HAPPY 3RD OF JULY: After winning three out of the first five games of the series against the Salem Red Sox, the FredNats will go for the series win today on July 3, the final home game before the All-Star break. RHP Riley Cornelio gets the start for Fredericksburg, and he has pitched well of late. Cornelio made four starts in the month of June, and allowed just four earned runs in 15 2/3 innings pitched in the month for an ERA of 2.30. He faces off against Salem's Yordanny Monegro, who dazzled in his first start with Salem last week against Down East, striking out 11 in five shutout frames.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT**: Salem starter Luis Perales struck out 12 FredNats in five scoreless frames, and the FredNats struck out 15 times total in a 4-2 defeat to the Red Sox. Sammy Infante had two hits and an RBI, and Jarlin Susana pitched through the fifth inning for the first time in his professional career. Salem can split the series with a win today, and the FredNats will go for their second straight series win over the Red Sox after taking four out of five games the first time these two teams met over Memorial Day Weekend.

**SOLID STARTS**: In the last four games of this series against the Red Sox, the FredNats have gotten solid starting pitching. In 19 innings pitched for the FredNat starter the last four games, they have allowed just six earned runs total across four starts, with the team going 3-1 in those outings.

**SLAMMIN' SAMMY:** Sammy Infante has had a strong series since moving back to third base for the FredNats. He had exclusively played at second base this year after playing 79 games at third a season ago for Fredericksburg, but recent roster movement has pushed him back to the hot corner. This week against Salem, Infante is 5-for-13 with two doubles, two RBI and three walks.

**TOLMAN THE SUN DEVIL:** 2021 14th round draft pick Erik Tolman had a long road back to the mound before last Thursday's start. He had Tommy John surgery after just three appearances his senior year at Arizona State, and then after 14 months of recovery, he re-injured his throwing elbow and needed Tommy John for a second time. He's finally back to the mound, and fired four shutout frames in his first start with the FredNats last night.

**K-ROD**: FredNat reliever Kevin Rodriguez has been one of the best relief pitchers in the Carolina League this year. He's allowed just two earned runs in the month of June, and just three earned runs since April 15. He's fourth in the Carolina League with 21 relief appearances, and he's done everything - long relief, closing games, piggybacking a starter.

WHAT THE BALK: Balks have been very prominent in the Carolina League this year. The FredNats have been called for 26, which is third-most in the league. Heading into play today, teams in the Carolina League have been called for 282 balks just over halfway through the season. By comparision, in the entire 2022 season, the teams in the league were called for 191 balks. There have been no actual rule changes to the balk rule, so it's unclear as to why so many more balks have been called this year.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Riley Cornelio made his professional debut for the Fredericksburg Nationals in a start at Fayetteville this season, after being selected in the 7th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. The 22 year-old righty more than answered the bell, firing five innings with just one earned run, while picking up seven punchouts to just a pair of walks. However, he was saddled with the loss in a 3-2 defeat against the Woodpeckers.

A stalwart for the TCU Horned Frogs, Cornelio led the team in '22 with 15 starts, and also finished first with 77 strikeouts in 75.0 innings of work.

The right-hander excelled in Big 12 action, posting a 3.12 ERA with 40 strikeouts in just seven starts. His work earned him 2nd Team All Big-12 honors.

**HIGH HONORS:** Cornelio was a highly touted arm coming out of Pine Creek HS in Monument, Colorado. Baseball America tabbed him as the top overall draft prospect in the state for 2019, as he earned both the Perfect Game and Gatorade Colorado Player of the Year award in his senior campaign

**LAST TIME OUT:** Riley Cornelio suffered a hard-luck loss in his most recent start against the Columbia Fireflies. He turned in five full innings for the third straight outing, and allowed a single earned run with just three hits and two walks. Unfortunately, the FredNats were shutout that night.
