LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox dropped Sunday's series finale to Harrisburg 5-4, despite leading by two through seven innings. Harrisburg scored three runs in the eighth to salvage the series finale and snap Bowie's season-best five game win streak. Samuel Basallo drove in the first run of the game while Dylan Beavers drove in a pair on his 23rd birthday. On the mound, Patrick Reilly threw four innings and struck out four. The Baysox still took five of six in the series to claim their first series win since the beginning of the second half.

WE'VE GOT THE RUNS

Bowie scored 42 runs in last week's series against Harrisburg, the third-most amongst Double-A teams. The Baysox also placed third amongst Double-A teams in OPS (.921). In July, the Baysox scored 69 runs, the fourth-fewest in Double-A.

FELIZ CUMPLEANOS BASALLO

C/1B Samuel Basallo, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, turns 20 today. The No. 2 O's/No. 12 MLB prospect leads the Eastern League in total bases (166) and is tied for 2nd among active Eastern League players in hits (102). Basallo is leading all qualified Eastern League hitters in August with a .432 batting average (16-for-40).

BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. was officially promoted from High-A Aberdeen to Double-A Bowie today. At the time of promotion, the Orioles 2023 first rounder stole 59 bases, which led the South Atlantic League and was second in all of Minor League Baseball. Bradfield is the No. 4 Orioles prospect and the top Orioles outfield prospect, according to MLB Pipeline.

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF Jud Fabian is tied for the Eastern League lead in home runs with 17 on the season. Amongst all Double-A hitters, he is tied for 4th in home runs. The O's No. 8 prospect has 32 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF Frederick Bencosme recorded his first four-RBI game at Double-A with his first career grand slam on Friday. The Orioles No. 24 prospect has tallied a hit in 14 of his last 16 games. Over his last 15 games, the 21-year-old is batting .417 (20-for-48) with three doubles, two homers and 11 RBI.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** celebrated his 23rd birthday on Sunday with a two-run single in the second inning. The Orioles No. 5 prospect set a new a career-high in home runs last week with his 12th of the season. The 22-year-old has reached base in 75 of 93 games played and is tied for second in the Eastern League in walks (52) and tied for third in stolen bases (25).

SECOND HALF SILAS

C Silas Ardoin is batting a team-best .362 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .483 and OPS of .909. The 23-year-old has hits in nine of his last 10 games. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 23 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve are tied for fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 16-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Pirates has won 10 of the last 11 games against the Baysox. Six of the Pirates top 30 prospects are on the Curve active roster - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 3), SS Tsung Che-Cheng (No. 8), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 13), OF Jase Bowen (No. 17), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 24), LHP Jaden Woods (No. 30)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Po-Yu Chen takes the hill for the Curve tonight. Chen has thrown the fourthmost innings in the Eastern League (114.1) and has the eighth-best ERA (3.89). The 22-year-old recorded a 1.89 ERA in the month of July over 33.1 innings. The Taoyuan City, Taiwan native has a career 4.01 ERA in five outings against Bowie.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

### **CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX**

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organizations. All Ribens, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain basebal team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia an New Zealand in 2011.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

### CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.
