SALT LAKE BEES (3-4) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (3-4)

<u>RHP Dakota Hud</u>son (NR) vs. RHP Andrew Quezada (0-0, 0.00)

TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque evened the series at two games apiece after Braxton Fulford's two-run, walk-off homer in the ninth inning yesterday ... Andrew Quezada is expected to make his first start of the season after making two appearances out of the pen to begin the year while former Rockie and Isotope Dakota Hudson is slated to take the hill for the Bees.

WALK-OFF: The Isotopes completed their first walk-off of the 2025 season last night and first since September 13, 2024, against Las Vegas when Elehuris Montero connected on a two-run homer in the 10th frame.

VS. SALT LAKE: It's the Isotopes ninth all-time walk-off win against Salt Lake (last: June 28, 2024, Connor Kaiser two-run double). Additionally, it's the first time in club history Albuquerque has hit a walk-off homer against the Bees.

ONE-RUN GAMES: With the win yesterday, Albuquerque is 2-0 in one run games on the season (also: March 30 at Sacramento, 2-1). Dating back to last year, the Isotopes have won three-straight one-run games (other: September 22, 2024, at Reno, 7-6, 10 innings).

KEEP IT CLEAN: The Isotopes did not commit an error last night, the sixth game of the year without an error. Albuquerque's two errors on the season are tied for the fewest errors in Triple-A (others: Columbus and Worcester).

RUNS: Albuquerque scored more than three runs for the second time this year last night (also: April 2 vs. Salt Lake, 17 runs).

BRAX: Braxton Fulford's two-run, walk-off clout yesterday is his second four-bagger of the year and his second in his last three games. He also registered his first multi-hit contest of the season.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk recorded two singles on the night for his second multi-hit game of the year and second in his last three games.

RITTER: Ryan Ritter drove in a run last night for the secondstraight night. He has an RBI in three of his last four contests.

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel drove in his second run of the season in the ninth inning last night with his RBI single.

TG: Starter Tanner Gordon completed 5.2 frames and allowed two runs on five hits, one walk and one homer while punching out six yesterday ... He's the second Isotopes starter to complete at least 5.0 frames in a start (also: Jack O'Loughlin, April 2 vs. Salt Lake, 5.0 IP).

SAM I AM: On Thursday, Sam Hilliard connected on his 77th home run in an Isotopes uniform across five seasons (2019, 21, 22, 24 and 25). He is now two blasts away from tying Mike Busch (1993-96) for most among all Albuquerque Triple-A players.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Hilliard has 216 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

VEEN: Zac Veen saw his season-opening five-game hit streak come to an end Thursday. Veen was 7-for-19 with two doubles, a triple, four RBI and two walks during the stretch.

AMADOR: Adael Amador recorded a single Thursday and has a hit in three-straight games and four of the five contests he's played in 2025 ... He also drew two walks Thursday, the first time with two free passes since August 14, 2024, vs. Somerset.

KEST DADDY: Keston Hiura has a hit in two-straight contests (3x8) after going hitless over his first four games of the season (0x14)

MILLER TIME: Owen Miller has a hit in five of the seven games he's played in to begin his Isotopes tenure.

RISP: The Isotopes went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position last night. Over their last two games, the club is just 1-for-20 with runners in scoring position.

SERIES WIN VS. SL: The Isotopes need to win the final two contests of the series to claim their first series win over the Bees in Albuquerque since taking two of three July 14-6, 2024.

COMEBACK WIN: With the win last night, the Isotopes completed their second comeback triumph of the season (also: March 30 at Sacramento, 2-1 victory).

HOMERS: Albuquerque has homered in five of their first seven games to begin the season.

SALT LAKE TIES: Bees right-handed pitcher Dakota Hudson pithed for the Isotopes in 2024 ... Salt Lake right-hander Chase Silseth hails from Farmington and was named Gatorade New Mexico Player of the Year in 2018 after his senior year at Piedra Vista High School ... Isotopes infielder Keston Hiura played in 37 games for the Bees last season, blasting 20 home runs with 42 RBI.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
