Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the fourth game of a season-ending six-game series against the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, the 225th all-time meeting between the two teams. The Lugnuts are 8-13 vs. the Captains this season and 1-7 in games played at Classic Auto Group Park, losing four of five games in Eastlake in April before winning four of seven games in Lansing in May, splitting a six-game series in July, and dropping the first three games of the current series.

Yesterday: Captains 4, Lugnuts 0. Aaron Davenport and Jake Miller combined on a six-hit shutout, Cooper Ingle and Jake Fox hit RBI doubles, and Chase DeLauter launched a two-run homer to spur a Captains shutout effort on Thursday night for Lake County's third consecutive victory in the series.

**Starting Matchup:** 20-year-old right-hander **Luis Morales**, the Athletics' No. 2 pitching prospect, makes his second Midwest League start. Lake County counters with former Michigan Wolverines ace lefty **Steven Hajjar**, who first faced Lansing last year as a member of the Dayton Dragons.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler calls the action on StreamGuys while Logan Potosky has the call on Bally Live and MiLB.TV.

### Lug•Notes

Sizzling at the Plate: SS Euribiel Ángeles has collected 12 hits in his last 27 at-bats, while 1B Brennan Milone has 13 hits in his last 26 at-bats. Milone has gone 2-for-3 with a single and a double in each of the last two games.

Transaction: INF Casey Yamauchi flew in to join the Lugnuts on Wednesday from Double-A Midland. Signed as an undrafted free agent following five years at Hawai'i Hilo, where he set the career program records for runs scored, base hits, doubles and stolen bases, Yamauchi played three games in the Arizona Complex League and 11 games in the Texas League. Yamauchi is the 26th different position player used and the 52nd different player overall for the Nuts this season.

Among the League Leaders, Individual: The promoted Daniel Susac leads the Midwest League in qualified batting average with a .303 average and is tied for 5th in hits (111), 8th in OPS (.810) and 9th in OBP (.373). Danny Bautista, Jr. is 3rd in base hits (116) and 9th in batting average (.271). Junior Pérez is tied for 3rd in stolen bases (41), tied for 6th in doubles (26), 9th in total bases (168) and 10th in extra-base hits (40).

Among the League Leaders, Team: The Nuts' offense is 3rd in the MWL in team batting average (.250), 2nd in fewest strikeouts (1043), 2nd in stolen bases (185), tied for 2nd in sacrifices (15), tied for 3rd in sacrifice flies (46), 3rd in base hits (1053), 3rd in doubles (212) and 4th in triples (30). The Nuts' pitchers are 1st in GO/AO ratio (1.00) and GiDP (97) and 3rd in saves (37). Lansing leads the league with 115 double plays turned, five more than second-place Peoria.

Record-Setter, Individual: Reliever Brock Whittlesey owns the career appearances record at 103 games pitched. Whittlesey appeared in 32 games in 2021, 33 games in 2022 and 38 games thus far in 2023. Of those 103, one – in 2021 – was a spot start. Whittlesey has allowed just two earned runs in his last 17 innings.

Record-Setter, Team: The Lugnuts have committed only 102 errors through 128 games, on pace to break last season's franchise record low of 111 errors.

Keeping it Close: Of the Lugs' 128 games played this year: 45 have been one-run games, 34 have been two-run games, 16 have been three-run games, 10 have been four-run games, and 23 have been games decided by five or more runs. 30 of the Lugnuts' 35 losses this half have been decided by three runs or fewer.

Consistent Faces: Lansing has used the same outfield of LF Danny Bautista, Jr., CF Junior Pérez and RF Colby Thomas for 16 straight games, every game since August 20th, since Clark Elliott was placed on the Injured List. Bautista, Jr. has played in 61 of the last 62 Lugnuts games dating back to June 24, while Pérez has played in 57 of the last 58 games and Thomas has played in 51 consecutive games since joining the Nuts on July 7.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster. Chronologically, working backwards: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); Gunnar Hoglund (Toronto Blue Jays, 3/16/22, for Matt Chapman); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, and 2022 first-round selection, catcher Daniel Susac, are both currently excelling with the Double-A Midland RockHounds in the Texas League.

In a Nutshell: Added to the Lansing roster from Stockton on August 30, 2023, becoming the 922nd Lugnut in franchise history, the 15th different starting pitcher for Lansing this season and the 51st different player used... signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023... joins Pedro Santos as native Cubans on the Lugnuts.

**Prospecting:** Morales is ranked the A's no. 7 prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50...



fastball, slider, change-up

They write, "Considered the top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period, Morales signed for \$3 million with the A's in January of 2023. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019 and 2020 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected from Cuba in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs.

"Morales boasts an electric arm with a fastball that has clocked as high as 99 mph in the past and sits 94-97. He also utilizes a slider, changeup and curveball as secondary pitches that are still developing, and the A's will look to get to work on helping him refine those offerings as he enters the system.

"Morales has worked hard on preparing his body by adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame, which should help his durability. Command is going to be key to his success, as he's struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can improve that aspect of his game, he should be able to move through the organization rather quickly and could be a frontline starter in the future if he can fulfill his potential."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... innings high: 4 IP, 2x; strikeouts high: 6, 6/20.

**Lugnuts Debut:** Started vs. West Michigan at home on September 1... tossed 3 2/3 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 4 K, allowing 2 HR... 59 pitches, 35 strikes... fastball touched 99 mph... in 1st inning, struck out Seth Stephenson and Luke Gold while pitching around a single to Gage Workman (stranded at third)... in 2nd inning, allowed two-out, first-pitch solo HR to RF from Izaac Pacheco... in 3rd inning, allowed one-out, first-pitch solo HR to RF from Gage Workman... in 4th inning, departed with two outs and runners at 1st and 2nd base; reliever Jake Garland allowed RBI single, bringing in one inherited runner, before ending the inning with the score tied 3-3... Garland kept the game tied by blanking the Whitecaps until the 9th, when West Michigan plated two runs against him for a 5-3 victory.

**In a Nutshell:** Opened season with Single-A Stockton... debuted in the MWL May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win over the Captains... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... @JakeGarland25.

**Hometown Hero:** Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg).

**Jupiter?** How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

**The U:** Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

**Professional Debut:** After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.
