### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

**\*\*\*LAST TIME OUT:** The Marauders lost both ends of Saturday's doubleheader, falling by scores of 3-1 and 4-3... **Po-Yu Chen** tossed five innings in Bradenton's game one loss, striking out five and walking none... In the nightcap, **Justin Meis** became the first Marauders pitcher of 2022 to pitch six innings in a game, limiting Jupiter to three runs... **Alexander Mojica's** third home run of the season, a three-run shot in the first inning, accounted for all three Marauders runs in the second game... The Marauders have now lost a season-high five straight games.

**THE OPPONENT:** The Hammerheads have won six straight games, their longest win streak of the season... Jupiter's roster currently features five players in *Baseball America's* pre-season top 30 prospect rankings for the Marlins organization: INF Kahlil Watson (#2), INF Jose Salas (#8), INF Ian Lewis (#9), RHP Chris Mokma (#26), and INF Cristhian Rodriguez (#30).

**STUCK IN A RUT:** The Marauders have lost a season-worst five straight games (first time since August 9-13, 2019) and have now dropped nine of their last 11... This marks the team's worst losing streak since the club lost 14 of 15 games August 2-16, 2018)... The skid has dropped Bradenton below .500 (15-17) for the first time since opening weekend, and the club is now a season-worst five-and-a-half games out of first place in the West Division.

**ENDING THE DROUGHT:** The Marauders went 28 innings without an extra-base hit during the current series; after a **Jase Bowen** RBI-ground-rule double in the fifth inning Tuesday, Bradenton did not manage another extra-base hit until a **Rodolfo Nolasco** double in the seventh inning of the first game Saturday's doubleheader.

**HASTE MAKES WASTE:** After committing just 13 errors in their first 17 games, the Marauders have committed 23 errors in their last 15 games and now have the third-highest error total (36) in the FSL... The errors have led to 32 unearned runs on the season, most in the FSL... Additionally, Marauders catchers have allowed a combined eight passed balls, second-most in the league.

**ANOTHER FREE PASS:** Fifteen of the Marauders' 32 games this season have seen the staff issue six or more walks... Bradenton's 152 walks allowed are the most in the FSL and rank seventh-most among all 30 Single-A teams... The Marauders are averaging 4.94 walks per nine innings, also seventh-worst among all Single-A teams.

**TOP PIRATES PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently includes one prospect in *Baseball America's* pre-season Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: outfielder **Rodolfo Nolasco** (#21). *Baseball America* lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball.

**FIELD STAFF:** Manager **Jonathan Johnston**, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer **Yorman Bazardo** is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate **Mendy López** joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... **Casey Harms** is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... **Gustavo Omaña** is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021.

**HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS:** The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Henry Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS/INFO

**2022:** In season debut April 10 at Dunedin, pitched behind rehabbing RHP Luis Oviedo: two singles and a HBP led to a sac fly in the second inning; after a scoreless third, allowed a double, two-run homer, and another double, was lifted after a strikeout... April 17 vs Lakeland, allowed a walk in the first inning that led to two RBI-doubles, allowed a solo homer in the second, retired the next seven straight batters but was lifted after allowing another solo home run in the fourth... April 24 at Daytona, held Tortugas scoreless over first three innings (worked around four baserunners) before allowing an RBI-single in the fourth, exiting with two out and bases loaded (all runners stranded by Cristian Charle)... May 1 vs Dunedin, allowed just 2 runs (1 earned) in season-high 5 IP... Last Sunday vs Tampa, matched season-high 5 IP and recorded a season-best 6 K while walking one...

**2021:** In stateside debut, split season between starting rotation and bullpen, posting a 1.09 WHIP and holding opponents to a .224 AVG...

**2020:** (No MiLB season)

**2019:** Returned to DSL Pirates 1 and worked primarily as a starter, limiting opponents to a .240 AVG in 12G (11GS)...

**2018:** In professional debut season, pitched to a 1.64 ERA and 1.00 WHIP out of the bullpen for DSL Pirates 1, holding opponents to a .147 AVG...

**PERSONAL:** Born and raised in Santiago, Dominican Republic, home of 2003 American League Rookie of the Year (and former Marauders coach) Angel Berroa, former major league outfielder Carlos Gomez, and 2021 Low-A Southeast Player of the Year Endy Rodriguez...
