FERGUSON HOMERS FOR THE SECOND STRAIGHT NIGHT IN 6-2 LOSS The Portland Sea Dogs (13-15, 47-48) fell to the Altoona Curve (17-12, 47-50) 6-2 on Wednesday evening in front of 6,362 fans at Delta Dental Park. Trailing Altoona 6-0 in the bottom of the seventh, Max Ferguson (7) launched a two-run home run to cut the deficit to 6-2. Ferguson has now homered in consecutive games against Altoona after launching a grand slam in Tuesday night's win. The Curve added to their 2-0 lead in the top of the sixth. Consecutive singles from Valdez and Bowen and a walk issued to Jebb loaded the bases for Altoona. The next batters Aaron McKeithan and Maikol Escotto hit back-to-back sacrifice flies that scored Valdez and Bowen, to increase their lead to 4-0. Altoona put two more runs on the board in the top of the seventh. Mike Jarvis led off the inning with a single. Following two putouts, Valdez roped an RBI double to make the score 5-0. The next batter Bowen also cracked an RBI double that scored Valdez and made the game 6-0.

FERGUSON DOES IT AGAIN For the second straight game, Max Ferguson crushed a home run in the bottom of the seventh inning against the Altoona Curve. His two-run shot is his seventh homer of the season. He is now tied with Allan Castro for second-most home runs on the Sea Dogs (Romero and Z.Ehrhard have eight). Ferguson is now riding a five-game hitting streak (7/24-present). In his last five games, he is hitting .400 (6-for-15) with a double, three runs scored, two home runs (one grand slam), and nine RBI.

ROSARIO'S GOT IT GOIN Sea Dogs catcher Ronald Rosario has caught fire recently. In his last 10 games, the Venezuelan native is slashing .375 (12-for-32) with a double, three home runs (two of them were hit in the same game on 7/26), and seven RBI. During the hot stretch, Rosario has mustered three games with multiple hits. He has now notched 13 multi-hit performances this season, tallying three hits in one of those games (3-4, 1 R, 1 RBI on 7/12 vs Hartford).

TRADE DEADLINE NEWS One former Sea Dog is making headlines today as Blaze Jordan has been traded to the St. Louis Cardinals in exchange for LHP Steven Matz. After tearing up the Eastern League to start the 2025 campaign, Jordan received a well-earned promotion to Triple-A Worcester on June 3 after slashing .320/.490/.671 with 11 doubles, six home runs, and 37 RBI.

COOP GETS THE CALL TO TRIPLE-A RHP Cooper Adams was called up to Triple-A Worcester today. Adams only pitched in one game with Portland on July 23 in Richmond when he tossed 2.1 innings of shutout ball while tallying three strikeouts. This is Adams first stint with Triple-A Worcester.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY July 31, 2011 – Tim Federowicz and Jon Hee each homered, and Junichi Tazawa worked three perfect innings of relief, leading the Sea Dogs to an 8-5 win over Altoona.

ON THE MOUND RHP Caleb Bolden makes his fifth start of the season, sporting a 1-3 record with a 8.06 ERA. His last start came on June 25 against Binghamton, throwing 2.2 innings of three-run ball (all earned) while giving up four hits, two walks and striking out two.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Manager - Chad Epperson

Manager Chad Epperson will lead the team in his fourth season in Portland. In 2024, he led the Sea Dogs to a 78-60 record, the best record in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, and third best in the league. In his fourth season with the team, he is tied for the longest serving manager in Sea Dogs history with Arnie Beyeler who managed Portland for four seasons from 2007 to 2010. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Rivera spent the last three seasons as Salem Red Sox' pitching coach and led the pitching staff to a 3.61 ERA, fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, he has been in the Red Sox organization since 2022 as a Development Coach with Salem.

Hitting Coach - Chris Hess

Chris Hess returns to Portland for his second year as the Sea Dogs' hitting coach after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. Last season, Portland's hitters led Double-A in runs (711), doubles (285), RBI (658), slugging (.412) and OPS (.753). They ranked second in average (.257), hits (1,221), and OBP (.348). He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. This year will mark Hess' fifth year in the Red Sox organization.

Assistant Hitting Coach - Johnny Reina

Johnny Reina will serve as Assistant Hitting Coach after working as a Hitting Trainer at Driveline Baseball in Seattle, Washington. Driveline Baseball's mission is to develop the future of baseball training by finding industry-leading insights, all while publishing those insights back to the baseball community.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala will be on staff for his second season in Portland after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record.

Athletic Trainer - Bobby Stachura

Stachura returns to Portland for his third season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch joins the staff for his first season in Portland, but his second year in the Red Sox organization. He was previously an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach. In that role, he assisted in the strength and conditioning for players returning to the field.
