 with a 4.81 ERA. Today marks his 48th Double-A appearance and his 33rd start, totaling a 10-12 record with a 4.42 ERA.

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** Last Friday, **Wade Meckler** went 0-for-4, snapping his 24-game on-base streak. It was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also saw his 11-game run scored streak end, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 200 PA) in batting average (.398), ranks second in wRC+ (178) and BABIP (.447) and is tied for fourth in OBP (.466). He leads the Eastern League (min. 100 PA) in on-base percentage (.445) and is second in batting average (.353).

VAUN GONE WILD: Vaun Brown saw his 11-game hitting streak end on Saturday night, one game shy of matching Carter Williams (12 games) for the longest hit streak by a Richmond player this season. It was also the longest active hit streak in the Eastern League. In his last 13 games, Brown is batting .315 (17-for-54) with five homers, four doubles, 16 RBIs, 10 runs scored and no walks. Brown homered in back-to-back games on June 28 and 29 at Reading, totaling six RBIs in the two games. He homered twice last series against the Baysox.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base in 18 consecutive games dating back to June 18, which is the second-longest active streak in the Eastern League. For that stretch, he is batting .290 (18-for-62) with six doubles, two homers and 11 RBIs, adding nine walks. He is batting .296 (8-for-27) with two RBIs since the calendar flipped to July. Matheny also hit solo homers in back-to-back games on Tuesday and Wednesday to begin this week's series. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 104 walks, which is tied for the fourth-most in franchise history with Skyler Stromsmoe (2010-11, '13-15). His .362 career on-base percentage is tied for the third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 600 PA).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas has picked up 13 RBIs over his last 12 games since June 24. From June 24-29, he collected nine RBIs over a four-game span, including a two-run homer on June 29 at Reading. In his last 12 games, Thomas is batting .326 (14-for-43) with two homers, three doubles, a triple and 13 RBIs. For the season, he leads the Flying Squirrels with 40 RBIs.

**LOVE LUCI:** In his last 13 games since June 23, **Marco Luciano** is batting .333 (15-for-45) with two homers, five doubles, seven RBIs and 11 runs scored. On June 24, he tied his career high in hits, going 4-for-4. On July 4, he hit his 11th Double-A homer, a solo shot in the eighth inning.

**DLD FRIENDS:** Harrisburg's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels players. First baseman Frankie Tostado was selected by the Mariners in the minor-league phase of December's Rule 5 Draft and later traded to the Nationals. In 2021 and 2022, Tostado played 177 games for the Flying Squirrels, batting .264 with 104 RBIs. His 25 career homers with Richmond are tied for fifth-most in a career in franchise history. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** joined the Senators after being signed by the Nationals as a free agent on July 1. He spent parts of three seasons with Richmond (2018, 2021, 2021), going 4-2 with a 245 ERA and 16 saves in his 64 appearances. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Ruotolo worked the ninth in the Flying Squirrels' first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history. Other former Flying Squirrels playing in the Eastern League this year include outfielder Diego Rincones (2021-22) with Series and pitcher Matt Seelinger (2021) with Reading.

THE FUTURE IS NUW: Flying Squirrels pitcher Carson Whisenhunt worked a scoreless third inning in Saturday night's SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Seattle's T-Mobile Park. In his outing, he struck out Mariners prospect Jonatan Clase and Orioles prospect Jackson Holliday before surrendering a single to Baltimore's Heston Kjerstad, who was stranded after a groundout by Angels minor leaguer Edgar Quero. Whisenhunt and former Flying Squirrels pitcher Kyle Harrison were selected to represent the Giants. Harrison pitched in last year's Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Former Flying Squirrels pitcher Dan Otero was a member of the National League team's coaching staff. Whisenhunt was the sixth player to participate in the Futures Game as a member of the Flying Squirrels, including Tommy Joseph (2012), Tyler Beede (2015), Shaun Anderson (2018), Heliot Ramos (2021) and Harrison (2022). Other players who were selected for the Futures Game before or after playing in Richmond include Collin Balester (2017), Gary Brown (2011), Kyle Crick (2013), Jorge Guzman (2018), Kieran Lovegrove (2018), Luis Alexander Basabe (2018), Joeg Bart (2019). Marco Luciano (2019) and David Villar (2022). Ramos also went to the Futures Game toic (2018 and 2019) before being selected a third time as a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021. Villar was picked in 2022 but was not eligible because he was in the majors at the time.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 2), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America's the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
