The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Midland RockHounds 4-1 in the series finale from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Sunday afternoon. The Riders (23-16, 67-41) turned to **Emiliano Teodo** for the start and the righty went 3.1 innings, allowing just an unearned run on one hit while striking out three and walking two. His third strikeout was his 100th on the season, becoming the first RoughRiders pitcher to reach that mark this season. Midland (24-14, 64-43) found the scoreboard first on Sunday, scoring in the bottom of the third on a Brennan Milone sacrifice fly. Frisco then tied the game in the fourth when Luis Mieses scored on an RBI fielder's choice from Tucker Mitchell, his first career Double-A RBI. In the seventh, the Hounds took the lead when Milone doubled home a run over Daniel Mateo's head in center field against Seth Clark (1-1). They added on with two runs in the bottom of the eighth inning as well on a two-run single from Euribiel Angeles to push the lead to 4-1. Domingo Robles (5-2) earned the win, throwing four shutout innings from the bullpen while Ryan Cusick took him his second save of the season. At the plate, Josh Hatcher and Mateo had twohit games.

RoughRiders starting pitchers have been dominant over their last 12 games, owning a 1.55 ERA (10ER/58.0IP). Overall, Frisco has allowed just 28 earned runs in their last 12 games for a 2.42 ERA (104.0IP). The Riders have played incredibly close games over the road trip with 10 of the 12 games being decided by three runs or fewer (Frisco is 5-5 in those games).

Over the last 18 games, the Riders are third in the Texas League with a .717 OPS, second with a .257 batting average and are sixth with 3.8 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .169 (27-for-160) with runners in scoring position over their last 18 games.

### READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher Kumar Rocker has been fantastic in his three starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the three starts, he has pitched 11.0 shutout innings, allowing just five hits and one walk with 16 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 11.9 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their .700 winning percentage at home is first in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). Cody Freeman is slashing .339/.398/.594/.992 at home this season with nine of his 13 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

### **OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:**

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 31 games, he is hitting .303 (36-for-119)/.404/.521/.925 with 13 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. Over his last 28 games, he is batting .311 (33-for-106)/.422/.538/.960 with 11 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. He has reached in 28 of his 31 games with the Riders. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.14 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.46), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .228 BAA is on pace to tie the best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

### **ABOUT BEN**

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out thee side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by  $\operatorname{Tim}$  Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

### **2023 SEASON**

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

### **2022 SEASON**

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

### **2021 SEASON**

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.
