SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots took down the New Hampshire Fisher Cats on Friday night in a thrilling 8-7 late inning victory in game five of a seven-game series at Delta Dental Stadium in Manchester, NH.
- RHP Bailey Dees (5 IP, 3 R, 6 H, 2 BB, 6 K) took a no-decision in his ninth start of the season.
 - Over four starts in the month of May, Dees has pitched to a 2.29 ERA in 19.2 IP with 20 K/4 BB and a 1.02 WHIP.
 - Over his most recent eight starts since 4/13 @ NH, excluding his first start of the season, Dees owns a 2.70 ERA with 44 K in 40 IP.
- RHP Jesus Liranzo (2 IP, 0 R, 1 H, 0 BB, 3 K) earned his first win of the season.
- **C Agustin Ramirez** (3-for-4, 2 RBI, 2 R, 2 2B, SB) singled home the go-ahead run in the 9th inning, scoring Spencer Jones from 3rd with two outs to break a 7-7 tie, in addition to a 5th inning sacrifice fly.
 - o Friday marked Ramirez's 4th 3+ hit game of the season and 4th multi-XBH game.
 - The Yankees No. 20 prospect now has back-to-back multi hit efforts, and 10 multi-hit games this season.
 - Ramirez extended his season-long on-base streak to 13 games, the longest active streak on the team. During the stretch, which dates back to 5/9 @ALT, Ramirez is 17-for-47 (.361) with 10 RBI, 12 R, 5 BB and 5 SB.
 - Ramirez now leads the Eastern League with 12 HR, 32 RBI, 83 TB, and 34 R.
 - After swiping his 11th base in the contest, Ramirez is the only player in the Eastern League with double-digit HR (12) and SB (11) this season.
- **SS Ben Cowles** (1-for-3, HR, 2 RBI, R, 2 BB) lifted his 4th homer of the season, a two-run blast, to give Somerset a 3-0 lead in the 1st inning.
 - Cowles has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games.
 - The Yankees No. 29 prospect leads the Eastern League with a .329 average on the season.
 - o Friday marked Cowles's 7th multi-RBI game of the season.
- **DH Jasson Dominguez** (2-for-5) had his first hit on MLB rehab assignment with Somerset as part of a two-hit night in his third rehab game with the Patriots.
- **3B JC Escarra** (2-for-3, 3 RBI, 2 2B) extended Somerset's lead to 4-1 in the 4th inning with an RBI double, before his clutch two-out, two-RBI double in the 8th inning tied the ballgame at 7-7.
 - Friday marked Escarra's 8th multi-hit effort of the season and 5th multi-RBI game.
 - Escarra's 3 RBI in the contest are a season high.
