Who's Hot: Outfielder **Maciel** went 1-for-4 with a double and two hard lineouts last night; the native Brazilian leads the Lugnuts with a .400 average, a .471 on-base percentage and a .938 OPS this season.

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buevas** (No. 10) and **Euribiel Angeles** (No. 11), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 19), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 21) and pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 22).

In Memoriam: Former Lansing Lugnuts general manager **Patrick Day** passed away suddenly of a heart attack this past week. His memorial service will be held this coming Thursday at the Peoria Sports Complex in Peoria, Arizona, from 3-5 p.m. Eastern.

Lugnut Reunion: The Oakland Athletics, the Lugnuts' current parent club, is in the midst of a three-game series in Toronto against the Lugnuts' former parent club, the Blue Jays. The A's feature former Nuts **Kevin Smith**, **Zach Logue**, **Zach Jackson** and **Dany Jiménez**, while the Blue Jays have **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, **Cavan Biggio**, **Bo Bichette**, **Alejandro Kirk**, **Tim Mayza** and **Jordan Romano**. Jiménez earned the win in relief yesterday as the A's prevailed 7-5.

No. 162: Reliever **Zach Jackson**, a member of the 2017 Lugnuts pen, made his MLB debut on April 9 for the Oakland Athletics. In doing so, he became the 162nd all-time Nut to reach the Majors. There are currently 15 Major League teams with at least one Lugnut representing, totaling 31 players, including four (Jackson, **Dany Jiménez**, **Kirby Sneed** and **Kevin Smith**) on the A's and one (**Drew Hutchison**) on the Detroit Tigers.

No. 163? 2018 Nuts pitcher **Zach Logue** was called up to the Major Leagues yesterday by the Oakland Athletics just in time to play a series at old parent club Toronto.

Record-Breaking: On April 10, reliever **Jordan Romano**, a member of the 2016 Lugnuts starting rotation, broke Tom Henke's Toronto Blue Jays franchise record with his 26th consecutive save, closing out the Yankees in a 3-0 Blue Jays win.

Welcome Back: The Nuts return one coach (hitting coach **Javier Godard**) and 12 players from 2021, pitchers **Osvaldo Berrios**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **David Leal**; catcher **Jared McDonald**; infielders **Brett Harris**, **Patrick McColl** and **Drew Swift**; and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros**, **Austin Beck**, **Jonny Butler** and **Lawrence Butler**.

Recent Acquisitions: Three Lugnuts – pitcher **Joey Estes**, infielder **Euribiel Angeles** and outfielder **Gabriel Maciel** – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman Matt Olson on March 14, 2022; Angeles was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher Sean Manaea on April 3, 2022; and Maciel was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021.

International Appeal: In addition to 15 states plus Puerto Rico represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, the 2022 Nuts hail from Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

Down the Ladder: After losing their first five games this year, the Stockton Ports have caught fire with three consecutive wins. The latest came late last night, a 6-5 triumph over the Modesto Nuts behind a monster game from outfielder **Daniel Bautista** (son of former Detroit Tiger Danny Bautista), who went 3-for-3 with two walks and a game-ending diving catch. Stockton is averaging nearly seven runs per game and is slashing .276/.360/.453 as a team for an offensive OPS of .812. 2021 first-rounder **Max Muncy** is faring particularly well, hitting .333/.424/.778 with three home runs and 12 RBIs in seven games.

26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2017: The Dayton Dragons knocked out Andy Ravel in the first inning, scoring seven runs for a 7-1 lead at Fifth Third Field, only to see Bradley Jones belt a game-tying three-run homer in the seventh and then another three-run homer in the eighth for a 13-9 Lugnuts victory at Fifth Third Field. Jones outperformed both Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., to start the year, hitting .326/.394/.560 with 10 doubles, three triples and nine homers in 49 games before a promotion to Dunedin, but decided to step away from baseball after getting married in 2018.

Personal: Drafted in the 20th round in 2017 from the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School (Gurabo, Puerto Rico) and signed away from Alabama State University commitment... signing scout: Hector Stewart.

PRBHS History: Founded in 2002 by Ed Correa, who first used the Los Angeles Dodgers' Dominican complex in Las Palmas, DR, in 1999 as what would become the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School three years later... produced Carlos Correa (1st overall in 2012), Hiram Burgos, Joe Jiménez, Vimaél Machin, Jesmuel Valentin and Christian Vázquez... this year produced one draftee, Astros 16th-rounder Gaby Nieves... in 2017, when Berrios was drafted, he was one of four players drafted from PRBHS.

Puerto Rican Baseball: Puerto Rico has produced four Hall of Famers thus far in Roberto Clemente, Iván Rodríguez, Roberto Alomar and Orlando Cepeda, with 1996 Lugnuts outfielder Carlos Beltrán and current catcher Yadier Molina each with their own Hall of Fame cases... today's Major League stars from Puerto Rico are led by Javier Báez of the Tigers, Francisco Lindor of the Mets, José Berrios of the Blue Jays, and Carlos Correa of the Twins... Lindor, like Osvaldo Berrios, was born in Caguas.

Pro Debut - 2017 in AZL: Made professional debut on July 1, 2017, vs. AZL Giants, allowing three runs on five hits in 1 2/3... final appearance of the year was his best (3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) vs. AZL SD1 on September 2... gave up .302 avg. to lefties, .366 to righties... base-stealers were 4-for-6.

2018 in AZL: Relieved Daulton Jefferies in the second game of the season, tossing 3 2/3 innings (6 H, 1 R, 5 K) vs. AZL Giants Black... pitched six-inning gem (3 H, 1 R, 4 K) on the 4th of July vs. AZL White Sox... gave up just two earned runs in final 17 2/3 innings... limited righties to .252 avg./628 OPS while lefties hit .348/.860... base-stealers were 6-for-6.

2019 in AZL and the NYPL: Opened season with AZL A's Gold, making four appearances... in first game of the year, appeared in relief on June 17 and struck out six AZL Cubs2 in 3 2/3 innings, allowing only one hit... tossed five-inning gem (4 H, 1 R, 4 K) on July 1 vs. AZL Dodgers, earning promotion to Short-Season A Vermont... finished the year with best outing for the Lake Monsters, August 29 vs. Connecticut in Game 2 of doubleheader (5 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 4 K)... with Vermont, gave up .326 avg./855 OPS to right-handed hitters while lefties hit .241/.770... base-stealers went 1-for-1 in the AZL and 7-for-9 in the New York-Penn League.

2021 in Low-A West: Received the Opening Day start for the Stockton Ports, May 4 at Modesto, allowing two-run homer to Nuts catcher Matt Scheffler in the second inning but nothing further in four innings, striking out five... by month: May (4 G, 2 GS, 17 1/3, 3.63, .231, 0.98 WHIP)... June (5 G, 3 GS, 23 1/3, 8.49, .350, 1.89 WHIP)... July (4 G, 3 GS, 18 2/3, 4.82, .282, 1.39 WHIP)... August (3 GS, 16 IP, 6.19, .308, 1.44 WHIP... in best outing, whiffed nine batters in 5 2/3 innings, July 6 at Modesto, allowing two runs on four hits and two walks... vs. left-handers: .320/.379/.484, 3 HR... vs. right-handers: .283/.333/.514, 9 HR... base-stealers stole 22 bases in 26 attempts.

2021 in High-A Central: Promoted to Lansing on August 19, replacing starter Jack Cushing (promoted to Double-A Midland; the RockHounds' 2022 Opening Day starter, coincidentally)... enjoyed a smashing debut, limiting Great Lakes to two runs in six innings, August 20 at Dow Diamond... followed up with six scoreless innings of seven-hit relief at West Michigan, August 26, earning the win... faced the Whitecaps in back-to-back home starts to end the year, allowing two runs in three innings in a no-decision September 15, and suffering the loss on the final day of the year, September 19: 2 1/3 IP, 6 H, 8 R, 3 BB, 3 K, serving up a solo HR to Jake Holton in the 1st inning and knocked out by a six-run 3rd... Whitecaps won the game, 19-4, to end the season with an identical 58-62 record as the Lugnuts.

Winter Ball: Pitched for Cangrejeros de Santurce – a cangrejero is a crabber – in Liga de Béisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente, who finished 17-15 in 3rd place and were knocked out in the playoff semifinals by champs Criollos de Caguas... appeared in six games in relief: 5.87 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 6 K... the Santurce Cangrejeros were the same team that the great Clemente himself played for in the early 1950s... the 1954-55 Cangrejeros had both Clemente and Willie Mays in their outfield.

2022 - Return to Lansing: Followed Joey Estes to the mound and pitched the final three innings in relief against Michigan State in the 2022 Crosstown Showdown presented by Delta Dental, allowing one run and striking out three in Lugnuts' 3-2 win... moved into the starting rotation when Jake Walkinshaw and Hogan Harris landed on the Injured List just prior to the season... made 2022 debut April 12th at West Michigan, allowing five runs in four innings (one in the 1st, four in the 2nd)... departed with Lugnuts trailing 5-4... Nuts tied the game in the 9th on a pinch-hit RBI single from Jonny Butler and took a 10-6 lead in the 11th, only to see West Michigan walk off with 11-10 victory thanks to a five-run rally.
