YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Yard Goats, 10-7, to pick up their third straight win. The Yard Goats took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first with an RBI single by Sterlin Thompson. The Flying Squirrels jumped ahead, 2-1, with an RBI single by **Victor Bericoto** and a run scoring on an error in the bottom of the first. In the top of the second, Hartford tied the score with a run scoring on an error. Bericoto knocked a two-run single in the bottom of the second to move the Flying Squirrels ahead, 4-2. In the bottom of the third, the Flying Squirrels scored six runs to open a 10-2 lead. **Justin Wishkoski** clubbed a two-run homer, his first at Double-A. **Carter Howell** hit an RBI single and three runs scored on a **Jairo Pomares** single and an error. In the top of the fifth, **Warming Bernabel** hit an RBI single and Thompson brought in a run with a sac fly. In the top of the eighth, **Braxton Fulford** hit a solo homer and **Adael Amador** added a two-run single to pull the score to 10-7. **Jack Choate** started for Richmond in his Double-A debut and allowed four runs (three earned) over 4.1 innings. **Ben Madison** picked up his first win of the season with 1.1 scoreless innings. **Mat Olsen** closed out his fifth save.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, in the second of a six-game series. This is the only series between the two teams this season. Last year, the two teams met for six games at Dunkin Park in Hartford, with Richmond winning four-of-six. This set is the Flying Squirrels' final series this year against an opponent from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won three straight games after going 4-12 in their previous 16 games dating back to July 13. They had lost five straight games from Sunday through Friday before beating the Curve on Saturday night and Sunday afternoon. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .230 and averaging 3.87 runs per game (201 runs/52 games) at home compared to a .236 batting average and 4.71 runs per game on the road (240 runs/51 games).

THE YARD GOATS clinched their first postseason appearance in franchise history by winning the Northeast Division in the Eastern League's first half with a 38-30 record, finishing 2.5 games ahead of Binghamton and Portland. The Yard Goats will face the second-half division champ in this year's Eastern League playoffs. For the season, the Yard Goats lead the Eastern League in stolen bases (155). Hartford's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including RHP Chase Dollander (No. 2), OF Adael Amador (No. 3), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 4), INF Sterlin Thompson (No. 7), LHP Sean Sullivan (No. 16), SS Ryan Ritter (No. 25), and RHP Zach Agnos (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes nine Hartford players, including Dollander (No. 1), Amador (No. 2), Fernandez (No. 4), Thompson (No. 6), Sullivan (No. 13), INF Warming Bernabel (No. 16), RHP Bradley Blalock (No. 20), LHP Mason Albright (No. 22) and LHP Luis Peralta (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Nick Sinacola** makes his ninth Double-A start. He last pitched last Wednesday at Altoona and threw three scoreless innings in his first outing since July 13 after spending a week on the injured list. He made his Double-A debut on June 6 against the Curve at The Diamond and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings. In his next five starts from June 12-July 4, he went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP). Among Giants minor league pitchers (min. 70 IP), he leads the organization in BAA (.215), BB/9 (2.00) and WHIP (1.00). He also ranks second in ERA (2.93) and fifth in strikeout percentage (26.3%). He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. **For more on Sinacola, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Bradley Blalock makes his second appearance with the Rockies organization. He last pitched on Thursday at Reading and allowed four runs (three earned) over five innings in his Hartford debut. Blalock was traded to Colorado from the Milwaukee Brewers on July 27 along with another pitcher in exchange for RHP Nick Mears. He has spent most of the season with Double-A Biloxi in the Southern League, going 5-2 with a 4.08 ERA in 16 starts. On June 20, he was called up by the Brewers and made his MLB debut on June 20 at San Diego and pitched a scoreless inning. Blalock was selected in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Boston Red Sox out of Grayson High School in Georgia. He was traded from the Red Sox to the Brewers on August 1, 2023 for infielder Luis Urias.

COMEBACK KIDS: On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels came from behind to win after trailing by five runs early. The five-run comeback win was tied for the third-largest in franchise history. They have come back to win after trailing by six runs twice, first on July 28, 2017 against the SeaWolves in a 9-7 win and again on July 24, 2022 against the Baysox in a 7-6 victory. Sunday's 9-7 win was the eighth comeback win after trailing by five runs. The most recent prior to Sunday was on June 23, 2023 in the first game of a doubleheader against the Senators at The Diamond, capped with an eighth-inning, walk-off single by **Wade Meckler** for his team-record-tying fifth hit of the game. Sunday was the fourth comeback win after trailing by five-or-more runs under **Dennis Pelfrey**, this most for any manager in franchise history.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 74 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 71. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. It is also tied for the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

KING OF THE HILL: **Turner Hill** is batting .364 (12-for-33) with two doubles, a triple and five RBIs in his last nine games dating back to July 23, including three multi-hit games. Last Wednesday at Altoona, he picked up three hits, including a double. On Thursday night, he belted a bases-clearing, three-run double. Since his Double-A debut on June 27, Hill is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in batting average (.303).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 44 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .309 (54-for-175) with three homers, nine doubles, eight walks and 24 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 34 games. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 16-of-36 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .307 (43-for-140) in that stretch.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked seventh among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,665), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: There have been 58 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is two shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 29 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes an appearance by Andy Thomas on June 1 against the SeaWolves. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season. In last week's series at Altoona, three players made their Flying Squirrels debuts, including **Zach Morgan**, **Justin Wishkoski**, and **Julio Rodriguez**. Pitcher **Jack Choate** made his Double-A debut on Tuesday night against the Yard Goats.

PROSPECT WATCH: One of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, which is SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
