## **SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

SETTING THE NEW MARK: OF Jackson Chourio hit his 18th home run of the year on Wednesday, bringing home his 75th and 76th RBI of the year, setting the new Shuckers' single-season record... Chourio broke the previous record of 74, set by **OF Johnny Davis** in 2018.

📚 Since the start of July, Chourio has driven in 29 runs in 35 games... Through the first five months of the season, including August, Chourio has driven in at least 15 runs in three months.

WHY DO WE LIKE HIM? HE GETS ON BASE: OF Carlos Rodriguez enters today with a 18-game on-base streak, his longest streak of the year, and one of six Shuckers to record a streak of at least 18 games in 2023... Over his most recent streak (July 30 - Today), Rodriguez is hitting .343 (24-70) with six doubles, a home run and seven walks... Entering today, Rodriguez has tallied multiple hits in nine of his last 12 games.

A RECORD-BREAKING PACE: The Biloxi Shuckers have scored 630 runs through the first 116 games, 34 runs away from breaking the franchise single-season record, set in 2022 [664]... 2023 marks the second straight year that the Shuckers have scored at least 600 runs in a season after the Shuckers never crossed 600 runs in a season during their first six

- SENTER ENTRY IN EACH THE SHUCKERS ARE ON PACE TO SCORE 749 runs, crossing 700 runs in a season for the first time in franchise history (since 2015).
- The Shuckers would break the record for the most runs scored by a Brewers' Double-A affiliate since 2005, breaking the previous record set by the Huntsville Stars in 2008 (733)... The Stars finished with 733 runs during a 140-game season.

CLOSING IN ON HISTORY: OF Jackson Chourio enters today two home runs away from becoming the first teenager in Double-A or Triple-A to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season since OF Delmon Young in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB)... Chourio's 34 stolen bases are the most by a teenager in Double-A since INF Elvis Andrus stole 51 with the Frisco RoughRiders (Double-A, TEX) in 2008.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would qualify for the 2023 Southern League Playoffs, their first appearance since 2019.

- The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division.
- The Shuckers have a one-game lead on the Montgomery Biscuits and a two-game lead on the Blue Wahoos for the division lead... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TJ SHOOK [5-4, 5.09]: RHP TJ Shook will make his eighth start of the year and his fifth appearance against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos... Last time out, Shook struck out seven over five shutout innings against the Mississippi Braves... At MGM Park, Shook has a 3.02 ERA, one of 15 Southern League pitchers (min. 40 IP) with an ERA under 3.05 at their home ballpark.
