ROAD WARRIORS: After skating by with another close victory last night with six shutout innings from the bullpen, the FredNats turn around quickly for a Wednesday day game with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans, Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. Today, RHP Bryan Polanco rejoins the FredNat rotation after the promotion of Jose Atencio. Polanco has been one of the best overall arms on the FredNat pitching staff this year, posting a 4-0 record and team-best 2.49 ERA in mostly long relief appearances for FXBG. Polanco will face Myrtle Beach righty Mason McGwire, the son of baseball legend Mark McGwire. Fredericksburg continues to lead the Carolina League in runs scored with 199, and Myrtle Beach has allowed the most as well (186).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Both offenses got off to a quick start, with MB scoring three runs in the first two innings against Bryan Sanchez, and FXBG scoring four runs on four straight hits in the 2nd inning to take a 4-3 lead. Armando Cruz, Everett Cooper III and Cristhian Vaquero all drove in runs for the FredNats in that 2nd inning. Then, the FredNat bullpen took over, firing six scoreless innings the rest of the way. Brandon Pimentel drove in a crucial insurance run in the top of the 9th and Thomas Schultz induced a game-ending double play to secure a 5-3 win in the series opener.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. After six more shutout innings last night, the bullpen has pitched 180 innings this year and allowed just 43 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.15. The Freddies are also 12/13 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is first in the Carolina League with seven saves. The unit has also danced out of trouble time and time again on this road trip. In all five wins this trip, the oppoosing team has had the tying and/or go-ahead runs on base in the 9th inning, and FXBG's bullpen has slammed the door each time.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 16-2 this season when scoring first, including the last 14 wins in a row prior to lats night. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in last week's series against Charleston on Friday and Sunday, and last night against Myrtle Beach was the first time since mid-April the team won despite not scoring first.

FORMULA CONTINUED: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 23 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .251 with RISP, compared to .102 in losses. The FredNats did decently well at the plate with runners in scoring position last week, going a combined 11-for-44 (.250) against the RiverDogs, and then followed it up with a 4-for-12 peformance last night.

HE'S BACK: 2021/22 FredNat Jeremy De La Rosa burst back onto the scene last week with the FredNats on a rehab assignment after injuring the AC joint in his shoulder during spring training. In his first game action in 2024, De La Rosa went 8-for-17 with four doubles, two triples and three RBI, including the game-winning RBI in the 10th inning of Saturday's game.

ANOTHER PROMOTION: Prior to yesterday's game, RHP Jose Atencio was promoted to High-A Wilmington. Atencio was one of the best starting pitchers in the Carolina League, posting a 31/1 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 28 innings for Fredericksburg. He is the only FredNat pitcher this year to reach the sixth inning of a start as he battled the RiverDogs through six tough innings last Thursday. Atencio was promoted to Fredericksburg in July of 2022 and now gets the call to Wilmington.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 163–131 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TODAY'S START: Bryan Polanco is set to make his second start of the season, this afternoon against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. Polanco made a spot start at the end of April against Delmarva, but figures to take over a starting role with the promotion of Jose Atencio.

NOTHING NEW: While Polanco had been primarily a relief arm with Fredericksburg this year, starting games is a role he's more than familiar with. In his MiLB career, 17 of Bryan's 33 career appearances have been as a starting pitcher. In 2022 and '23 in particular, he started 16 games compared to just six relief appearances.

Further simplifying the transtition, Polanco has served as the "bridge guy" out of the FredNat bullpen this year, capable of handling longer outings. Of his five relief appearances, Polanco has worked three innings once, 4+ innings three times, and even logged a five inning relief outing on 5/1 vs Down East.

ROAD TO THE FREDDIES: Polanco began his professional career with a rough debut in the DSL in 2021, but he returned in '22 and cut his ERA in half (7.04 to 3.51) while striking out 49 hitters in 41.0 IP. He jumped to the FCL and faced some struggles, but joined the Nats late in 2023 for a pair of starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Polanco earned his fourth win of the year last week against the RiverDogs. He fired 4.1 scoreless, hitless innings, with no walks and three punchouts.
