and struct out a second sheet for hitters. Reading scored two runs in the fourth, with one coming on another RBI from Hendry Mendez and then tacked on an insurance tally in the seventh when Luis Verdugo knocked an RBI double. Nelson Alvarez picked up his fourth save in the game two victory.

It's Miller Time Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller is currently riding a season-high seven-game hitting streak, and is slashing .391/.462/.609 (1.071 OPS) over that stretch. Miller has now reached base in 26 of his last 29 games played in, dating back to April 12 and has a .352 on-base percentage over that span. Miller has also proven to be a threat on the base paths as his 13 steals rank tied for sixth in the Eastern League.

Go Keaton Go

Keaton Anthony stayed red-hot with a double and two hits on Tuesday. He had doubles in five-straight games from May 15-20, which marked the first time a Fightin Phil had doubled in five-straight games since Carlos Rivero did it from May 17-22, 2011. Since May 7 (10 games), Anthony is slashing .405/.463/.703 (1.166 OPS), with six runs, eight doubles, one home run and eight RBI. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 5th AVG (.319), 7th OBP (.382), 6th SLG (.526), 6th OPS (.908), 1st 2B (16), T-1st XBH (19).

Mashing Mendez

Hendry Mendez stayed hot with a home run and five-combined RBI between the two games Wednesday. He had two hits in three-straight games from May 18-21. Since May 14 (nine games), Mendez is slashing .419/.457/.774 (1.231 OPS), with seven runs, two doubles, three home runs and 10 RBI. Entering play today, Mendez is fourth in the Eastern League in average (.320), fifth in OBP (.392), 10th in OPS (.876), T-6th in htis (41) and T-9th in runs (23).

Let's Go Leandro

Leandro Pineda stayed red-hot with a hit in both games on Wednesday. He is on an eight-game hitting streak, dating back to May 15, and over the streak, he is slashing .444/.500/.630 (1.130 OPS), along with seven runs, five doubles and three RBI. After hitting just .104 in April, Pineda has posted a .321 average in May.

New Crowe in the Nest

The Phillies signed Wil Crowe prior to Tuesday's game at Portland. Crowe is returning to affiliated ball after spending 2024 with the Kia Tigers in the KBO in Korea. Over eight starts, Crowe went 5-1, with a 3.57 ERA. He last pitched in the United States in 2023, appearing in 17 games across three levels in Pittsburgh's system. Crowe has pitched parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the big leagues, most notably making 60 appearances with Pittsburgh in 2022 and starting 25 games for the Pitates in 2021.

Go Gabe Go

Gabe Mosser turned in his second-straight excellent start on Wednesday, allowing one run on three hits over six innings of work. Over his last two starts, Mosser is 2-0, with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER, 12.2 IP), along with six hits allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts.

Portland enters today with a 21-17 record, sitting in second place in the Northeast Division. Last week, Portland took two-of-five games at Somerset, with one game being postponned to June. Portland's roster features seven of Boston's top-30 prospects: Luis Perales (4), David Sandlin (8), Connelly Early (9), Mikey Romero (11), Allan Castro (22), Yordanny Monegro (23) and Blake Wehunt (27)

Portland Pitcher

Lefty Dalton Rogers makes his second Double-A start on Wednesday morning. In his Double-A debut, Rogers tossed five-shutout innings, allowing just two hits and striking out six, in a no-decision at Somerset last Thursday. Rogers began the season with Greenville (A+) and went 2-1, with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER, 20.2 IP) over five appearances and one start prior to his call up to Portland. Rogers spent all of 2024 with Greenville, going 2-7, with a 5.12 ERA over 21 games and 19 starts. The 24-year old was a third round pick of the Red Sox in the 2022 draft out of Southern Mississippi. He pitched at Southeatern Lousiiana in 2020 and spent one season with Southern Mississippi in 2022 prior to being drafted.
