

Century Mark

Reading continues this week's series in Hartford with game five tonight. The R-Phils won the season-series last night and lead 13-9 overall.

Reading matched a season high with four wins in a row with a 6-0 win last night. It was the R-Phils' second-shutout win of the season and first since May 28. Mick Abel went 5.1 frames and the bullpen followed by allowing just one hit over the final 3.2 innings. Matthew Kroon matched a season-high with four hits, while Casey Martin homered for the second-straight game and Oliver Dunn stayed hot with two hits and a homer.

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just three wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (43).

Oliver Dunn is having his best week of the season in Hartford. Through four games, Dunn's hitting 10-19 (.526)/4 HR/11 RBI/6 R/7 XBH. He has homered in three-of-four games in the series. The strong week has also elevated Dunn in many of the league rankings, which currently sit at: 2nd OBP, 5th BB, 3rd OPS, 4th RBI, 4th SLG, 8th AVG, T5th 2B and 10th HR.

Reading has enjoyed a lot of success of Hartford starting pitching this week. In 16.2 innings against Yard Goats' starters, Reading has put up 23 runs, with 22 of them earned. Hartford's starters hold an 11.88 ERA in the first-four games of this week's series.

Odds and Ends

After last night's shutout, Reading pitching has thrown 13-straight shutout innings. That is one shy of their season-high of 14, which happened in the Altoona series two weeks ago. Matthew Kroon's four hits last night matched a season-high, with his other on June 6 against Binghamton. Kroon raised his team-best average to .321, which is four-points behind first place in the Eastern League. Additionally, the one-through-six hitters in Reading's lineup combined last night: 11-23 (.478), 6 R, 4 XBH, 6 RBI, 5 BB, 2 SO, and also had a .571 on-base percentage.

Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to the Royals 7-5 last night as Johan Rojas had a two-run double in the loss. Lehigh Valley fell to Buffalo in a 7-6 slugfest. Cal Stevenson and Aramis Garcia each homered. Jersey Shore defeated Brooklyn as Matt Osterbeg earned a win over five-innings pitched. Marcus Lee Sang had two triples and three RBI. Clearwater beat Lakeland 7-6 as Cade Fergus homered to complete a 3-1 night for Phillies' affiliates.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 5, 2009: At Reading, an all-time record crowd of 9,953 packs FirstEnergy Stadium to see Pedro Martinez continue his comeback to Major League Baseball. Martinez picks up the win, going 6.0 innings, giving up 4 runs (3 earned) on 5 hits and striking out 11 Trenton hitters. All nine Thunder starters are fanned by Martinez at least once. Also, top prospect Domonic Brown connects for his first Double-A home run in the 1st inning, sending a rocket over the pool pavilion and out onto Centre Avenue.

Hey Hartford

Hartford enters tonight with a 12-17 second-half record, and are 41-55 overall in 2023. Last week, the Yard Goats took three-of five from New Hampshire. Next week, Hartford heads north for a series ar Portland. Hunter Goodman leads Hartford with 25 home runs, which is a new Yard Goats' single season record for home runs. Hartford ranks 11th in the Eastern League with a .230 average, and sit last with a 5.55 ERA.

Righty Tanner Gordon gets the start tonight for Hartford, in what will be his first appearence against Reading this season. In his lone start for Hartford, Gordon went 5.2 innings and allowed just two runs on six strikeouts in a win. Gordon was traded from the Braves to Rockies on July 24, along with Victor Vodnik for pitcher Pierce Johnson. With Double-A Mississippi this season, Gordon went 4-5 with a 4.61 ERA over 11 starts. He also made six appearences for Triple-A Gwinnett. Last season, Gordan split the year between High-A Rome and Mississippi. Gordan was selected by the Braves in the sixth round in 2019 out of Indiana.

Overall, he's 1-0 with 12 ER allowed across 19.1 IP, which included allowing six-earned runs over 3.2 IP on May 3. Remaining starts against Hartford he allowed three runs or less each time, which included win on June 17, with 3 ER allowed over six innings. Recently, he had a stretch of six-straight starts with decisions (4-2) from June 17-July 22. Stretch included all starts over five innings, including four of six innings. In last start against Binghamton (July 29), Parkinson went a season-high 6.2 innings, and allowed just one run on three hits. Also tossed season-high ten strikeouts on July 14 in win against Portland and also had nine strikeouts on June 23 at Portland. Made one appearence with Triple-A Lehigh Valley on June 3.
