- The Jays dropped the series finale against Tampa, allowing a season-high 15-runs. With the loss, Dunedin settled for a series split.
- Blue Jays pitchers allowed a season-high 12 walks.
- Tampa jumped ahead in the first inning, scoring four times capped off by a 3-run homer by Dylan Jasso.
- The lead swelled to 8-0 before Dunedin responded in the bottom of the fifth, scoring four runs without a hit using five walks and three wild pitches.
- The Tarpons scored three more times in the top of the sixth. The Blue Jays responded with three in the bottom half, highlighted by RBIs from Victor Arias and Tucker Toman.
- Tampa pulled away once and for all in the seventh, scoring three times, before tacking on another tally in the eighth.

HIGH FIVE

After being held to four or fewer runs in 11 consecutive games, the Blue Jays scored five or more in the final three games of the series with Tampa. Dunedin is 10-3 when scoring five or more runs this season.

K COUNTER

Blue Jays pitchers racked up 74 strikeouts in six games last week - the second most in all of Single-A last week. Tampa's hurlers weren't far behind, picking up 68 punchouts (6th in Single-A).

FREE PASSES

Dunedin's pitching staff issued a season-high 12 walks on Sunday. The Jays pitching staff is second in the Florida State League with 136 walks. However, Dunedin is also top three in the league in walks drawn with 125 (3rd, behind Lakeland and Tampa).

SLIMMEST OF MARGINS

Sunday's loss was a rare lopsided decision for Dunedin, as 13 of the Blue Jays' last 15 contests have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has gone 4-9 in those games. Thursday night's 6-run win by the Tarpons marked Dunedin's first game decided by more than four runs in over two weeks (April 17 vs Clearwater).

SUPER 8TH

The Blue Jays tallied 10 8th inning runs in last week's series with Tampa - including Cristian Feliz's go-ahead 2-run homer on Saturday night.

FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

Cristian Feliz's two-homer performance Saturday night marked the first by a Blue Jay this season. Feliz's second homer traveled 431 feet - the 5th longest homer in the Florida State League this season. Dunedin's last two-homer game came from Jace Bohrofen on August 16 last year.

IN THE ARIAS TONIGHT

Victor Arias ranks among the league's leading hitters in nearly every major rate stat. Arias is top 10 in average (7th - .319), OBP (8th - .413), SLG (7th - .478), and OPS (4th - .891). Arias has more multi-hit games (7) than hitless games (5).

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

Today's starting pitcher, LHP Connor O'Halloran, is the son of former Major League catcher Greg O'Halloran, who had a brief stint with the Florida Marlins in 1994. Both O'Hallorans made their professional debuts with the Dunedin Blue Jays: Connor last season, and Greg in 1990.

BULLPEN BLEMISHES

Dunedin's bullpen surrendered nine earned runs in 5.1 innings in Sunday's loss. Despite the tough day at the office, the Blue Jays' bullpen owns the third-best ERA in the Florida State League at 3.82. Opponents are hitting just .197 against Dunedin's 'pen - the best mark in the league.

YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

- Native of Mississauga, Ontario one of three native Canadians on the Dunedin roster. Played on the Canadian 18U national team for three seasons, from 2018-2020.
- Dad, Greg O'Halloran, was drafted by the Blue Jays in 1988. Made professional debut with Dunedin in the 1990 MiLB season. Eventually debuted and played 12 games as a catcher with the Marlins in 1994.
- Also played hockey and volleyball growing up, but chose baseball.
- Throws from a low, three-quarter slot... fastball sits in the low-to-mid 90s, with a slider in the low 80s, along with a mid-80s change.
