Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play their 418th all-time game against the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, the second game of a six-game series at LMCU Ballpark. The Caps prevailed in Tuesday's opener and are 5-2 at home and 7-6 overall against the Lugnuts this season. Lugnuts lefty Hogan Harris receives the start tonight, while West Michigan counters with the Tigers' third-round selection last year from Alabama, right-hander Dylan Smith.

Last Night: Lugnuts at Whitecaps, ppd. The game will be made up as part of a doubleheader on Friday.

Tuesday: Whitecap 9, Lugnuts 5: The Nuts allowed a season high 15 hits - four by Daniel Cabrera, plus solo home runs from Colt Keith and Bryant Packard - in falling in the series opener at LMCU Ballpark. In the loss, Euribiel Ángeles went 2-for-4 with a two-run double.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday in Comstock Park before returning to Jackson Field to open a 12-game, 13-day homestand against the Fort Wayne TinCaps (June 14-19) and Beloit Sky Carp (June 21-26).

Let's Play Two... Again: Tomorrow night will mark the Lugnuts' seventh doubleheader of the year, their third against West Michigan. The Nuts are 1-3-2 (won-lost-split) in their doubleheaders, with their only twinbill sweep of the year coming against the Whitecaps on May 4th. Not coincidentally, that May six-game series against the Whitecaps represents the Lugnuts' only series victory of the year.

Seeing Blue: Euribiel Ángeles's strong opening outing (2-for-4, 2B, 2 RBIs) fits right in with his season performance against West Michigan, where he's 19-for-48, .396/.412/.542, with four doubles, one homer and 11 RBIs in 12 games.

No June Swoon: Though the Lugnuts have opened 1-5 this month (with a 6.96 ERA to boot), Austin Beck is excelling. Beck went 2-for-4 with a walk yesterday and is now 9-for-23 with one home run and two walks, slashing .391/.407/.522 with seven RBIs in six games. The recipient of Beck's productivity has been leadoff hitter Drew Swift, who has scored eight runs in five games this month, thanks to Beck driving him in six times. Swift has reached 11 times (five hits, six walks) in June, posting a .458 on-base percentage.

How to Bunt: 1. Don't. 2. Hit a Dinger: The Lugnuts are one of two Midwest League teams (Dayton Dragons) without a sacrifice bunt this year. The Quad Cities River Bandits lead the MWL with 12 sacrifices laid down.

Ale Alejandro: Captain Alejandro Kirk, who starred for the 2019 Lugnuts, has caught for fire for the Toronto Blue Jays and is slashing .467/.529/.822 in his last 12 games, going 21-for-45 with four doubles and four home runs with six walks compared to four strikeouts. He's one of only four players in the Major Leagues (Jose Ramirez, Juan Soto and Luis Arraez being the others) with 800+ OPS (.878 OPS) and more walks than strikeouts this season (21/16).

Speaking of Impactful Lugnuts 2019 Catchers: It was announced this morning that Gabriel Moreno was being promoted to the Major Leagues by the Blue Jays today. Moreno, the No. 1 prospect in the Blue Jays organization and the No. 4 prospect in all of baseball, slashed .280/.337/.485 with 17 doubles, five triples and 12 homers in 82 games with the Lugnuts in 2019. This year, he was hitting .323/.377/.406 with eight doubles and one home run in 35 games with Triple-A Buffalo

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: In Game 1 of a doubleheader at Cooley Law School Stadium, Chase Lirette twirled a seven-inning complete game in a Lugnuts 8-2 win over the West Michigan Whitecaps. Game 2 was a marathon: The Whitecaps scored three in the 1st, the Lugnuts scored three in the 2nd, and then both teams hung goose eggs until the 11th inning when Avisail Garcia's two-run triple gave the Whitecaps a 5-3 victory. 2013: Game 1 of a doubleheader at West Michigan, the second straight day with a doubleheader against the Whitecaps, went to extra innings before Jared Reaves walked it off with an RBI single in a 4-3 Whitecaps win. Game 2 saw the Lugnuts' third shutout in four games, a 2-0 win in one hour and 26 minutes.

In a Nutshell: Considered at one time one of the A's top left-handed pitching prospects in the organization, Harris has overcome a series of injuries to return to the mound, delivering his first outings since August 2019... he is expected to be followed to the mound today by Shohei Tomioka... @itshoganharris.

Sports in the Family: Harris's mother was an All-American softball player at Louisiana, playing from 1992-1995... grandfather Joe Harris played football at Auburn University... Hogan himself started two years at quarterback at St. Thomas More.

Glory Days: It was baseball, however, where he truly distinguished himself... played at Petco Park in the 2014 Perfect Game All-American Game, the only player from Louisiana invited... ranked Louisiana's No. 1 player in 2015 and the No. 5 southpaw in the nation... led St. Thomas More to back-to-back state titles in 2014 and 2015... as a senior, in 42 innings, posted 0.67 ERA with five shutouts; allowed eight hits and 26 walks while striking out 76 batters... career high school ERA: 1.03.

Ragin' Cajun: In first ever college appearance, notched save... in all, made 14 relief appearances and two starts as a freshman: 3.90 ERA, 27 2/3 IP, 26 K... moved to the starting rotation as a sophomore in 2017, with a 2.66 ERA (5th in Sun Belt Conf.) and 87 strikeouts (6th) in 67 2/3 innings... followed up with a 2.62 ERA in 58 1/3 innings as a junior in 2018, whiffing 54 while allowing just one home run... played summer in Cape Cod League in 2016 (Wareham, teammates with Casey Mize and former Lugnut Sean Rackoski) and 2017 (Yarmouth-Dennis)... worked as high as 98 mph, putting him among the hardest throwers in the country.

Draft Day: Signed for \$660,000 as the 85th overall selection in the 2018 draft... other notable Athletics picks in the draft: Kyler Murray (1st round), Jeremy Eierman (2nd round), Lawrence Butler (6th round), Joe DeMers (1th round), Cobie Vance (18th round), Matt Cross (19th round), Max Schuemann (20th round), Daniel Martinez (21st round), Aiden McIntyre (22nd round), Jonah Bride (23rd round), Chase Calabuig (27th round).

Shut Down: Wrote Melissa Lockard for The Athletic, Hogan Harris was "the first pitcher the A's selected in that draft after they used their first three picks on college position players. There was a lot of excitement at the time about Harris, who came to pro ball with a fastball in the mid-90s and a high spin rate from the left side. He signed quickly, and then the momentum stopped. Before he could throw a professional pitch, Harris was sidelined with an elbow strain. The A's were cautious with his rehab, shutting him down for the rest of the 2018 season and keeping him back at extended spring training to start the 2019 campaign."

Optimism in 2019: Harris made his professional debut for the Vermont Lake Monsters in the New York-Penn League, tossing 3 1/3 innings in a loss to Connecticut on June 17, though he struck out five... two appearances later, he whiffed six while allowing just one run on two hits on June 28 vs. Staten Island... on July 3, he struck out the first six batters he faced and finished with 8 K's in 3 2/3 innings at Lowell... on July 8, he tossed four perfect innings vs. Hudson Valley... on July 13, he fanned six in three scoreless innings vs. Batavia... on July 26, he was promoted to Stockton, combining to allowing just two runs in his 9 1/3 innings in his first two starts... finished the season with four hitless innings on August 29 at Modesto.

But Then: Melissa Lockard promoted Harris as one of her top three Athletics prospects ready for a 2020 breakout, projecting him as returning to High-A Stockton to start the year before a quick promotion to Midland awaited... she wrote, "Although Harris sat more in the low-90s than the mid-90s last season, he did touch the mid-90s on occasion. A's minor-league pitching coordinator Gil Patterson said Harris got nearly 40 percent of his strikeouts on his curveball and the fastball and changeup were effective pitches for him in 2019. The focus will be improving his command a bit and tightening up the slider." Unfortunately, there was no 2020 Minor League Baseball season, and then Harris missed all of 2021 due to injury.

2022 in the Midwest League: Harris joined the Lugnuts from Spring Training, but was placed on the Injured list on Opening Day... on April 24, at last, he was activated and made his return as a starter that afternoon vs. Fort Wayne... allowed an unearned run in the 1st inning, then walked the first two batters in the 2nd inning and departed; both scored against reliever Osvaldo Berrios in a seven-run 2nd inning, and the TinCaps rolled onward to a 13-5 win... departed May 4 due to injury precaution in the middle of his warm-up pitches in the 2nd inning vs. West Michigan after tossing a scoreless 1st with 2 K... David Leal followed with 6 IP in relief in a 7-1 win... spent May 7-22 on the Injured List... returned May 22 at Great Lakes, tossing an easy 1st inning and recorded the first two outs of the 2nd, but Leonel Valera reached on a Marty Bechina throwing error and that unraveled things... Imanol Vargas walked, Edwin Mateo singled in Valera, Max Hewitt walked, and that was all... Stevie Emanuels relieved Harris and tossed 4 1/3 scoreless IP, though Lugnuts fell, 8-3... May 29 at Beloit: tossed two easy, perfect innings, striking out four... fanned the side in the 2nd... 26 pitches, 19 strikes... Brock Whittlesey allowed four in the bottom of the 9th, however, and the Lugnuts were shocked by a 5-4 Sky Carp walkoff win... June 3 vs. Cedar Rapids: blanked Kernels over 2 1/3 innings, allowing one hit in the 1st and walking two in the 2nd... 39 pitches, 24 strikes... after departing, bullpen allowed two runs in the 3rd, two in the 5th and four in the 8th in an 8-5 Kernels win.
