TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open up their lone series of the season against the New Hampshire FIsher Cats at PNG Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Yoyner Fajardo drove in a run with an RBI double, but Altoona dropped their series finale at Richmond, dropping the series four games to two.

A YOUNG MAN'S ARRIVAL: Infielder Termarr Johnson joined the Curve on Tuesday, August 27 ahead of their series with the Fisher Cats. At 20 years, 2 months and 16 days, <u>Johnson is the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve</u>, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve. At High-A Greensboro this season, Johnson helped the Grasshoppers earn a First Half title and batted .238/.372/.385/.757 with 17 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR, 46 RBI and 20-24 SB. He earned 78 walks in 110 games played. He ranked first in the SAL in walks (78) and runs scored (73), fifth in OBP (.372) and eighth in hits (94).

SIR SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has heated up at the plate since July 30 (21 games), he's batting: .333/.402/.449/.851 with 5 2B, 2 3B, 10 RBI, 3-4 SB. Siani had a season-long 11-game on-base streak end on August 25 during which he hit: .297 with a .409 on-base percentage.

ROAD Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng has one of the most dramatic home/road splits of any Eastern League player. In 58 road games, Cheng is batting .249 with a .772 OPS, totaling 10 2B, 10 HR, 29 RBI and 22 BB. In 50 home games, Cheng is batting . 181 with a .556 OPS totaling 6 2B, 1 HR, 18 RBI and 31 BB. Overall, Cheng has done a majority of his damage at the plate on the first pitch of his plate appearance where he's batting .362 with a 1.111 OPS in 47 at-bats that he's put the ball in play in an 0-0 count.

KERVIN AND THE GIANT PEACH: Infielder Kervin Pichardo had a 17-game on-base streak from July 23 - August 15, and has picked up right where he left off with hits in 5-of-8 games since. Pichardo has reached base safely in 22-of-26 games since July 23, during which he's hitting .269/.321/.510/.831 with 3 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR, 17 RBI and 2-2 SB. Since then he ranks T-2nd in the EL in HR (6), and, T-9th in SLG% (.510).

PROVIDING RELIEF: Altoona's bullpen has had a revolving door of talent this year, though of late **Cy Nielson** and **Emmanuel Chapman** have performed the best. Nielson has struck out 16 batters in 10.1 innings since his call-up from Greensboro and Emmanuel Chapman has a 2.13 ERA (42.1 IP / 10 ER), 40 strikeouts and a .152 BAA in his last 16 appearances (3 starts).

SETTING THE TABLE: Outfielder Yoyner Fajardo has led off 34 times with Altoona this season and has become one of the league's best leadoff hitters. Fajardo has recorded .416 on-base percentage as the team's table setter and he ranks all over the league leaderboards since June 1: 2nd in BA (.302), 2nd in OBP (.411), T-8th in 3B (3) and T-10th in SB (14).

THE CATS THAT FISH: Cesar Martin is back for his fourth season as the Manager for the Fisher Cats. New Hampshire has spent much of the season in the bottom of the standings for the Northeast Division and enter this week with 48 wins, the fewest in the Eastern League and third-fewest by a Double-A club. New Hampshire's roster is a bit light in the prospect department, though former Curve INF Charles McAdoo is currently manning the hot corner for the Fisher Cats. McAdoo was traded to the Jays in exchange for INF/OF Isiah Kiner-Falefa at the trade deadline this season.

THE FIRST MEOWER: Michael Dominguez takes the ball in the series opener for New Hampshire. Dominguez was born in Newport News, VA and was picked by the Jays in the 15h round in 2019 out of Thomas Jefferson High School in Tampa, Florida. Noteable alums from Thomas Jefferson High School include a pair of Hall of Fame players, Tony LaRussa and Fred McGriff and a pair of high quality bug leaguers in Lúis Gonzalez and Tino Martinez. Dominguez spent several weeks on New Hampshire's Development List this season and will make his third start since returning on Tuesday night. Last time out, he threw a rain-shortened complete game, allowing just one run in 5.0 innings against Hartford.
