### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox took down the Hartford Yard Goats by a 13-8 final Friday night. Bowie got a career-high matching 4 RBI form TT Bowns, including a bases-clearing double that highlighted a 6-run top of the first. Billy Cook also contributed a pair of RBI in the sixth on a run-scoring triple, while Connor Pavolony mashed his first home run of the season. Alex Pham produced four innings of two-run ball out of the gate for Bowie, and while the bullpen struggled in the middle phase of the game, Logan Rinehart and Keagan Gillies combined to collect the final 11 outs without allowing a run in the process. Kade Strowd tossed a scoreless third of an inning and picked up the win for Bowie.

### A GLANCE AT THE GOATS

The Hartford Yard Goats are coming off a 57-76 campaign in 2023, finishing last overall in the Northeast division. The Baysox took two of three from the Yard Goats at Dunkin' Park to open last season in the only meeting between the two teams. The Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, Hartford is led by first-year skipper Bobby Meacham. The Yard Goats roster includes four of the Rockies' top-six prospects, per MLB Pipeline - 2B Adael Amador (No. 1 COL), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 3 COL), IF/OF Sterlin Thompson (No. 5 COL), and OF Zac Veen (No. 6 COL).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Connor Van Scoyoc gets the ball in game one of the twin-bill for Hartford. Van Scoyoc was acquired by the Rockies from the Angels' organization in the Mike Moustakas deal in June of 2023. The No. 30 Rockies' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, features a fastball, curveball, and change-up. LHP Carson Palmquist is game two's projected starter, coming off five shutout innings in his season debut on Sunday in Portland. Palmquist is the No. 15 prospect in the Rockies' system, and showcases a fastball, slider, and changeup.

### FAMILIAR FACES

The Baysox have a couple individuals returning close to home this week. Both IF TT Bowns and first-year manager Roberto Mercado are Connecticut natives. Before joining the Orioles' organization in 2022, Mercado coached for 17 seasons at New Britain High School and led them to three conference championships, while also serving as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He currently resides in the offseason with his family in the Dunkin' Park area. Bowns is a New London native and played four years collegiately at Central Connecticut State, winning a pair of conference championships, before signing with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent, following the shortened 2020 draft.

### WAY OF THE K

Baysox pitching is second the Eastern League in strikeouts through the first few games of the season, with 75 of them through six games. The Baysox have accumulated double-digit strikeout totals in each of the first six games this season, with relievers totaling a league-high 46 punchouts.

### LOCK UP YOUR VALUABLES

Both the Baysox and Yard Goats have been running rampant with stolen bases in 2024. Bowie (9/9) and Hartford (5/15) lead the league in stolen bases, and are two of four sides that have yet to be caught stealing and have attempted at least seven steals. Bowie has gone 3/3 so far this week, while Hartford has gone a perfect 9/9.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers ended last season on a tear with the Baysox. After hitting .337 with a .443 OBP in August, winning Orioles Minor Leaguer of the Month for his debut month at the Double-A level, Beavers finished strong. His .321 average ranked second-highest in the Eastern League through the final two months of the 2023 season (min 130 PA), while his .417 OBP led the way. The 2022 first round pick out of Cal enters 2024 as the No. 7 prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline.

### BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo is coming off a monster season. At just 19 years old, the phenom catcher finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

**Returns for his third stint with Baysox. First full healthy season since 2021.**

**2023:** Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made one start on June 26. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on June 28 to continue rehab assignment. Made one start and went 3.0 scoreless innings. Assigned to High-A Aberdeen on July 4 to continue rehab assignment. Made two starts and struck out 11 over 7.0 innings, giving up just one earned run. Sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

**2022:** Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

**2021:** Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went three innings and gave up four runs (three earned) with four strikeouts in his Double-A debut against Akron. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 strikeouts over 60.2 innings and an ERA of 3.86.

**2019:** Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

### CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

### CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
