**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve look to exact some revenge on the Baysox after dropping 5-of-6 to Bowie in late-April. This is the final visit of the season for the Curve to Prince George Stadium, the team's will see each other at PNG Field in August.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Po-Yu Chen tossed 6.0 strong inning, but the Curve could only must 3 hits in a 3-2 loss to Bowie on Tuesday night.

**SLAMMIN' SAMMY:** Outfielder **Sammy Siani** led the Curve to a 6-4 comeback win over Bowie on Wednesday, June 19. With a solo homer, and a run-scoring single as part of a 3-for-5 day at the plate, Siani also added a critical diving catch in right field in the 5th inning to support the Curve bullpen. In his last 5 games (June 14), Siani is batting .368/.455/.789/1.244 OPS with 1 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR and 4 RBI with 3 BB.

**DIXON PLAYS THE SONG:** Altoona earned their second walk-off victory of the season on Saturday, June 15 when **Brenden Dixon** smacked a 3-run homer to left to defeat the Erie SeaWolves 11-8. Dixon aided the comeback effort, which began with the Curve trailing 8-4 headed to the bottom of the eighth, with an RBI single in a three-run frame.

**TROUBLE AT HOME:** With a 11-18 record at home this season, the Curve have struggled to take advantage of their homefield advantage at Peoples Natural Gas Field. Altoona's .641 OPS as a team in home games is 25th among Double-A teams. Offense is generally down in the league as Binghamton (.634 OPS in home games, 28th among Double-A teams) and Akron (.630 OPS in home games, 29th among Double-A teams) have also struggled to score runs in their home games. Altoona's 122 runs scored in home 29 games is 22nd at the level, 3rd-worst to Akron who has scored 104 runs in 28 home games this season.

**SULLY DOMINATES:** Righty **Sean Sullivan** has picked up right where he left off in 2023 in the Curve rotation. Sullivan tossed 18.0 consecutive scoreless innings (5/7 - 5/28), the longest streak by a Curve pitcher since Roansy Contreras began the 2021 season with 18.2 scoreless innings. In his time with Altoona he has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 23-of-37 outings (20-of-32 starts) and his 3.72 ERA ranks 11th in the Eastern League.

**BOWEN'S BAT:** Outfielder **Jase Bowen** has hit his stride in the month of June. He's batting .273 (15-for-55) in the first 13 games of June with 2 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, and 6 RBI. Bowen reached base safely in a season-high 10 straight games entering play on from May 31 - June 12 during which he batted .318/.340/.409 with 5 RBI.

**PETEY'S BIG FLIES:** Outfielder **Dustin Peterson** recorded his fourth career two-homer game in Altoona's 6-4 win over Richmond on Sunday, June 9. Peterson recorded the second multi-homer game by a Curve batter this season (Aaron Shackelford - April 9) and the 129th instance in franchise history. Peterson is batting .348/.400/.652/1.052 with 1 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI during his current 6-game hit streak (6/9 - Present).

**THE CHEN CHRONICLES:** Righty **Po-Yu Chen** overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed just one run in three straight outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.82 ERA (9 ER / 28.2 IP) with 25 strikeouts.

**THE POWER OF GEN Z:** Infielder **Tsung-Che Cheng** homered in back-to-back games for the first time in his career when he knocked solo homers on June 5 and 6 at Richmond. Cheng has reached base safely in 12 of his last 16 games.

**K SPELLS TROUBLE:** The Curve struck out at least 13 times in 7-of-10 games from Thursday, May 30 - Tuesday, June 11. Altoona has struck out at least 10 times at the plate in a game 31 times this season in 65 games.

**BULLPEN TROUBLES:** Altoona's bullpen has blown 11 of 24 save chances this season, second-most by a Double-A club behind the Akron RubberDucks (14 blown saves). Altoona's 5.07 bullpen ERA is 29th among 30 Double-A clubs, 102nd among 120 minor league teams.

**HANGING BY THE BAY:** Roberto Mercado leads the Baysox after two seasons managing the Orioles High-A affiliate in Aberdeen. Mercado led the Ironbirds to a playoff appearance in 2022 and took home the organization's Cal Ripken Sr. Award given to the minor league instructor with the most dramatic impact during the season. The typically loaded Baysox are a bit light in the prospect department this year, but OF Dylan Beavers, C/DH Samuel Basallo and C Silas Ardoin highlight the position player group.

**THE FIRST TO PUT THEIR SOX ON:** Kyle Brnovich toes the rubber for Bowie on Thursday night. Brnovich was another piece in the Dylan Bundy trade made with the Angels in 2019 along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek and RHP **Isaac Mattson**. Brnovich tossed 5.0 innings and allowed just 1 hit with 8 K's against the Curve on Sunday, April 21.
