### PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings re-set for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game with the best overall record in Minor League Baseball, 26 games over .500 with a 53-27 record (.663 winning%).

- 53 wins are tied for the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, tied with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .663 winning percentage overall this year is also the best, just ahead of Sugar Land (.653-29 / .646).
- Omaha has held the best record in Minor League Baseball for 27 days, since June 5 ... the Chasers have been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25.

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

51 of Omaha's 80 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 18 of 27 losses in 2024.

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 5 of its last 11 save opportunities, since June 5.
- Omaha is 17-8 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... the Storm Chasers have won 10 of their last 15 games decided by just a run.
- As a team, Omaha's 25 saves are the 4th-most of any Minor League team and second in Triple-A ... Will Klein's 9 saves individually rank 3rd in the International League, while six Storm Chasers players have 2 or more saves this year.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 450 to 360 this season, a +90 run differential.

- A +90 run differential is the 2nd-best in the International League and at the Triple-A level, just behind the Syracuse Mets (+93).
- Omaha ranks 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +147 (499 to 352).

#### COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 30 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (57%) of this year's wins have been comeback victories.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 11 of the 30 comeback wins, with five victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 8 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

#### DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 20 games (since June 9), a .988 fielding percentage (8 errors in 691 total chances) is the 3rd-best in Minor League Baseball over that span.
- Early in the season, the Storm Chasers went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7, that included all 6 games of a series at Columbus, April 3 to April 7.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.32 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .207/.320/.346 ... the .207 opponents' average is tied for the 5th-best in the Minors ... a 3.59 ERA ranks 2nd in Triple-A.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 19 games this year, roughly one in every 4.21 games.
- Since June 14, Omaha's bullpen has a 2.73 ERA (20 ER in 66.0 IP), the 2nd-best in Triple-A in that 17-game stretch.
- Walter Pennington's 75 strikeouts (in 31 games/2 starts) are tied for the 9th-most in the International League ... his 35.7% strikeout rate is 8th in MiLB (min. 50.0 IP).
- Noah Murdock made his Triple-A debut just under three weeks ago in Toledo and opened his Triple-A career with 7 straight scoreless appearances, totalling 8.0 scoreless innings between June 11 and June 29, with 3 walks and 9 strikeouts.
