### TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Oklahoma City play game two of the six-game series at 7:05 p.m. CT on Wednesday night from Dell Diamond. E-Train RHP Spencer Howard will toe the rubber against Dodgers RHP Andre Jackson.

### TIME TO RECAP

Oklahoma City posted a shutout over Round Rock on Tuesday by a final score of 8-0. The scoring began in the second inning. Oklahoma City 2B Michael Busch and DH Ryan Noda each singled. C Tomás Telis added the third single of the inning and scored Bush to give the Dodgers a 1-0 lead. In the third, Busch drove in the first of three runs in the inning with a single that scored SS Zach McKinstry and advanced LF Eddy Alvarez to second base. Noda then scored Alvarez on a double and Busch crossed home on an Express error to extend the lead to 4-0. In the fifth, 3B Miguel Vargas was hit by a pitch to begin the frame and scored on an Alvarez double. Noda then collected his second RBI of the night on a single that sent Alvarez home as Oklahoma City held a 6-0 advantage. Vargas added on for Oklahoma City with a double that scored two runs and put the game out of reach for Round Rock. RHP Beau Burrows earned the win after 5.2 scoreless frames. He walked two and struck out eight. RHP Tyson Miller earned the loss after 3.0 innings and three earned runs.

### HOWARD TAKES THE HILL

Express RHP Spencer Howard will make his fifth start of the year. The righty has an 0-1 record and a 6.28 ERA (10 ER/14.1 IP). Howard has struck out 21 and walked seven. Opposing hitters are batting .333 against him this season.

### THE SNYDER STREAK CONTINUES

Round Rock RHP Nick Snyder tossed a scoreless ninth inning on Tuesday as he continues to not have allowed an earned run this season. He has tossed a Pacific Coast League-best 13 outings and 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings this year and has surrendered only five hits. He has tallied 16 strikeouts to only six walks. Snyder has appeared in two games for the Rangers this year and has allowed two runs in 1.0-inning of work.

### GOODBYE MAY, HELLO JUNE

The Express finished the month of May with a 15-11 record and plenty of offensive outbursts. Round Rock scored seven or more runs in 14 of their 26 games. In May, they led all of Triple-A in average (.290), runs (195) and hits (274). They were fourth in both home runs (40) and stolen bases (37).

### TERRIFIC THOMPSON

E-Train CF Bubba Thompson stole his 26th base last night. He leads the PCL in stolen bases and is tied for fourth in Minor League Baseball. The righty also leads the PCL in hits (55) and is tied for fourth in batting average (.333). In his last five games, Thompson is 10-for-24 with two home runs, seven RBI and five runs scored.

### STRUGGLING AGAINST OKC

The Express are 2-5 in their seven games this season against the Dodgers. Round Rock holds an 8.86 ERA (62 ER/63.0 IP) against Oklahoma City and the offense has been shut out twice by Dodgers pitchers. In the five losses, Round Rock has averaged two runs per game while in the two wins, they have averaged 13.5 runs per game.

### ROSTER MOVES

Following the promotion of INF Josh Smith and OF Zach Reks on Monday, the Texas Rangers announced RHP Kohei Arihara and INF Davis Wendzel were reinstated from the 7-day Injured List. INF Diosbel Arias joined Round Rock from the ACL Rangers and Texas Rangers RHP José Leclerc joined on a Major League rehab assignment. C Konner Piovto was transferred from Round Rock to the Arizona Complex League.

**EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN**

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.



Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
