#### **ROUGHRIDERS DOWN WIND SURGE 2-1:**

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Wichita Wind Surge 2-1 on Friday evening from Riders Field. Wichita (24-37, 55-75) opened the scoring against Frisco (35-26, 79-51) starter **Andy Rodriguez** in the top of the third inning, using an RBI single by Kala'i Rosario to take a 1-0 lead. Rodriguez, making just the second start of his professional career, finished after 5.0 innings. He allowed just one run on three hits and two walks while striking out three. **Jackson Kelley** (3-1) took over in the sixth, retiring all six batters he faced before handing the ball to **Ricky DeVito**. The Riders evened the game in the home half of the fifth inning as **Theo Hardy** doubled to mark his first Double-A hit and later scored on an RBI single from **Alejandro Osuna**. Tied 1-1 in the bottom of the sixth, **Cody Freeman** doubled to open the inning. He advanced to third on a groundout and then scored on a groundout by Luis Mieses, giving Frisco a 2-1 advantage. **Skylar Hales** spun a scoreless ninth inning, securing the win and earning his fourth save of the season. Offensively, the Riders collected six hits as Freeman paced the team with a 2-for-4 effort.

#### PACE OF PLAY:

The RoughRiders and Wind Surge played a 1:59 game last night, the fifth-fastest nine-inning game in franchise history.

#### **PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:**

Riders infielder **Max Acosta** has been en fuego at the plate, hitting .314 (50-for-159)/.383/.484/.867 over his last 41 games. In his last 28 games, he is hitting .327 (36-for-110)/.402/.509/.911. Acosta now has a career-best in all slashline categories and is one of five qualified players in the Texas League this year who is 21-year-old or younger.

#### THOSE ROUGHRIDERS ARE SO HOT RIGHT NOW:

The RoughRiders have been playing well recently, winning 11 of their last 15 games. In the 15 games, Frisco is first in the Texas League in runs per game (5.7) and second in OPS (.778) while hitting 17 home runs in the 15 games.

#### HATCHIN HOMERS:

Josh Hatcher has been one of the hotter hitters in the Texas League recently, batting .350/.414/.493/.907 over his last 35 games with eight doubles, four home runs and 20 RBIs. In his last eight games, he is hitting .455 (15-for-33)/.514/.667/1.181 with four doubles, one home run, six RBIs, six runs scored.

#### ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 42 games, Ortiz is hitting .302/.397/.535/.932 with eight doubles, nine home runs, 30 RBIs, 29 runs scored and 24 walks. Since July 10th, in those 42 games, he is fifth in average (.302), second in OPS (.932), third in RBIs (30), fifth in home runs (nine) and third in runs scored (29). In his last 23 games, he is batting .341 (29-for-85)/.456/.624/1.080 with four doubles, six home runs, 22 RBIs, 17 walks, 19 strikeouts and 19 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .289 with an .885 OPS, raising his batting average to .231 and a .713 OPS.

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 23 home runs in the last 19 games, with those 23 home runs being second in the Texas League over the last 19 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 99 across their 130 games (on pace for 108, which would be for the 10th in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

#### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 43-23 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +70 run differential, a 3.96 ERA and is averaging 5.5 runs per game with a .753 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 36-28 with a 3.46 ERA, but a +28 run differential while averaging 4.1 runs per game and owning a .659 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 14 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .309/.394/.534/.932 at home as opposed to .147/.223/.253/.476 on the road.

#### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

CAREER: The 35-year-old right-hander is in his second season with the Texas organization after signing a five-year free agent contract on 12/2/22...made 6 starts to open 2023, including Opening Day, but deGrom missed the final five months of the regular season - plus the Rangers' World Series title run after having 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on 6/12/23...he is expected to miss at least the first half of the 2024 campaign as he continues his injury rehabilitation...a two-time National League Cy Young Award winner with the Mets (2018-19), deGrom owns the third-lowest ERA in the Expansion Era (since 1961) among pitchers with at least 200 starts...he was also the N.L. Rookie of the Year in 2014, one of just three pitchers in baseball history to win multiple Cy Young Awards and a Rookie of the Year Award (also Justin Verlander and Tom Seaver)... received Cy Young Award votes in six of seven seasons from 2015-21 (2015-17-18-19-20-21), including five straight years prior to an injury-shortened 2022 campaign...deGrom is a four-time All-Star (2015, 2018, 2019, 2021) and has twice been selected All-MLB First Team (2019, 2020) since those honors began in 2019...his ranks among MLB pitchers over the last four seasons since the beginning of 2020 (min. 200.0 IP): ERA (1st, 2.12), opp. BA (1st, .163), WHIP (1st, 0.73), strikeouts per 9 innings (1st, 14.03), and walks per 9 innings (2nd, 1.45)...also owns MLB's lowest ERA since the start of 2018 (2.08) among pitchers with 500+ innings...deGrom has averaged 10.96 strikeouts per 9 innings in his MLB career with the Mets (2014-22) and Rangers (2023), the 2nd-best figure in Major League history among pitchers with at least 1300.0 innings (11.06-Chris Sale)...also has the highest swing-and-miss rate since pitches were first tracked in 1988 (min. 1300.0 IP)...his 1652 career strikeouts are the most in MLB history by any pitcher through his first 215 outings in the big leagues...the Deland, Fla. native and resident played college baseball at his hometown Stetson University, the same school which produced two-time Cy Young Award winner Corey Kluber...in college, played third base and shortstop his first two years before converting to a pitcher as a junior in 2010.

SHORTENED SEASON: Made 6 starts to open the year in his 1st season with Texas, but final outing was 4/28 vs. NYY...exited start on 4/17 at KC after 4.0 no-hit innings as a precaution due to right wrist soreness...had quality start in next outing on 4/23 vs. OAK, then left final start on 4/28 vs. NYY in the middle of the 4th inning...placed on the 10-day Injured List on 4/29 with right elbow inflammation...after attempting to ramp up with bullpen sessions in late May, Including 31 pitches in Baltimore on 5/26, it was announced on 6/6 at Globe Life Field that he would undergo surgery...had 'Tommy John' ligament replacement procedure on his right elbow on 6/12/23, with the surgery performed by Rangers Team Physician Dr. Keith Meister...transferred to 60-day IL on 6/5...is expected to continue his injury rehabilitation work during Spring Training, with the hope of returning in the last half of 2024...after making at least 22 starts in each of his 1st 6 MLB seasons, deGrom now has 4 straight years of 15-or-fewer starts.

2023: Finished 2-0 with a 2.67 ERA (9 ER/30.1 IP), 4 BB/45 SO, 13.35 SO/9, .171 opp. BA and a 0.758 WHIP figure over 6 starts in his season with Texas...whiffed 45 of 115 (39.1%) batters faced...final 5 starts: 2-0, 1.35 (4 ER/26.2 IP), 5 XBH allowed (1 HR, 4 2B)...last 3 starts: 0.66 ERA (1 ER/13.2 IP), 2 BB, 18 SO, .085 opp. BA...season-high 11 SO twice: 4/5 vs. BAL and 4/23 vs. OAK...made 5 of his 6 starts at Globe Life Field, as only road start w/ TEX was 4/17 at KC...Rangers were 6-0 in deGrom starts...at the time he was placed on the IL on 4/29, deGrom ranked among A.L. qualifiers in SO/9 (1st), WHIP (2nd), opp. BA (3rd), and ERA (10th).

SUPERLATIVES: Is one of 3 players in Rangers history with 45+ SO over his 1st 6 starts with the club: 52-Nolan Ryan, 47-Max Scherzer, 45-deGrom...is the only player in franchise history with 45+ SO and as little as 4 BB over his 1st 6 starts with the Rangers...the only other pitchers with 45+ SO and 4-or-fewer BB over 6 starts in Washington/Texas franchise history: Lance Lynn (2019), Yu Darvish (2016), Cliff Lee (2010), Gaylord Perry (1975), Fergie Jenkins (1974)...had 11 K's on just 80 pitches on 4/23 vs. OAK, as he owns 2 of 13 instances of 11+ SO on 80-or-fewer pitches since pitches were 1st tracked in 1988 (also w/ NYM, 8/7/22 vs. ATL)...allowed a career-high 6 XBH on Opening Day, 3/30 vs. PHI (3.2 IP, 5 R-ER), his 4th career start in an opener (also 2019-20-21 w/ NYM)...joined Perry (1976) and Jenkins (1975, 1979) as the only Rangers to start a season opener after having previously won a Cy Young Award...opened start on 4/5 vs. BAL with 4.0 perfect innings, retiring all 12 BF to open game, his 9th career start opened with 4.0+ perfect innings.
