Loss: Ángel Zerpa (1-2) **SPRINGDALE, AR** – The Naturals rallied in the 9th and got the tying run into scoring position, but could not complete the comeback, as the Wind Surge took the second game of the series, 4-3 Wednesday night.

- Northwest Arkansas was forced to play from behind early, as Wichita jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the second off starter **Ángel Zerpa** and held a lead for the rest of the night. Zerpa allowed just one run across 4.0 innings, striking out three and at a point from the 2nd to the 4th innings, retired six straight.
- Zack Phillips and Stephen Woods Jr. combined to pitch the next 2.2 innings out of the bullpen, allowing three runs while combining to strike out six. **Holden Capps** took over for Woods Jr. with two on and one out in the ninth and faced one batter, procuring a 9-2 double play to end the inning, **Nate** Eaton's second outfield assist from right field in the game.
- The two teams tied with eight hits each, with three Naturals producing multi-hit efforts. Catcher Logan Porter went 2-for-3 and scored twice, homering for the third time this season to lead off the seventh inning.
- Porter singled to lead off the ninth, then after **Tucker Bradley** reached on an error, the two scored on a two-run single from Maikel Garcia, on Garcia's second hit of the night.
- Center fielder John Rave went 2-for-5 as well, but Garcia's singled and stole second, the Naturals couldn't bring him home and fell a run short.
- Garcia's two hits stretched his hitting streak to 13 games, tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this year, the longest for a Naturals player this season.

#### This Day in Naturals History

#### The Naturals are 5-6 all-time when playing on May 12

On May 12, 2018, the Naturals walked off for the second time that season, 10-9 over the Tulsa Drillers in 9 innings at Arvest Ballpark. The Naturals entered the bottom of the 9th inning trailing 9-8, but Nicky Lopez led off with a triple and scored to tie the game the very next pitch on a **Elier Hernandez** single. After two outs were record. **Brandon Downes** reached on a throwing error from Tulsa's Connor Joe to score Hernandez from third base to win the game. Lopez and Hernandez each produced 4-for-5 nights at the plate, with Hernandez also homering in the third inning, scoring four times and driving in four runs.

#### FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 27 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 11 of the Naturals' 27 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas:
   Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave, Patrick Smith and Ángel Zerpa.

#### **TOOLSY TEAM**

Five Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF Seuly Matias is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP Asa Lacy is rated as having the "Best Slider" in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the "Best Control" in the system.

#### WHAT YOU KNOW ABOUT PITCHING DEEP?

Last week against Springfield, Naturals starting pitchers combined to throw 27.2 innings (out of 52.0 played, or 53%), the most the rotation has collectively offered in a series this season, including three performances of 5.0 innings or more.

- As a staff, the Naturals 4.44 ERA in the month of May ranks 4th in the Texas League, with four of nine starts lasting 5.0 innings or longer and seven straight of 4.0 innings or more.
- Across eight May games, Naturals starting pitchers have a 3.76 ERA (17
  ER in 40.2 IP) with 43 strikeouts (9.52 K/9) and a .208 opponents' average.
- Reigning Texas League Pitcher of the Week Drew Parrish has thrown 5.0
  innings or more in each of his last five outings, including a pair of scoreless
  starts, 6.0 innings on 4/26 vs. AMA and 5/7 @ SPR.

#### NATURALS IN THE SHOW

In last Tuesday's 7-1 win for the Kansas City Royals, 2021 Natural MJ Melendez hit seventh and served as the Royals' DH, becoming the 113th player to debut in the Majors after spending time in Northwest Arkansas, the fourth in the 2022 MLB Season.

 Bobby Witt Jr. was Naturals alum 110 to reach the Majors, debuting on April 7 ... Collin Snider was the 111th on April 9 ... Yunior Marté became the 112th Naturals alum to reach the Majors, debuting with the San Fransisco Giants on April 12.

#### **EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring five runs or less, the Naturals are just 2-13, while 13-1 when scoring six runs or more.
- The Naturals are 4-12 when recording nine hits or less, but 11-2 when recording 10 hits or more.
- The Naturals are 15-3 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 0-11 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 12-5, whereas 3-9 when the opponent scores first.

#### Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 29 games, the Naturals have stolen <u>41 bases in 61 attempts</u> (average 1.41 steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 6 times*.

- 41 steals ranks third in the Texas League, eighth in Double-A and tied for 29th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's 12 steals (in 14 attempts) ranks fourth in the Texas League and tied for seventh in all of Double-A.

#### GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** is currently riding a 13-game hitting streak, but also has 22 walks on the season, which is tied for third in the Texas League and tied sixth in Double-A. while his 35 hits are 10th in Double-A.

- The 13-game hitting streak is the longest on the Naturals this year, the third-longest in the Texas League this season and is the second- longest active hitting streak behind Amarillo's Dominic Fletcher (16 games) ... in the 13 games since 4/27, he's batting .389 (21-for-54) with five doubles and a .949 OPS.
- In 135 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 57 times, for a .425 on-base percentage (35 hits + 22 walks) ... he has reached at least once in 26 of the 28 games he's appeared in this season ... the only games he didn't reach base were back-to-back games, on April 23 & 26 ... he's also reached base at least twice in 18 of 26 games where he has reached base.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied third in walks (22), fourth in steals (12), tied fifth in runs scored (26) and sixth in hits (35).
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.

#### NATE IS GREAT

Utility man **Nate Eaton** has been a consistent presence in the Naturals lineup all season along, playing all over the diamond for Northwest Arkansas as well.

- Between April 23 and May 1, Eaton collected an eight-game hitting streak, going 15-for-31 (.484 average) with two homers, six runs batted in, four steals and a 1.285 OPS ... this streak ranks second on the team in 2022, behind Maikel Garcia's active 13 game streak.
- With 15 starts (131.0 innings) at third base, 5 starts (45.0 innings) in right field, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in left field and one start at shortstop (9.0 innings), the VMI product is the only Naturals player who has spent time at more than three positions in the field. He's also tied with Tucker Bradley for the team lead with 3 outfield assists.

#### It's Gonna Be Massey

Since the calendar flipped to May, second baseman **Michael Massey** has been one of the top hitters in the Texas League, batting at a .433 (13-for-30) average with a 1.067 OPS across eight games, while driving in 11 runs.

- After two slow weeks to start the season, Massey has turned things around, raising his batting average over 100 points, from .213 after April 21 to the team-best .324 it sits at now.
- His hot streak began April 22, homering in three consecutive games, April
  22 to 24 in Frisco and went from having no homers through the first 11
  games of the season, to having five in his last 14, tied for the team lead
  in that department.
- Massey has reached base in 23 of 27 games he's played this year, with already 10 multi-hit games, including four in May and hits in four straight.
- Massey ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking fourth in runs batted in (27), tied fourth in hits (36), tied eighth in total bases (59), 10th in batting average (.324) and tied 10th in doubles (8).

### #6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).

- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
