FROM THE DOG HOUSE

TIGHT TO THE FINISH: With under a month remaining in the first half, the RiverDogs enter Wednesday 3.5 games back of Hickory for first place in the Carolina League South standings. The first half is slated to complete on June 18 - whoever finishes in first after that date clinches a spot in the postseason. Charleston will face Hickory once more from June 9-June 14 and will wrap up the first half on the road at Wilson. Charleston eyes its first postseason berth since 2024. Despite a sizzling start to the month of May, the club has cooled over the latter two weeks. Dating back to 5/9, they have dropped 13 of their last 16 - all against divisional opponents. Over that stretch, they're slashing .233/.311/.350, averaging 3.5 runs per game and have posted a 5.41 team ERA.

KUHN TAKES THE BALL: Right hander **Jacob Kuhn** will make his second professional start tonight, after opening for **Aidan Haugh** last week. Across 14 outings this season, Kuhn has posted a team-leading 1.96 ERA and fanned 28 hitters. In the process, opponents are hitting just .163 against him. In his last start at Hickory (in Winston-Salem) last week, the righty fired three shutout frames, facing one batter over the minimum with four punchouts. In the month of May, he has allowed just two runs across 12.1 innings (1.46 ERA). He mixes in an upper 90s fastball, cutter and changeup.

HAUGH YOU DOIN'?: Right hander **Aidan Haugh** was dominant in game one of the doubleheader last night for Charleston, firing a seven-inning-complete-game shutout to earn his fourth win of the year. The seven frames marked a career high. Throughout the gem, he tossed just 80 pitches, surrendered no walks and faced four batters over the minimum. The performance was the seventh complete game of at least seven innings in MiLB this season, and the third that ended in a shutout. Haugh joins **Aidan Cremarosa** who tossed a nine-inning no hitter earlier this month as the only RiverDogs to toss a complete game. It also earned the team its second win of the shutout variety this season, and first since Cremarosa's no-hitter on May 8.

MR. RISP: Rays No. 27 prospect **Cooper Flemming** has been sensational with runners in scoring position this season. Along with his team-leading 30 runs batted in, the infielder is 18-for-50 (.360) in those spots - good for the 13th most hits in Single-A, and tied for the second-most in the Carolina League. Flemming was just named to Baseball America's Top 100 prospects list (No. 90), catapulting him to No. 5 in the Rays system via their updated rankings. His 140 wRC+ ranks 87th in MiLB among hitters with 150+ PA.

CLASH OF THE TAITN: At only 18 years old, **Taitn Gray** is lauded for his unique combination of elite bat speed and bat-to-ball skills. Among all qualified players in MiLB 18 years or younger, he enters the week fourth in hits (36), first in homers (6 - tied), and second in OPS (.832). Ranked the Rays No. 29 prospect, he went 4-for-5 with two homers and six runs batted in on 5/7, setting career highs in all categories. In the process, he became just the 48th player in all of Minor and Major League Baseball since 2005 to homer twice in a game at age 18 or younger (full-season affiliates only). He joins **Leo De Vries** (7/5/2024) as one of only two players on that list to homer from both sides of the plate. He is also the first RiverDog to homer from both sides of the plate since **Abiezel Ramirez** on 7/8/21 vs Augusta. Gray was drafted in the third round last year by the Rays after winning Iowa's Gatorade Player of the Year Award after an illustrious career at Dallas Center-Grimes High School (IA).
