Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Toledo Mud Hens play game five of a seven-game series tonight. Nashville has won three of the first four games, including a 12-0 pummeling of Toledo last night. Right-hander Alec Bettinger starts for the Sounds against right-hander Pedro Payano for the Mud Hens.

Alec Bettinger: 26-year-old Alec Bettinger makes his 13th appearance (11th start) for the Sounds in game five of the set. In 52.2 innings with Nashville, Bettinger is 2-3 with a 3.76 ERA. He has yielded 25 runs on 58 hits and 13 walks to go along with 58 strikeouts. He last threw on July 30 in a start against Columbus and went 5.0 innings. Despite giving up 5 runs on 6 hits and 3 walks, he earned his second win of the season. The right-hander has also made four appearances (one start) with Milwaukee and is 0-1 with a 13.50 ERA (14 ER/9.0 IP). In 2019, he went 5-7 with a 3.44 ERA in 26 games (26 starts) with Double-A Biloxi. He finished among Southern League leaders in starts (T-1st), strikeouts (2nd), innings pitched (2nd), WHIP (2nd, 1.07), opponents' batting average (4th, .223) and ERA (6th). Bettinger was drafted by Milwaukee in the 10th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Pedro Payano: 26-year-old Pedro Payano starts for the Mud Hens tonight. The right-hander is 2-3 with a 4.43 ERA in 9 games (8 starts) with Toledo in 2021. He has also made 6 starts for Double-A Erie. In 71.2 total innings this year, Payano has allowed 60 hits and 14 walks to go along with 36 strikeouts. Double-A batters hit only .167 against him while Triple-A batters have hit at a .263 clip against the former Sound. In 11 games with Nashville in 2019, Payano went 2-3 with a 5.44 ERA. He signed a minor league contract with Detroit on February 8, 2021.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 52, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

10-Run Outburst: Nashville sent 14 batters to the plate in the eighth inning last night and scored 10 runs, the most runs in a single inning this year. It's the first time scoring 10+ runs in a single inning since the Sounds plated 12 runs in the 2nd inning vs. Oklahoma City on July 3, 2019. The Sounds sent 16 hitters to the plate in that inning and won the game, 14-11.

Two Hits, Same Inning: Troy Stokes Jr. (single, double), Pablo Reyes (single, double) and Brice Turang (single, single) had two hits apiece during last night's big inning. It's the second time a Sounds player has had two hits in one inning this year. Stokes Jr. had two singles in the fifth inning on June 29 vs. Louisville. In the 2nd inning vs. Oklahoma City on July 3, 2019, the Sounds also had three players with two hits each. Andy Ibanez (home run, double), Christian Lopes (double, home run) and Zack Granite (two singles) had two hits each.

That's Offensive: The Nashville offense has exploded over the last two games, putting up 23 runs in the process. During the two games, Nashville hit .338 (22-for-65) with 8 extra-base hits (7 doubles, 1 home run). In their previous four games, Nashville hitters put together a .178 (19-for-107) average with 4 extra-base hits (3 doubles, 1 home run) and 30 strikeouts.

Ashby Deals: Aaron Ashby had one of the best performances in his young career last night. The southpaw punched out 11 Toledo hitters, matching a season-high (also 6/4 at Charlotte). Ashby threw 48 of his 60 pitches for strikes and recorded the seventh double-digit strikeout game in his career.

That's RISP: Entering last night's game the Sounds were hitting .250 with runners in scoring position. They went 8-for-13 with a runner in scoring position last night – the most hits they've had in that situation since they went 8-for-13 on June 11 in a 14-1 win over Indianapolis. Nashville is now 8th in the Triple-A East with a .257 team average with RISP.

Let's Play the AL: After last night's win, the Sounds are 22-11 against American League affiliates compared to 25-23 against National League affiliates. The designated hitter spot in the Nashville lineup has hit .274 (31-for-113) with 9 doubles, 5 home runs, 17 RBI and 26 walks with an OPS of .905.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,078-1,956. The 2,078 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
