ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-6 at Dow Diamond. Diego Cartaya broke a 6-6 tie with a two-out, two-run double in the bottom of the eighth inning. The loss officially eliminated the Timber Rattlers from playoff contention in the first half of the season.

FIRST! James Meeker was the Wisconsin starting pitcher last night. He had made 125 relief appearances as a professional before getting the start on Saturday. He allowed two runs on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts over three innings. The only runs he allowed were on a two-run home run by Jonny DeLuca in the second inning.

BACK AND FORTH: Wisconsin took a 4-2 lead when Ethan Murray had a three-run double in the third and Arbert Cipion added an RBI single in the fourth. The Loons took a 6-4 lead with four runs in the fifth inning. Wisconsin rallied to tie the game with a run-scoring wild pitch in the seventh, and an RBI bunt single by Jose Acosta in the eighth.

GRAY'S ELEVEN: Joe Gray Jr is 11-for-11 in stolen base attempts this season after he stole second in the eighth inning. Gray scored the tying run from second on the bunt single by Acosta moments later.

THIS GUY: Cartaya had three-hits last night, including his two-run double in the eighth to give the Loons the lead. Cartaya is 8-for-16 with four doubles and four RBI in four games in this series.

THAT'S A LOT: The Rattlers struck out fourteen times last night. They have struck out 61 times in the last four games. This is the first four-game losing streak of the season for the Timber Rattlers.

STANDINGS UPDATE: Cedar Rapids clinched the first-half Western Division title when the Rattlers lost last night. The Kernels would defeat Dayton 9-5 at home last night, too.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They made the Midwest League playoffs seven times between 2007 and 2019. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

GREAT LAKES IN 2021: The Loons went 63-57 and missed the playoffs. Great Lakes had an opportunity to make the playoffs in the final week of the season, but the Timber Rattlers won five of six games from the Loons at Down Diamond to knock Great Lakes out of the playoff picture.

GREAT LAKES IN 2022: The Loons are in second place in the Eastern Division. They won the final five games in a series at first place Dayton prior to starting this series with Wisconsin to cut the deficit from 8-1/2 games to 3-1/2 games. They have gone 9-1 in their last ten games and are now 1-1/2 games behind division-leading Dayton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has seven current Loons on their list of Dodgers prospects: Diego Cartaya (#1), Eddys Leonard (#8), Jorbit Vivas (#9), Nick Nastrini (#13), Jose Ramos (#14), Carlos Duran (#16), and Alex De Jesus (#20). Hyun-il Choi (#28) is on the Great Lakes Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTOINE KELLY: Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as the #14 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* places Kelly at #10 for their in-season update of Milwaukee prospects.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley College

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with the Padres.

THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE: Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

LAST START: Kelly had <u>a no decision at Great Lakes on June 14</u> in game one of this series. He allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and ten strikeouts.

VS. GREAT LAKES: The game on June 14, 2022 was the only time Kelly has faced the Loons in his career. He made one appearance against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers in his career before this series. Kelly allowed one run on five hits with no walks and four strikeouts against the Dodgers Mota affiliate in the Arizona League on July 19, 2019 for a no decision.

GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BEN CASPARIUS: Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 5^{th} round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Connecticut.

UCONN...THE HUSKIES: Casparius was 8-5 with a 4.03 ERA and 127 strikeouts over 91-2/3 innings pitched in fifteen starts during his only season at Connecticut. His 127 strikeouts are the second most in a single season by a UConn pitcher. Casparius was a Second Team All-BIG EAST selection.

THE BEFORE TIME: Casparius was a freshman pitcher and position player on the North Carolina Tarheels team that made the College World Series in 2018 and played for UNC again in 2019. He transferred to UConn after the 2019 season and sat out the abbreviated 2020 season before playing for the Huskies in 2021

STARTING OUT: Casparius began his pro career with five games – one start – between the Dodgers Arizona Complex League affiliate and the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes after signing with LA. He had ten strikeouts and allowed two earned runs over six innings in those two stops in the system.

QUAKING: Casparius started this season back in Rancho Cucamonga. He was 1-2 with a 2.73 ERA and 43 strikeouts over 29-2/3 innings in nine games – seven starts – prior to his promotion to Great Lakes.

LAST START: Casparius had a <u>no decision against the Timber Rattlers on June 14</u> in game one of this series. He allowed three runs – one earned – on two hits with two walks and no strikeouts without recording an out in the first inning of the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Casparius had never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to June 14. He pitched against the <u>Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on September 13, 2021</u>. He worked a scoreless, hitless inning of relief with two strikeouts in that game.
