SECOND HALF PATS: The Somerset Patriots secured their third walk-off win of the season on the Fourth of July, courtesy of Cole Gabrielson's 10th inning walk-off infield single. The win marked Somerset first win this season when trailing after eight innings, improving to 1-35 in such games. As the Patriots were out-hit in the contest, it was also their fourth win this season when being out-hit, improving to 4-31 in such games.

NEW SHADE OF INDIGO: Indigo Diaz threw 2.1 perfect innings on Wednesday to earn his team-best sixth win of the season. Since 5/11 @AKR, Diaz has thrown 18.1 IP over which he has allowed 5 H, 1 ER, 7 BB and recorded 19 K. In this stretch, Diaz has posted a 0.48 ERA, a 0.64 WHIP and a .083 BAA. Diaz's 0.48 ERA since 5/11 is the second-best mark in the Eastern League among pitchers with 15+ IP (T. Watson - ERI, 0.39 ERA).

ROC & ROLL: Roc Riggio led the Patriots in Wednesday's doubleheader with 4 R and 5 RBI on the day, highlighted by a two-run home run in the fifth inning of game two. Riggio's 15 HR are the 2nd-most in the Yankees minor league system this year (Spencer Jones, 19). Since Riggio debuted in Double-A on 6/3, he leads the EL with 8 HR and is T-1st with 14 XBH. Riggio also ranks 3rd in RBI (21), and TB (55), 4th in SLG (.561) and T-4th in R (19).

RAFA RAKES: Rafael Flores smacked a double on Friday night, signaling his fifth straight game with an extra-base hit, the longest such streak actively in the Eastern League. On Wednesday, Flores picked up his 25th multi-hit game, continuing to lead the Patriots in that category. He has collected multiple hits in eight of his last 14 games, dating back to 6/19 @NH, over which he is 21-for-54 (.389/.435/.704) with 9 R, 11 XBH (8 2B, 3 HR), 14 RBI, 6 BB, and a 1.139 OPS. In this stretch, Flores has collected a hit in 12 of the 14 games played. Flores is tied for the Eastern League lead with 37 XBH and ranks 2nd in with 153 TB, 88 H, 53 RBI.

EVERYTHING IS JASSOME: Dylan Jasso hit his 11th home run of the season on Wednesday, tying for his career-high mark in his 69th game of the season. Last season, Jasso homered 11 times in 120 games between Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley. He ranks 3rd among EL batters in TB (126), T-5th in H (72), T-6th in HR (11) and RBI (42) and 9th in R (43).

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

Began the season on Somerset's 60-day Injured List, before commencing a minor league rehab assignment on 6/2. Across four rehab starts between the FCL Yankees, Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley, Shields posted a 2.25 ERA in 12.0 IP with 16 K, 4 BB and a 1.25 WHIP. He was reinstated off Somerset's 60-day Injured List on 6/28.

Broke camp with High-A Hudson Valley and started the season in the Renegades' bullpen, pitching to a 2.41 ERA over seven relief appearances (5 ER / 18.2 IP). In April, over his first six professional appearances, Shields pitched allowed only one run, pitching to a 0.54 ERA (1 ER / 16.2 IP) with 20 K and 3 BB. Transitioned to a starting role on 5/12 after injury to RHP Brian Hendry. In his first three High-A starts, he went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (9 ER in 9.0 IP). He ended May by being called up to Triple-A SWB for a spot start on 5/25, in which he allowed 9 R (7 ER) on 8 H in 1.2 IP. In his first full month as a starter in June, Shields was named the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month. In June, Shields went 2-1 with a 2.03 ERA (6 ER / 26.2 IP) in five starts while allowing 13 H and 6 BB for a 0.71 WHIP. He led the SAL with 37 K, striking out a 36.3% of BF in the month. He set and then tied his career-high with nine strikeouts in each of his final two High-A starts. On 6/8, Shields took a no-hitter into the fifth inning @WIL, combining with McKinley Moore on a one-hit shutout in seven innings. Overall with Hudson Valley, Shields posted a 2.75 ERA over 14 appearances (seven starts) with 71 K and 10 BB in 52.1 IP. He was named the SAL Pitcher of the Month the day after he was promoted to Double-A Somerset on 7/2. Ending the season with the Patriots, Shields made 11 appearances (nine starts) and posted a 3.12 ERA over 52.0 IP with 65 K, 21 BB, a .212 BAA and 1.19 WHIP to close out the season. Shields started Game 1 of the Eastern League Championship Series @ERI on 9/22/24, went 4.1 IP with 4 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 7 K in a no-decision where the Patriots went on to lose 9-5.

Spent four years at UMass, pitching three seasons (2018, 20-21), before transferring to George Mason University and pitching in 2022-23. In three seasons at UMass, Shields pitched to a 6.33 ERA over 42.2 IP. During his grad season in 2023, Shields went 7-4 with a 4.69 ERA in 17 appearances, leading the A-10 in GS (16) and K (107), while tying for first with his seven wing and ranking 6th in IP (80.2). In his lone season with GMU in 2023, Shields helped set new program records in strikeouts (516) and lowest BAA (.258).

Signed with the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent on 7/14/23. Did not pitch in 2023 after signing with the Yankees. Summer of 2022, Shields pitched for the Orleans Firebirds in the Cape Cod League, where his teammates included fellow Yankees 2023 signees LHP Kyle Carr and RHP Bryce Warrecker.
