SNAP OUT OF IT: After dropping three games in a row for the first time all season, the FredNats continue their final voyage at Historic Grainger Stadium in Kinston, N.C. to take on the Down East Wood Ducks, Single-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers. After last night's series opening loss, FXBG turns to RHP Bryan Polanco on the mound today as he looks to bounce back after back-to-back rough starts. Heading into play today, Fredericksburg is now in second place in the division behind Carolina, with the Wood Ducks nipping at the heels as well. Eight of FXBG's final 20 games in the half are against the Wood Ducks, as DE returns to Fredericksburg for the final three games of the half as well. Down East does not have a video broadcast, so the only live broadcast of this week's series is on the radio on the FredNats Baseball Network. This is FXBG's last scheduled trip to Historic Grainger Stadium before it closes after this year and DE moves to Spartanburg, S.C.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNat offense managed just two hits against Down East starter David Davalillo, and a two-run homer in the first inning gave the Wood Ducks a lead they would not give up. Down East ended up winning the series opener 7-2 after FXBG scratched a couple runs across in the 8th inning.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. So far this season, the bullpen has pitched 245 innings this year and allowed just 70 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.57. The Freddies are also 13/14 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is tied for first in all of Minor League Baseball with eight saves. The unit also worked out of major trouble a bunch on the last trip. The first five wins of the last road trip, the opposing team has had the tying and/or go-ahead runs on base in the 9th inning, and FXBG's bullpen has slammed the door each time. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (21-0), and 8 (23-0) innings after taking the lead in the 7th inning last night and not giving it up.

NO GRAY MAY: Roismar Quintana's emergence in the middle of this Fredericksburg order has been a huge key to success for FXBG in this month of May. This month, Quintana is slashing .300/.364/.500 for an OPS of .864, and his wRC+ is 151 (100 is average). Quintana's wOBA, which is a key advanced metric that measures how a hitter reaches base and the impact it has on scoring runs, is .402 this month (.320 is average).

HE GONE: Prior to yesterday's game, infielder Gavin Dugas was promoted to High-A Wilmington. He becomes the third FredNat to get the call to High-A this year after playing significant time for FXBG. In 27 games with the FredNats, Dugas slashed .340/.438/.524 for an OPS of .962. The Nats' sixth round draft pick out of LSU had a wRC+ of 179 (100 is average), and a wOBA of .456 (around .320 is average) for FXBG.

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel continues to tie for the lead in all of Minor League Baseball Double-A and below in RBI with 46 after he drove in three more runs last series. This year, Pimentel is hitting .411 with runners in scoring position, and is 10-for-19 (.526) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of MiLB.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 20-2 this season when scoring first, including 17 out of the last 18 wins. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in the last road trip against Charleston. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses last week to the Hillcats, in fact, Lynchburg scored first in five out of the six games in the series.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 168-138 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TODAY'S START: Bryan Polanco is set to make his fourth start of the season, this afternoon against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. Polanco made a spot start at the end of April against Delmarva, but figures to take over a starting role with the promotion of Jose Atencio.

NOTHING NEW: While Polanco had been primarily a relief arm with Fredericksburg this year, starting games is a role he's more than familiar with. In his MiLB career, 17 of Bryan's 33 career appearances have been as a starting pitcher. In 2022 and '23 in particular, he started 16 games compared to just six relief appearances.

Further simplifying the transtition, Polanco has served as the "bridge guy" out of the FredNat bullpen this year, capable of handling longer outings. Of his five relief appearances, Polanco has worked three innings once, 4+ innings three times, and even logged a five inning relief outing on 5/1 vs Down East.

ROAD TO THE FREDDIES: Polanco began his professional career with a rough debut in the DSL in 2021, but he returned in '22 and cut his ERA in half (7.04 to 3.51) while striking out 49 hitters in 41.0 IP. He jumped to the FCL and faced some struggles, but joined the FredNats late in 2023 for a pair of starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Polanco gave up a three-run second inning against the Hillcats, in a three-inning start. Bryan also walked two and struck out two, but did not factor into the decision.
