**Tonight:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second game in a season-ending six-game series against the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Nuts won the series opener last night, improving to 9-4 against the Dragons in the season series.

**Off the Field:** Today is the final **Dog Days of Summer**, with dogs welcome to the ballpark. Tomorrow is **Pride Night** as well as a **Labatt Blue Thirsty Thursday**, with \$2 domestic drafts and \$4 craft drafts; Friday is a **LAFCU Frontline Friday** with postgame LAFCU Fireworks; Saturday is **Fan Appreciation Night** featuring the Lugnut Jersey Charity Auction; and Sunday, the final game of the year, is a **Capital City Market Kids Day / Accessible Day**, partnering with Disability Rights Michigan.

**Starting Matchup:** Lugnuts right-hander **Christian Fernandez**, acquired via trade with Cal Stevenson from Tampa Bay for Christian Bethancourt, makes his sixth start and eighth overall appearance. Dayton counters with right-hander **Thomas Farr**, drafted in the fifth round in 2021 from South Carolina, making his 20th start and 22nd appearance with the Dragons.

**Last Night: Locos 6, Dragons 2.** In the final Copa de la Diversión appearance for the Lansing Locos, **Jonny Butler** hit a three-run homer in a four-run 1st inning and Lansing cruised to victory behind balanced pitching from **Jacob Watters** (2 IP), **Angello Infante** (3 IP), **Kumar Nambiar** (2 IP) and **Calvin Coker** (2 IP). In defeat, Dayton received solo home runs from **Noelvi Marte** and **Michel Triana**, but went 0-for-15 with runners in scoring position.

### LUG•NOTES

**Dragons Slayers:** With yesterday's result, the Nuts have won their last six games against Dayton – five straight at Day Air Ballpark and the series opener last night. Lansing's 9-4 record against the Dragons is the Lugnuts' best record against any team this year in the MWL. The teams have similar offensive numbers (104 hits, 46 XBH, .239/.333/.428 for Lansing, 101 hits, 48 XBH, .231/.314/.439 for Dayton), the Nuts outscoring the Dragons 67-52. **Christian Fernandez**, tonight's starter, fared particularly well in Dayton with five hitless innings on August 10th.

**Running Men:** With OF **Lawrence Butler**'s successful steal of second last night, the Nuts are 10-for-10 in stealing bases in five games played in September. In 54 games since July 3, the Nuts have 87 steals in 102 attempts (after stealing 40 bases in 57 attempts in their first 71 games).

**But None For You:** Meanwhile, Dayton was caught stealing three times in six attempts last night, giving the Nuts seven runners caught stealing in 11 attempts this month. This comes after Lansing allowed just 16 successful steals in 31 attempts in August, and 12 successful steals in 17 attempts in July. In the season series, Dayton is just 14-for-25 on the base paths against the Nuts.

**No-No History:** Before Sunday's four-pitcher no-hitter at South Bend, the only no-hitters in Lugnuts franchise history were...

- A three-pitcher, nine-inning 15-0 win on April 21, 2003, vs. Dayton, noteworthy for Donnie Hood hitting for the cycle in the same game
- A two-pitcher, six-inning 1-0 loss on July 14, 2016, at Peoria as part of a doubleheader, noteworthy for 2022 A.L. All-Star Jordan Romano starting the game for Lansing.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has five players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Cooper Bowman** (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22, for Frankie Montas and Lou Trivino); **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Joey Estes** (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22, for Matt Olson); and the injured **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17).

- Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.
- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame, by request.

**To the Show:** Ten former Nuts have debuted in MLB this year, namely A's pitchers **Norge Ruiz** (2021), **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018), catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019) and pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018); M's reliever **Danny Young** (2016); Red Sox pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) and Marlins pitcher **Jake Fishman** (2017).

**Team USA Skipper for the Series:** When **Phil Pohl** went on scheduled vacation from August 16-21 vs. Great Lakes; **Veronica Alvarez** stepped in as interim manager, going 2-4. Alvarez was the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Athletics.

**Inside the Park and Out of This World:** On August 2-3, 2022, CF **Denzel Clarke** joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Majors.

**Life as a Lugnut:** Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

**Last Appearance: August 31st at South Bend.** After Jacob Watters started the game and pitched the 1st inning and Osvaldo Berrios handled the 2nd and 3rd innings, Fernandez entered and took care of the final five innings in relief... blanked South Bend in the 4th, 6th, 7th and 8th, but gave up a two-run homer to Kevin Made in the 5th breaking a 2-2 tie, and the Nuts lost, 4-2... 70 pitches, 46 strikes.

**The Early Word:** When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury... Fernandez is eligible for the Rule 5 Draft at season's end.

**Home Cooking:** Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include Marlins ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

**Path Through the Pros:** Debuted in 2016 in Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in Appalachian League... missed 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).

**2022 Dominance in the Rays' System:** Opened this season as a middle reliever in the Charleston RiverDogs bullpen, striking out five in 2 1/3 innings vs. Myrtle Beach on April 10 in season debut; it had been 958 days since his last MiLB appearance on August 27, 2019... pitched out of the bullpen through late May, peaking in final appearance with eight strikeouts in four innings vs. August, May 20... moved into the starting rotation May 26 vs. Delmarva and responded with four scoreless innings, six strikeouts... made five starts in June: 3.27 ERA, 22 IP, 10 BB, 30 K, .195 avg. ... in two starts in July: 2.79 ERA, 9 2/3 IP, 3 BB, 10 K, .263 avg. ... longest start: 5 2/3 IP at Myrtle Beach, July 1 (5 H, 2 R on 2 solo HR, 1 BB, 6 K)... excelled at home (33 2/3 IP, 2.14 ERA, .197 avg., 1 HR) compared to road (24 1/3 IP, 3.70 ERA, .207 avg., 5 HR)... because of change-up, very tough on lefties (.179, 0 HR) vs. righties (.223, 5 HR)... limited opposition to .179 avg. with runners in scoring position.
