IT'S LIKE AN OVEN OUT THERE: After a winning 12-game road trip and a seven-run comeback last night to steal the series opener from Kannapolis, the FredNats have won three out of the first four games of the second half and continue this hot home series tonight with Ballers (White Sox). Opening night starter Bryan Polanco gets the ball tonight for Fredericksburg trying to build off a start in Salem where he pitched six innings of four-hit, one-run ball with five strikeouts. He faces Kannapolis lefty Grant Umberger, who has been by far the best pitcher for the Ballers this year, posting a 2.54 ERA in 49.2 innings.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Fredericksburg erased a 7-0 deficit after three innings to mount the largest comeback of the season in a 10-9 walk-off win. Nate Ochoa got the winning hit in the 9th after the FredNat offense made a furious comeback, scoring seven runs in the final three innings. Luke Dickerson had a huge two-run single in the 8th, Francesco Barbieri drove in a run, Randal Diaz had an RBI double and scored the winning run, and eight out of the nine FredNat hitters had base hits. The FredNat bullpen pitched six innings and allowed just two runs (one earned).

**OCHOA MANIA:** After a very rough start to the month of June, Nate Ochoa has turned it around at the plate in his last two games. On Sunday in Salem, he hit a three-run home run and became the first FredNat this year to have five RBI in one game. Then, last night, he posted his second three-hit game of the season, driving in three more runs including the winning run. In Ochoa's first 35 games this year, he drove in 12 runs. In his last two, he has eight runs knocked in.

THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level in the month of June. FBG's bullpen ERA this month is 2.28, which is number two in Single-A behind Dunedin (2.26) and fourth in all of MiLB behind the Blue Jays, Pensacola (2.01) and Altoona (2.21). FBG's eight saves this month is also tied for the second-most in MiLB.

**SECOND HALF FREDDIES:** The FredNats have won the second half title in the North two out of the last three seasons, including last year's Carolina League championship season. Including last night's game, Fredericksburg is 119-79 (.600) in the second half, and those 119 wins are the second most in that time frame (since '22) in Single-A and High-A behind Charleston (125).

**DON'T EVEN TRY IT:** The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers this season. As a team, Fredericksburg's 53 caught stealings is tied for the MiLB lead with Fayetteville. Among the top four teams in that stat category, Fredericksburg has allowed 39 fewer total stolen bases than the next team. Bazzell is tied for the lead among qualified MiLB catchers with 33 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 300 innings this year, throwing out 40% of would-be base stealers. Rombach has 20 caught stealings himself, a top-10 mark in the Carolina League, and is throwing out 33% of potential base stealers this year.

**THREE BALL**: The FredNats turned the second triple play in Fredericksburg franchise history Friday night at Salem. Randal Diaz, Carlos Tavares and Luke Dickerson went 4-3-6 to turn it. The franchise's first triple play was also at Salem on May 26, 2023.

**NEW OWNERSHIP:** On Monday, June 9, it was announced that the Silber family sold the majority stake in the Fredericksburg Nationals to Diamond Baseball Holdings (DBH), becoming the 44th MiLB team DBH has purchased since its founding in 2021. The FredNats will remain the Nationals' Single-A affiliate in the Carolina League. Seth Silber has kept a minority ownership stake and will take on the President/CEO role overseeing day-to-day operations moving forward, and DBH has retained the entire front office staff.

**THE STAFF:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

**BUY IN BULK:** Polanco has been chomping up innings in the Carolina League over the past two years. Since the start of the 2024 season, no one has thrown more than Polanco's 154.1. He is one of just 15 pitchers with 100+ innings in that span and the only pitcher with 150+.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Polanco earned a well-deserved win on the road in Salem last week, throwing six one-run innings against the Sox. He allowed just four hits and struck out five hitters on just 73 pitches.

**CAROLINA COMFORT:** Polanco ranks in the top 10 in the Carolina League this year in ERA (3.96, 8th), innings pitched (61.1, 6th), batting average against (.227, 5th) and WHIP (1.19, 3rd).

**BLIP ON THE RADAR:** Polanco's last two starts have been a course correction after two blow up starts to end May and start June. Before last roadtrip, Polanco had allowed 14 earned runs in his previous two appearances after allowing just 11 earned in his first nine of the year.

**SPECIAL K:** Over his two starts on the roadtrip, Polanco struck out a combined 15 hitters, including a career-high 10 in Fayetteville. In his five years at the professional level, the 15 strikeouts are the most Polanco has tallied in any two-start stretch in his career.

**LONG BALL LATELY:** Polanco, uncharacteristically, allowed six home runs in a four start stretch between 5/25 and 6/14 after giving up just two in his first eight appearances of the year. No one else in the Carolina League allowed more than four in that span. Polanco did bounce back, however, and didn't allow a big fly in Salem.

### **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



#### JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



#### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



#### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
