LANGFORD COLLECTS ONLY RBI IS 2-1 DEFEAT:

Wyatt Langford recorded his sixth multi-hit game in his ninth Double-A contest on Thursday, including the Frisco RoughRiders' only RBI, but the Amarillo Sod Poodles pulled out a 2-1 win from HODGETOWN. Langford singled in the first inning, walked in the third inning and came up in the eighth inning with two runners on and a deficit of 2-0 for Frisco (32-34, 63-71). He laced a single to the warning track to score the first run of the game and cut Frisco's deficit to 2-1. Amarillo's (41-25, 75-60) right fielder Neyfy Castillo cut down a runner at the plate later in the inning to keep the lead intact, and the Riders did not score in the ninth inning. Frisco had four hits in the ballgame, all by the top two hitters in the order. Besides Langford's 2-for-3 line, **Keyber Rodriguez** doubled and singled in his four plate appearances for his second-straight multi-hit game. **Liam Hicks** reached base twice, once on a walk and once on a hit by pitch. **Seth Nordlin** (2-7) tossed 5.1 innings and allowed just two runs, but was saddled with the loss. Nordlin struck out seven and scattered nine hits in his final start for Frisco in 2023. **Robby Ahlstrom** and **Danny Duffy** completed the final 2.2 innings out of Frisco's bullpen without a hit or run allowed. None of Frisco's three pitchers walked or hit a batter on Thursday. Yu-Min Lin (5-2) pitched into the eighth inning for Amarillo with eight strikeouts. He had gone seven shutout innings before allowing just his third hit of the day in the eighth. That run scored after he exited, his only run allowed on the day.

WELCOME, WYATT:

Wyatt Langford, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday against Northwest Arkansas, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday. On Wednesday, he had his first two-homer game. On Thursday, he became the second player (**Evan Carter**) for the RoughRiders to have multiple hits in five games in a row. During this stretch, he is hitting .588 (10-for-17) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBIs, six walks and five runs scored.

THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER:

On Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that No. 1 prospect and former RoughRiders outfielder **Evan Carter** was called up to the Major League roster. A second-round selection in 2020 by the Rangers out of Elizabethton High School in Elizabethton, Tennessee, Carter spent the last week of 2022 and the playoffs with Frisco before beginning the season with the RoughRiders in 2023. During the 2022 season, he won the Tom Grieve Texas Rangers Minor League Player of the Year award, batting .295/.397/.489/.886 with 21 doubles, 10 triples, 12 home runs and 28 steals over 106 games. In 97 games with the RoughRiders in 2023, Carter hit .284/.411/.451/.862 with 15 doubles, six triples, 12 home runs, 62 runs, 74 walks, 68 runs scored and 22 steals. When he was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock, Carter was second in the Texas League in walks (74) and on-base percentage (.411) while he was sixth in OPS (.862). In his MLB debut, he went 1-for-3 with a single, a walk and a stolen base.

BROKEN BATS:

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.6 runs per game, a .236 batting average, 24 home runs and a .706 OPS over their 39 games. Frisco's record since August 1st is 17-21. The 24 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in eight of the last 18 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 98 over their 134 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.370/.433/.803 in the first inning with 15 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 670 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .355 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: **Evan Carter** (74, 5th), **Trevor Hauver** (71, 6th), **Aaron Zavala** (71, 6th) and **Kellen Strahm** (71, 6th). In 2015, **Drew Robinson** set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 136. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 49 games, Hicks is batting .298 (48-for-161)/.433/.385/.818 with nine doubles, a triple, a home run, 23 RBIs, 30 walks and 21 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
