INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: In his first appearance with the Indianapolis Indians since April 8, 2023, No. 9 Pirates prospect Mike Burrows worked 4.0 innings of one-run ball in a 7-2 win over the lowa Cubs on Thursday night at Principal Park. Burrows retired the first six men he faced before the I-Cubs struck for their lone run against him in the bottom of the hird. However, the Indians had already jumped out to a 4-0 lead thanks to a two-run double from Jake Lamb and a two-run single from Malcom Nuñez in the top half of the inning against lowa starter Riley Thompson. The Indians added a run in the fifth inning before plating two more in the top of the eighth on a throwing error and a sacrifice fly.

BE LIKE MIKE: RHP Mike Burrows returned to the Indians starting rotation last night for the first time since April 8, 2023, and tossed 4.0 one-run innings with no walks and five strikeouts. He fired in 42 of his 60 pitches for strikes, with his four-seam fastball topping out at 95.0 MPH. Burrows made six starts between FCL Pirates and Single-A Bradenton this season while rehabbing from Tommy John surgery, going 0-2 with a 8.56 ERA (13er/13.2ip) and 14 strikeouts. In 15 career Triple-A outings (13 starts) since 2022, he is 1-4 with a 4.75 ERA (28er/53.0ip) and 50 strikeouts.

SHORTY SHINES: Aaron Shortridge made his second appearance with the Indians and first out of the bullpen last night, throwing 4.0 one-run innings (unearned) with just one hit, one walk and six strikeouts while piggybacking with Mike Burrows. The performance earned Shortridge his first win since Sept. 20, 2023, vs. Rochester in his Triple-A debut. Shortridge threw 44 of 68 pitches for strikes. In two games (one start) with Indy this season, he has allowed two runs (one earned) with eight strikeouts in 8.0 innings. The right-hander began the season on the injured list and began a minor league rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates on June 17. He made five appearances (four starts) between the FCL and High-A Bradenton, going 0-1 with a 1.76 ERA (3er/15.1ip), 25 strikeouts, 0.91 WHIP and .222 batting average against.

CAN'T WITHHOLD WILLIAMS: Alika Williams is working an incredible stretch vs. the I-Cubs this week, reaching base safely in 12 of 15 plate appearances over six games at Principal Park. Last night, he reached base safely in all five of his plate appearances, leading the Indians offense with three hits and two walks. His trio of base hits, including one double, extended his hitting streak to seven straight games since July 14 vs. Columbus. In that time, he is hitting 400 (10-for-25) with six runs, two doubles, nine walks and a .559 on-base percentage.

RAKE LAMB'S RIBBIES: Jake Lamb roped a two-run double in the third inning, going 1-for-2 with two runs, two walks and three RBI in the contest. His three RBI performance was his second in his past three games, and he has now driven in at least one run in five of his last six games since coming back from the All-Star break.

MASHING VS. THE I-CUBS: The Indians have launched 23 of their 88 home runs in 15 total games against the lowa Cubs, their most home runs against a single opponent this season. Fourteen of those home runs came during a six-game series at Principal Park from May 21-26, with the Indians launching a season-high six long balls on May 23. Including Tuesday night's four-homer outburst and two grand slams on Wednesday, the Indians now have launched 20 home runs in eight games in Des Moines this season. Individually, Matt Gorski leads the pack with five homers in 12 games against lowa. Below is a list of the hottest Indians hitters against the I-Cubs and their stats.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue a nine-game road trip with the fourth of six games at lowa tonight at 8:08 PM ET. The Indians mashed at Principal Park over six games in May, launching a staggering 14 home runs (see above). In 15 total games vs. lowa, the Indians are 10-5 after winning a six-game set at Victory Field from June 18-23. Continuing the six-game set for Indianapolis today is RHP Jake Woodford (1-5, 4.16), who tossed 6.0 one-run innings with six strikeouts in his last start vs. lowa on June 20. Countering for the I-Cubs is RHP Brandon Birdsell (0-2, 6.10), who has made just two Triple-A starts this season.

CHOPPIN' WOOD(FORD): Jake Woodford makes his seventh start with the Indians tonight, looking to continue his dominant stretch for the Indians. On July 20 at Omaha he, tossed 5.0 two-run innings and exited the contest with a 4-2 lead. Since making his Pirates organization debut on June 14 at Jacksonville, he is 0-2 with a 2.37 ERA (8er/30.1ip) and 30 strikeouts in six starts. He ranks among International League qualifiers with a 1.23 WHIP (3rd), 4.16 ERA (8th) and .249 batting average against (9th) for the season between Charlotte and Indy. Woodford has now logged at least 5.0 innings in 11 of his last 12 starts dating back to April 24 with Charlotte at Lehigh Valley and 13 of his 16 starts this season between teams.

THIS DATE IN 1967: Trailing 5-2 in the middle of the eighth at old Victory Field, the Indians plated one run in the eighth and two in the ninth to force extra innings, where they won in 11 frames, 6-5. Slugging first baseman Jim Hicks clubbed his 15th home run as part of a four-hit game, and Charles Nash belted his 13th homer while driving in three.
