Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the second game of a six-game series. This is the start of the final meetings in the 24-game season series between the two clubs; the Whitecaps are 13-5 against Lansing this season after the Nuts won yesterday.

Starting Matchup: Southpaw **Tucker Novotny** makes his fourth start since joining the rotation (and his 27th overall appearance), coming off a quality start of 6-IP, 3-R last time out against Lake County. Novotny has allowed two runs (one earned) in 5 1/3 IP against West Michigan this year. **Ben Jacobs** counters him in his 3rd start against Lansing (3 IP, 3 R, 7 K on May 27; 4 IP, 0 R, 6 K on June 18).

Yesterday: Lugnuts 5, 'Caps. Right-hander **Jorge Marcheco** allowed one run in 5 2/3 innings, and the Nuts scored four runs in the 7th to cruise to a comfortable victory.

LUG-NOTES

Turning Point: During the week of July 23, the Lugnuts lost three of their top starting pitchers to promotion, **Nathan Dettmer**, **Zane Taylor** and **Ben Hansen**, yet since then, the Nuts have a league-best 11-5 record with a 4.57 ERA that ranks 3rd in the league.

Heating Up:

- Catcher **Logan Sauve** is batting .444/.542/.556 (8-for-18, 4 BB) in August.
- Infielder **Jared Sprague-Lott** is batting .355/.459/.516 (11-for-31, 6 BB) in August.

Transaction: Days after his 21st birthday and a 9-K start vs. Lake County, **Steven Echavarria** was promoted to Class-AA Midland Monday. Ech is replaced in the rotation by Kentucky southpaw **Jackson Nove**, acquired via trade from the White Sox and called up from Stockton.

Streaking:

- Outfielder **Pedro Pineda** drilled an RBI double yesterday, finishing 1-for-4, to extend his hitting streak to 10 games.
- Outfielder **Jake Reinisch** went 1-for-3 with a two-run double and a walk, extending his on-base streak to 23 games.

Teen Spirit: 18-year-old Breyson Guede (pronounced "GEH-des," as in "Get us a drink, please") joined the Lugnuts at the start of last week from Class-A Stockton. The teenager is ranked the Athletics' No. 2 outfield prospect and No. 8 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline, signing as a top international free agent for about \$1.5 million from San Felipe, Venezuela, in January 2025. He posted a sizzling .359 batting average in his pro debut in the Dominican Summer League, then opened eyes in 2026 Spring Training, collecting singles in his first three Cactus League at-bats before slugging a 450-foot home run off San Diego Padres reliever Michael King on March 13. Thus encouraged, the A's skipped Guede up to Single-A Stockton to open the year and the Guede responded by hitting for a .379 average in June and .375 in July, collecting 73 hits in his last 46 games. Guede is 9-for-his-last-19, .474, in his last four games.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics, and – on August 9 with two scoreless innings in relief – 2021 Lugnut **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets.

Cooperstownian Nut: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

AUGUST 12 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: To Be Continued! Jackson Lowery struck out West Michigan catcher Shane Zeile with the bases loaded to end the 10th inning, and the umpires called it due to wet conditions – forcing a suspension in a 3-3 tie between the two clubs at Fifth Third Ballpark. The game was picked up again on August 13th, and it required 19 minutes to complete, with the Lugnuts winning in 11 innings, 5-3.

2018: Emotions were high in a playoff preview at Cooley Law School Stadium. The Bowling Green Hot Rods beat the Lugnuts, 8-6, ending the Nuts' six-game winning streak, in a game that saw Lugnuts manager Cesar Martin ejected in the top of the ninth (arguing that Hot Rods batter Alexander Alvarez interfered with first baseman Ryan Noda on a squeeze up the first-base line) and hitting coach Matt Young and batter Chavez Young ejected in the bottom of the ninth following a call of check-swing/strike-three.

In a Nutshell: Began the season on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster... making his fourth straight start after 23 relief appearances opened the year, moved into the rotation on July 25 following the promotions of Ben Hansen, Zane Taylor and Nathan Dettmer to Double-A Midland.

Last Start, August 6 vs. Lake County: Tossed 2nd career quality start (August 10, 2025), limiting Lake County to three runs on seven hits and one walk in six innings, striking out six... gave up RBI double to Welbyn Francisca in the 1st and two-run homer to Francisca in the 5th, but nothing else in a no-decision... Nuts walked off with a 6-5 win on a Daniel Bucciero two-out RBI single in the 9th.

Hometown Hero: Attended Park of Cottage Grove, where he lettered in baseball, basketball and bowling (yes, he has bowled a 300 game)... Mr. Baseball finalist, ranked Perfect Game's No. 5 player in Minnesota and No. 1 LHP... as a senior, went 10-1, 1.26 ERA, 78 1/3 IP, 11 ER, 25 BB and 114 K.

College Days: Chose the Golden Gophers over Alabama, USC, Illinois and Wichita State... majored in accounting at Minnesota's Carlson School of Management... spent his summer ball days with the Minnesota Mud Puppies (2021), Willmar Stingers (2022), Cotuit Kettleers (2023)... ascended to Minnesota's Friday starter as a sophomore in 2023 and was named Dave Winfield Pitcher of the Year... ranked 5th in the Big Ten in K/9 in 2024 (10.7), with 62 K in 52 IP, and was named All-Big Ten Third Team... named D1 Baseball's No. 26 Draft Prospect in the Big Ten.

Off to Pro Ball: Signed for \$125,000 as the first pick of the 18th round in 2018... dominated out of the bullpen for the Stockton Ports, and was sporting a 1.63 ERA when he moved to the starting rotation on July 13... whiffed nine Modesto Nuts in five innings in his first California League start, following up with six scoreless innings against Modesto on August 10... in total: 1.67 ERA as a reliever (37 2/3 IP, 15 R, 7 ER, 20 BB, 52 K), but a 5.85 ERA as a starter (40 IP, 27 R, 26 ER, 17 BB, 45 K)... joined the Lugnuts to begin 2026 and allowed only two runs in his first six appearances, but gave up five runs at South Bend on May 8 and four runs vs. Quad Cities on May 15... Midwest League base-stealers are 3-for-6... lefties are hitting just .232 but with a .380 OBP due to 12 walks; righties are batting .263 with a .402 OBP (21 BB), but have hit into eight double plays.
