INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians capitalized on three blasts courtesy of Liover Peguero, Edward Olivares and Jose Rojas and 4.0 shutout innings from Isaac Mattson to extend their win streak to eight games in a 7-5 triumph over the Toledo Mud Hens on Wednesday night at Victory Field. Peguero and Olivares combined on a pair of solo home runs in the second and third inning to give Indy an early lead. The offense tacked on two insurance runs in the fifth, the first thanks to a throwing error by Mud Hens catcher Stephen Scott on a double steal by Olivares and Matt Gorski. Nick Yorke, acquired via trade by Pittsburgh from the Boston Red Sox on Monday, chipped in a sacrifice fly to cap the inning. Indianapolis added three runs between the seventh and eighth inning on a Henry Davis RBI single and two-run home run by Rojas. Toledo failed to create any offense until the ninth, when the Mud Hens put up five runs on three hits and three walks in a late-inning scare. Ben Heller entered with the bases loaded and one out and issued a four-pitch walk to Spencer Torkelson. Yorke then speared a onehop smash at second base off the bat of Jace Jung that put the tying run in scoring position, but Heller rang up Justice Bigbie on three pitches to seal the triumph

ABOUT LAST MONTH: The Indians finished the month of July with a 14-7 record (.667 winning percentage), their best record in the month during the Victory Field era. Their previous best record in July came in 1996 when they went 17-12 (.586) overall with a 13-8 record (.619) at the Vic after moving to the corner of West and Maryland on July 11.

GONE STREAKIN': The Indians' victory yesterday extended their win streak to eight games, their longest since winning eight straight games from May 16-21, 2017. Their current streak is tied with two other instances for the second-longest streak in the Victory Field era, joining that 2017 streak and an eight-gamer from June 27-July 4, 2012. The Victory Field era record stands at 14 straight wins from July 28-Aug. 9, 1997.

JOSE'S HOMERS: With a two-run homer in the eighth inning that ended up being the difference in last night's victory for the Indians, newly-acquired Jose Rojas is now tied for the fifth-most home runs in the International League with 19 this season. Rojas, playing in just his fourth game with the Indians, went 2-for-4 with a double and the eighth-inning blast, and now ranks fifth among IL qualifiers with a .551 slugging percentage. The slugger began the season with Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre and hit .254 (58-for-228) with 14 doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 57 RBI, a .561 slugging percentage and .920 OPS before being released and signing with Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent.

HANK HITTIN': Henry Davis extended his hit streak to 11 games since July 13 vs. Columbus with a pair of singles last night. It is the longest hit streak of his career, besting his previous career-high nine-game streak set from April 23-May 9, 2023, with Double-A Altoona. In that time, he is hitting .391 (18-for-46) with eight runs, six extra-base hits, 12 RBI, a .440 on-base percentage and 1.082 OPS. Davis now owns the second-longest hit streak by an Indians batter this season and is three games shy of tying Nick Gonzales' team-leading 14-game hitting streak from April 6-24. His 11-gamer is also tied with Mud Hen Riley Unroe for the longest active streak in the International League.

LIFTOFF: Liover Peguero launched his ninth home run of the season last night and his fourth during the month of July. After a slow start to the month, Peguero has picked up and hit safely in six of his last seven games since smacking his first career grand slam on July 24 at lowa. In that time, he owns a .267 batting average (8-for-30) with five runs, one double, three home runs and a staggering 13 RBI.

OUTTA HERE FOR OLIVARES: Edward Olivares continued a recent hot streak with the Indians with his first Triple-A home run of the season last night. After jumping out to a slow start, the outfielder has hit .321 (9-for-28) with six runs, two extra-base hits, two RBI, two walks, just three strikeouts and six stolen bases over his last seven games since July 14. In 55 games with Pittsburgh to begin the season, Olivares launched five home runs and swiped just one base.

SWPIERS KEEP SWIPING: Coming out of the All-Star Break, the Indians have stolen 21 bases in 11 games against Omaha (6 SB), Iowa (10 SB) and Toledo (5 SB). They stole 23 total bases in just 20 July games, which is their most stolen bases in a month this season after stealing 19 bases in 28 May games.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their six-game homestand vs. the Toledo Mud Hens, Triple-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, at Victory Field tonight at 7:05 PM. The two teams split a six-game series at Victory Field from May 14-29. Indianapolis snapped Toledo's six-game winning streak on Tuesday night and last night extended its own winning streak to eight games since July 23. Continuing the series tonight for Indy is RHP Luis Cessa (4-4, 4.29), who made seven starts with the Mud Hens in 2015. He has faced his former team four times since, going 2-2 with a 1.83 ERA (5er/24.1ip) and 19 strikeouts. Countering for the Mud Hens is LHP Andrew Vasquez (5-2, 5.53), who has faced Indianapolsi five times already this season with a 2-0 record, 4.05 ERA (3er/6.2ip) and five strikeouts.

CESSA TAKES THE BUMP: After earning his second win with Indianapolis and fourth of the season in his last start at lowa on 7/27, RHP Luis Cessa takes the bump tonight for his eighth appearance (seventh start) in an Indians uniform. Last week, he was one earned run shy of his first quality start of the season after fanning six over a season-high 6.0 innings. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on June 10 and is 1-2 with a 4.87 ERA (11er/20.1ip) and 12 strikeouts in six games (five starts).

THIS DATE IN 2015: Tyler Glasnow made his Triple-A debut and struck out seven batters in 5.1 innings. He surrendered four runs (one earned) and took a nodecision as Indy mounted a comeback to defeat Charlotte in 13 innings at Victory Field, 6-5. Glasnow made six starts in August 2015 for the Indians and finished the month 1-0 with a 0.81 ERA (3er/33.1ip) and 39 strikeouts. He didn't allow a run in his final 17.1 innings (three starts) to close out the month.

Luis Cessa: Right-hander Luis Cessa is set to make his eighth outing (seventh start) with the Indians tonight after being signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on June 10. He began the season with Omaha and went 2-2 with a 3.89 ERA (17er/39.1ip).

Last Outing: Cessa struck out six batters across a season-high 6.0 innings on 7/27 at lowa to earn his second win with the Indians and fourth of the season.

Against the Mud Hens: Cessa faced Toledo four times from 2016-17 with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. In those games, he went 2-2 with a 1.83 ERA (5er/24.1ip) and 19 strikeouts.

Miscellaneous: Signed by New York (NL) as an international free agent on July 7, 2008. ... Had his contract first selected by Detroit on Nov. 3, 2015 before being traded to New York (AL) one month later. ... Made his MLB debut with the Yankees on on April 8, 2016 at Detroit. ...
