TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue up a six-game set with Akron for their final matchups of the year, Altoona is 9-13 vs. the 'Ducks.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona got homers from Endy Rodriguez and Aaron Shackelford, but Akron pitching struck out 14 in a 8-4 win for the 'Ducks

ENDY'S POP: Catcher Endy Rodriguez homered from both sides of the plate in Altoona's 13-7 win over Akron on Thursday, September 1. It was just the 5th time in franchise history that Altoona had a player homer from both sides of the plate and first time at PNG Field. **Rodolfo Castro** last turned the trick on 6/5/21 at Richmond. Others to homer from both sides of the plate in the same game in franchise history include: **Shawn Garrett** 5/2/03 at Reading, **Hector Gimenez** 5/5/10 at Richmond, **Shelby Ford** 5/15/10 at Richmond.

In his 19 games since joining the Curve on August 9 at Binghamton, he's batting .361/.459/.806/1.265 with 8 2B, 8 HR, 21 RBI, 12 BB and 1-1 SB. His 16 XBH, .806 SLG% and 1.265 OPS all rank 3rd among all minor league players since his promotion.

K-MAN GOES TO INDY: Right-hander Luis Ortiz struck out 126 batters in 24 appearances with the Curve; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since **Taylor Hearn** in 2018. Ortiz struck out 10 Bowie Baysox on Friday, August 26, the first 10+ strikeout performance for the Curve since **Roansy Contreras** struck out 10 on 6/15/21 at Erie. With his promotion to Triple-A Indianapolis on Thursday, September, Ortiz will finish his season just 16 strikeouts of matching the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (Ian Snell, 2004: 142).

24: Tuesday night Matt Gorski, who is rated as Pittsburgh's 22nd-best prospect according to MLB Pipeline, connected for his 24th home run of the season while on rehab with Low-A Bradenton, tying **Aaron Shackelford** for the organizational lead in that department. The last time the Pirates had two minor leaguers hit at least 24 home runs in a season was 2007 when **Steve Pearce** hit 31 while Jonel Pacheco finished second (27).

BLAKEY: Catcher Blake Sabol was promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis following Altoona's series at Bowie. Sabol finishes his time with the Curve on an 11-game hit streak during which he batted .395 (17-for-43) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 7 RBI and a 1.124 OPS. Following play on Sunday, August 28, Sabol ranked 3rd in the EL in BA (.281), 6th in SLG % (.486) and 8th in OPS (.833).

HAMMERIN' HANK IS BACK: Catcher Henry Davis has returned to Altoona's active roster after a 7-week stint on the IL. Davis, the No.1 overall selection in the 2021 draft out of Lousiville, last appeared for Altoona on Saturday, July 2. In a four-game rehab assignment at Low-A Bradenton, Davis batted 3-for-9 with 1 HR and 2 RBI and he picked up 2 hits in his return to the lineup on August 30.

ACTIVE 1'S: For the first time this season, Altoona has 4 First Round draft picks on the active roster at the same time with Connor Scott (13th overall, 2018 by Miami), Quinn Priester (19th overall, 2019), Nick Gonzales (7th overall, 2020) and Henry Davis (1st overall. 2021) active for Altoona.

NICKY G IS BACK: After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Infielder Nick Gonzales has reached base safely in 15-of-16 games since his activation batting: .295/.405/.475 (18-for-61) with 8 2B, 1 HR, 10 RBI, 10 BB since his return.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 148 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 19 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, Jared Triolo (24), Liover Peguero (23) and Andres Alvarez (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE RUBBERDUCKIES: Managed by Rouglas Odor, Akron enters the series on the fringe of the second half division playoff race. Their roster features several top Guardians prospects despite the promotions of INF Bryan Rocchio and OF George Valera to Triple-A. RHP Gavin Williams (#3), RHP Tanner Bibee (#8), INF Angel Martinez (#12), OF Jhonkensy Noel (#17), INF Jose Tena (#18), RHP Tanner Burns (#19), C Bryan Lavastida (#26) and LHP Doug Nikhazy (#28) highlight the current 'Ducks roster.

THE FIRST ONTO THE POND: Left-hander Doug Nikhazy, the #28 prospect in the system according to MLB.com, takes the ball on Saturday night. Cleveland's 2nd round pick in 2021 out of Ole Miss, Nikhazy will make his Double-A debut tonight after 21 starts at High-Á wȟere he recorded a 3.19 ERÀ in 93.0 IP with 68 BB and 118 K's. Nikhazy hails from Windermere, FL and attended West Orange HS where he coordinated the West Orange Dance Marathon that raised \$80,000 for a children's miracle network and was Student Body President and a National Debator in high school. Nikhazy played for USA Baseball in 2015 and helped Ole Miss reach the Super Regional in 2021 at Arizona where he struck out 10 in 5.1 IP in their lone win at the Super Regional.

#### **TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY**

2003 - First playoff game in team history, an 8-2 loss at Akron; Landon Jacobsen tabbed as starting pitcher and was bounced in the fourth inning Curve built a 2-0 lead before three-run third by Akron.

2005 - Josh Bonifay hits a solo homer in the sixth inning at Bowie, a 3-1 win, for his 125th extra-base hit as a member of the Curve, passing Adam lyzdu for the franchise's all-time record in that category.

2021 - Altoona narrowly avoids being no-hit for the 9th time in franchise history when Mason Martin lines an opposite field single to left field on a 3-2 pitch with 2 outs in the 9th inning at Akron.

#### **CAREER NOTES**

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 right-handed pitching prospect in all of minor league baseball entering the season... Suffered an oblique injury at the end of spring training and missed all of April and May before returning for a rehab assignment beginning on Thursday, June 9 with Bradenton vs. Clearwater in which the Marauders threw a combined no-hitter (Priester 3.0 IP, Anthony Solometo 4.0 IP, Jake Sullivan 1.0 IP, Yunior Thaibo 1.0 IP), game was caught by rehabbing Curve C Henry Davis... Bradenton's no-hitter was the first he's ever been part of in his life... Completed his rehab assignment on 6/14 with Greensboro: allowed five runs on six hits in 2.2 innings...EL Ranks in July: 5th in ERA (1.69), 6th in IP (26.2), 9th in WHIP (1.05), 10th in BAA (.216)... His 1.69 ERA in July ranked 8th among Double-A Pitchers... His 2.45 ERA since his debut (6/19 - Present) ranks 8th among qualified Double-A Pitchers...

2021: Entered the season ranked by Baseball America and MLB Pipeline as the fourth-best prospect in the Pirates system...Was also ranked by Baseball America as the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball and the No. 17 right-handed pitching prospect... Was listed as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates minor league system by Baseball America entering the 2021 campaign... Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training where he made two appearances and allowed one earned run in 1.1 innings pitched... CURVE CUTS: Charles Quinn Priester... Was committed to play coldraft... Signed for a bonus of \$3,400,000 by Pirates scout Anthony Wycklendt... Is a 2019 graduate of Cary-Grove (IL) High School, where he posted an 8-2 record and 1.00 ERA as a senior... Was named the 2018-19 Gatorade Illinois Player-of-the-Year... Was a two-sport athlete in high school; also played wide receiver and defensive back on the high school's football team that went 14-0 and won a Class 6A state championship in 2018 where he caught a 3-yard touchdown pass in the championship game against Crete-Monee HS... Played quarterback as an underclassmen before moving to receiver during his senior year of high school... Turned down an offer of a dual scholorship from Northnight school...
