SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels were shut out by the Bowie Baysox, 10-0. In the fourth, Bowie scored six runs to take the lead. Cody Roberts hit a three-run double, Marverick Handley drove in a run with a single and Jordan Westburg hit a two-run homer. Gunnar Henderson added an RBI single in the sixth. Bowie scored a run on a wild pitch to pull ahead, 8-0. Henderson hit a two-run homer in the eighth to extend the lead to 10-0. **Kai-Wei Teng** matched a career high with six runs allowed, all in the fourth inning, which was the most runs allowed in an inning by the Flying Squirrels this season. The Baysox handed the Flying Squirrels their first shutout loss of the year. **Frankie Tostado** and **Brandon Martorano** each picked up a pair of hits for the Flying Squirrels, who were held to five total hits in the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels and Baysox met for a three-game set in Bowie to open the season from April 8-10, with Richmond picking up two wins. After this week's six-game series, the two teams will meet for three more games in Richmond from July 22-24. The Flying Squirrels travel to Bowie for a six-game set from June 28-July 3 and again from September 6-11. Richmond has not scored a run in the last 9.2 innings dating back to Tuesday afternoon.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have alternated wins and losses over the last six games. Last week, they dropped four of six in their road set at Erie. It was the first series loss of the year for the Flying Squirrels. They opened the season taking two in a three-game series at Bowie from April 8-10 before winning four games in a six-game set against Altoona in their first homestand from April 12-17. The Flying Squirrels have the second-most offensive strikeouts in the league (194) and are tied for first in home runs (23).

THE BAYSOX snapped a three-game losing slide with Wednesday's win after winning their previous four games in last week's home series against the Akron RubberDucks. After dropping two of three against the Flying Squirrels at home to begin the season, the Baysox won three of five at Binghamton from April 12-17, with one game postponed until June. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Gunnar Henderson (3), Jordan Westburg (6), Joseph Ortiz (15), Hudson Haskin (16), Drew Rom (17) and Adam Hall (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Bryan Brickhouse** makes his fourth start of the season and his second against the Baysox. In his season debut on April 10 at Bowie, he allowed four earned runs in 3.1 innings. He made his home debut on April 16 at The Diamond against the Curve and allowed four runs in four innings in a no-decision. Last time out, he surrendered a season-high five runs over 5.2 innings in a loss at Erie on Friday. Brickhouse was signed as a free agent with a non-roster invitation to spring training by the Giants on December 15, 2021. Last year, Brickhouse signed with the Los Angeles Dodgers and spent the season with Double-A Tulsa, making 10 starts and nine relief outings. He was originally drafted by the Kansas City Royals in 2011 and retired in 2017 after battling injuries. He returned to the field in the 2018 season. *For more on Brickhouse, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander **Drew Rom** makes his fourth start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Thursday against the RubberDucks and worked four innings, allowing one run. He made his season debut as the Opening Day starter for the Baysox against the Flying Squirrels on April 8 and allowed three runs in three innings. Rom followed with five scoreless innings, allowing two hits with eight strikeouts, at Binghamton on April 14. Last year, he began the season with High-A Delmarva, going 8-0 with a 2.79 ERA in 14 outings, including 13 starts. He was promoted to Double-A Bowie on July 31. At the time of his promotion, he ranked tied for seventh in the High-A East with 73 strikeouts. Rom went 3-1 with a 3.83 ERA in nine outings (seven starts) for the Baysox. He started Game 3 of the Double-A Northeast Championship Series at Akron on September 24 and pitched 5.0 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts before the RubberDucks scored six runs over the final two innings to clinch the league title. Rom finished the 2021 season ranked fifth in the Orioles organization with 120 strikeouts, first with 107.2 innings pitched, and first with 11 wins. Overall on the year, he went 11-1 with a 3.18 ERA in 23 outings (20 starts) and was selected as an MiLB.com Orioles Organization All-Star. He faced Richmond twice last year, working 5.0 innings and allowing one run with six strikeouts on July 31 at The Diamond in the first match-up. In his second start against the Flying Squirrels on August 12, he allowed four runs in 5.0 innings and picked up a win at Prince George's Stadium. In 2019, he was a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star with Delmarva. Rom was selected in the fourth round (115th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Ky.

LOOKING FOR HITS: The Flying Squirrels have been held to 20 hits over the last four games since Saturday, hitting .167 (20-for-120) with 31 strikeouts. Over the first 13 games of the year from April 8-22, Richmond hit .250 (106-for-424), which was third in the league, and led the circuit with 21 homers. After being held without a homer on Saturday and Sunday, the Flying Squirrels went deep twice in Tuesday's game before being shut out on Wednesday night.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 23 home runs this season, which is tied for first in the Eastern League and second in all of Double-A. After hitting three homers in the season-opening series at Bowie from April 8-10, the Flying Squirrels hit 12 home runs over six games in their first homestand against Altoona last week. They added four homers in the two games of last Thursday's double-header in Erie and went deep twice last Friday night. After being held without a homer on Saturday and Sunday, the Flying Squirrels hit two on Tuesday in the opener against the Baysox. On April 13 against the Curve, the Flying Squirrels set the franchise record for homers in an inning with four in the fourth, and set a team record with five homers in the game. **Sean Roby** is leading the league with seven homers on the season, with six coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 187 home runs.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** leads the Eastern League with seven home runs on the season. He is one homer away from matching the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for most home runs in a calendar month, which is eight by **Jarrett Parker** in May 2013. Six of his home runs have come at The Diamond, including five in the first home series of the season against Altoona from April 12-17. Roby hit a homer in the series opener against the Baysox on Tuesday. Through just seven home games played, Roby is tied for the 12th-most home runs hit at The Diamond in a season by a Flying Squirrels player. He is tied for the team leader in homers at home from 2012, 2015 and 2017 and has more homers than team leaders in 2010 (3) and 2019 (4). His seven total home runs on the season are tied for the sixth-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

TOASTY: After hitting .263 (10-for-38) over his first 10 games of the year, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .375 (6-for-16) with a homer, two RBIs and a walk over his last four games since April 22. He has picked up two hits in two of his last four games and has four multi-hit games on the season. Last year, Tostado finished the season ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with 63 RBIs, which was fifth in the Giants system. Tostado hit 14 homers last year, which was tied for 10th-most in a season in Flying Squirrels history. He clubbed his first homer of 2022 on April 22 at Erie.

MARTY PARTY: After batting .063 (2-for-32) over a nine-game stretch from April 9-22, **Brandon Martorano** has picked up three hits in the last two games. In the current series against the Baysox, Martorano is batting .500 (3-for-6) with a double, three RBIs and two walks. On the year against the Baysox, Martorano is hitting .429 (6-for-14) with two doubles, five RBIs and four walks in five games, compared to a .071 (2-for-28, 2 HR, 3 RBI) against all other Eastern League teams.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is first in the Eastern League in homers (7), tied for second in RBIs (13), fourth in SLG (.686), third in OPS (1.057) and tied for second in total bases (35). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (3). **Jake Dahlberg** 10th in ERA (2.21), tied for seventh in strikeouts (24) and fourth in innings pitched (20.1). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for eighth in innings pitched (18.0).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: On March 3, **Dennis Pelfrey** was named the new manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Last year in his first season as a manager in affiliated baseball, he led the Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Pelfrey, 44, played six professional seasons in independent baseball from 1999-2004. He began his coaching career at South Grand Prairie High School in Texas in 2006, a position he held through 2015. He continued that role as he began his professional coaching career in 2011 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats, where he spent four seasons. Pelfrey landed his first managerial job in 2015 with the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League, a role he held for five seasons through 2019. He was hired by the Giants entering the 2020 season to manage High-A San Jose before the season was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under his direction last year, the Emeralds went 69-50 before topping Spokane in the High-A West Championship Series.

REWRITING THE RULES: New experimental rules are in effect during the Flying Squirrels' season. With runners on base, pitchers will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. The size of the bases has increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square in an attempt to reduce injuries. Defensively, teams must have a minimum of four players on the infield and two infielders complete on either side of second base.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
