LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints got hits from all nine spots in the lineup and Marco Raya pinned down his first professional save as the Saints took down the Indianapolis Indians 9-7 in a come-from-behind win on Saturday at Victory Field. After giving up two runs in the bottom of the eighth that erased a two-run lead, the Saints top of the order grabbed the lead back in the ninth. Tied at seven, Kaelen Culpepper drew a one out walk. Gabby Gonzalez then roped a double over righth fielder Jhostynxon Garcia's head to put runners at second and third before Alan Roden drilled a double to plate both runners, giving St. Paul a 9-7 edge. Raya worked around a one out double by striking out the other three batters he faced in his first-ever outing in a save situation. The Saints were outhit 14-12, marking the most hits combined by both teams in a Saints game since August 24, 2025 vs Round Rock when the Saints and Express racked up 33 hits in an 11-5 win for the PCL visitors at CHS Field.

SWEET, SWEET VICTORY: The Saints will try and polish off a three-game sweep of the Indians this afternoon in a ballpark they've historically struggled. The Saints went just 1-5 in their lone series in Indianapolis last season and were just 1-11 the year prior. Since winning the first four games of a six-game series from April 11-14, 2023 at Victory Field, St. Paul had failed to win back-to-back games in the ballpark until this weekend and were just 2-19 in their last 21 games there before this weekend.

ON PACE FOR 150: The Saints are 2-0 to open the season for the third year in a row and for the fourth time in six years as a Triple-A affiliate. No previous team in franchise history has ever won their first three games in a season with last year's club dropping a 2-0 game in Columbus in game two of a doubleheader, snapping a 25.0 inning scoreless streak by the pitching staff in the process. In 2024, the Saints held a 4-2 lead going into the bottom of the eighth in their third game of the season at Nashville before the Sounds rallied and won 5-4.

BULLPEN MARCO: In just his 13th professional appearance in relief and his first in a save situation, Marco Raya held down the lead in the ninth for the Saints on Saturday. After appearing in just two games in relief over his first three professional seasons, Raya transitioned to a reliever role with the Saints last season, making nine straight appearances out of the St. Paul bullpen and ten total on the season. On Saturday, Raya punched out three of four batters faced in his season debut while generating six swings-and-misses. His average 4-seam fastball (96.5) and cutter (91.8) velocities were both up a tick from last season.

IT'S EARLY, BUT...: After hitting his first Triple-A home run and the first Saints longball of the season on Saturday, St. Paul shortstop Kaelen Culpepper ranks t-5th in all of Triple-A with 4 RBI. Alan Roden has matched Culpepper's RBI total while also ranking t-5th in OBP (.700) and t-4th in walks drawn (4). Former St. Paul Saints Ryan Fitzgerald has 6 RBI after a three-run homer and a two-run double for Oklahoma City yesterday; he is tied for the Triple-A lead with Las Vegas' Brett Harris in that category.

TWINS OF TOMORROW: The Saints open the season with nine of the Twins' Top-30 ranked prospects according to MLB.com, marking the most players listed on MLB's Minnesota Top-30 list to open a campaign in the Saints' history as a Triple-A franchise. Between Walker Jenkins, Kaelen Culpepper, Emmanuel Rodriguez, & Connor Prielipp, they also tout four prospects on either the MLB.com or Baseball America Top-100 list, surpassing last year's total of three when Rodriguez, Luke Keaschall, and Zebby Matthews all began the year with the Saints. Jenkins, the Twins' consensus top prospect, became the youngest player in Saints franchise history when he debuted at 20 years, 6 months, and 7 days of age last year. After a 1-for-20 start, the North Carolina prep product hit .296 (21-71) with eight extra-base hits, including his first two Triple-A homers, in his last 17 games. Shortstop Kaelen Culpepper, Minnesota's No. 2 prospect (MLB.com) and last year's Twins Minor League Player of the Year, will make his Triple-A debut on Opening Day. Left-hander Connor Prielipp, the Twins No. 4 (BA) prospect, returns in a Saints uniform after finishing last season in St. Paul. The remaining ranked prospects include Gabriel Gonzalez (7/10), Andrew Morris (13/13), Marco Raya (18/21), and John Klein (20/23). Left-hander Kendry Rojas (10/8) will also open the year on the Saints' injured list, but is expected to join the rotation with the first few weeks.

YOU'RE A SAINT: The Saints Opening Day roster features 16 players that saw action in a St. Paul uniform previously and 12 new faces that are yet to make their Saints debuts. Among the 16 returners, 14 played for the Saints last season with catcher David Banuelos and Matt Bowman also returning to St. Paul after stints with other organizations. Among the 12 new players, only Kaelen Culpepper does not have previous Triple-A experience. With an average age of 26.7 on the active roster, the Saints are slightly younger than the average age for a Triple-A team last year (26.9). St. Paul's roster have 14 different U.S. states represented by hometown with 24 of the 28 on the active roster being American-born players. Internationally, the Saints tout three of their ranks from Venezuela (Gabby Gonzalez, Orlando Arcia, & Eduardo Salazar) and one from the Dominican Republic (E. Rodriguez).

LET'S HIT THE ROAD: Last season, St. Paul were a near .500 team at home in 2025 (36-38), but struggled mightily on the road: The Saints' 26-48 (.351) record away from CHS Field marked the worst road winning-percentage in Triple-A in 2025 and the 5th-worst among 120 full-season clubs in MiLB. St. Paul had lost their last 12 consecutive road games, a dubious franchise record, until notching a win in the third-to-last game of the year in Memphis. This season marks the first time since 2022 that the Saints have won their first two road games in a season. St. Paul have never won their first three road tilts in a season in the previous five years of their franchise history.

2026 Notables: Added to the Saints Opening Day roster...


2025 Season: Playing in his 10th season in The Show, hit just .202 (41-203), 3 HR, 13 RBI and a .529 OPS in 76 games split between the Atlanta Braves & Colorado Rockies

- >Marked the Venezuela native's worst MLB season by OPS while also notching the fewest HR and RBI of his career...spent the whole year in the majors
- Broke camp with the Braves and went 6-for-30 (.200) at the plate in 10 games before landing on the 10-day IL with a left wrist fracture
- >Returned to action on May 6 with Atlanta but appeared in just four games and only received 1 AB before being released on May 25
- Signed as a free agent with Colorado on May 28 and closed the year hitting .203, 3 HR 12 RBI and a .544 OPS in 62 games with the Rox
- >Was mired in a 1-for-29 (.034) slide from July 5-July 26
- Graded as an above average defender at shortstop in the big leagues, posting a +2 Outs Above Average, in the 78th percentile of big leaguers at the position

Career Notes: A veteran big-leaguer who has played parts of the last 10 years in MLB entering 2026...totaled over 1,000 games, 700+ hits, 90 HR in his MLB career w/ MIL, ATL, & COL

- >Had made 9 consecutive big league Opening Day rosters entering 2026 between Atlanta and Milwaukee
- Was an All-Star for the Atlanta Braves in 2023 after winning the starting shortstop job out of camp and hitting .264, 17 HR, 65 RBI and a .741 OPS in 139 games
- >Ranked 7th in batting average, eighth in OBP and slugging% & 9th in OPS among qualified MLB shortstops that season
- A 2021 World Series champion with Atlanta...saw just 4 AB in the postseason and drew a walk in one of his 5 PA
- >A .247 career postseason hitter (19-77) with 5 HR in 29 games...drilled 3 HR in the first 6 games of Milwaukee's 2018 run to the NLCS after 3 in 119 gm in reg. season
- Started his career with the Milwaukee Brewers organization, where he ascended to the big leagues for the first time in 2016 & spent six seasons with the club
- >Was traded to the Braves on April 6, 2021 in exchange for RHP Chad Sobotka and RHP Patrick Weigel
- In 2024, opened the Braves' season with back-to-back 3-hit games @PHI, 1-of-5 players in the Braves' modern era to do so

2025 Season: Opened the season with Double-A Wichita for the second year in-a-row and hit .257 w/ an .825 OPS, 3 HR, 17 RBI in 30 games

- >Raised his batting average 70 points & his OPS by 230+ points from his first season in Double-A in 2024
- Following his first Triple-A promotion to St. Paul, hit .234/.364/.458 (.822 OPS), 7 HR, 16 RBI in 39 games in the International League
- >Was promoted for his Triple-A debut with the Saints on June 10...collected his first Triple-A hit in his debut on 6/10 @IND, a single in third AB facing Burch Smith
- >Hit 7 homers during a 17-game span from June 15-Aug. 6...went just 10-for-44 (.227) with 1 XBH in his final 18 games following his last HR on 8/6 vs Iowa

2025 marked the California native's first season playing for multiple affiliates in the same year: 2024 w/ Wichita, all of '23 in Cedar Rapids, '22 in Fort Myers, '21 FCL

Ranked among the Twins' Top-30 prospects by the MLB Pipeline at the Mid-Season update...checked in at No. 25 before an influx of talent at the trade deadline

Saw 57% fastballs...hit .250, slugged .471 w/ 4 HR vs the heater...had 8th percentile average exit velo (82.9) and 9th percentile hard-hit rate (21.5%) in Triple-A

Career Notes: Last year marked Cardenas' 1st year in pro ball playing for multiple affiliates...spent all of '24 with AA-Wichita, all of '23 in Cedar Rapids, '22 in Fort Myers, '21 in FCL

In 2024, spent the entirety of the year with Double-A Wichita & hit .173 with a .587 OPS, 5 HR, 32 RBI in 75 games

- >Had the 2nd-lowest OPS of any hitter in the Texas League (min 300 PA) despite holding a 14% walk-rate that ranked among the top-5 in the league
- >Got off to a hot start, hitting .275 (14-51), 2 HR and a .795 OPS in April before hitting just .148 (30-203), 3 HR and a .534 OPS the rest of the season
- >Hit safely in nine straight from April 13-28 (10-32, 5 RBI)...did not have a hitting streak of more than 3 games the rest of the year


2023: hit .272, 3 HR, 38 RBI, .779 OPS in 90 games for Cedar Rapids

- >Recorded a career-best 10-game hitting streak from July 2-20 while with the Kernels

2026 Notables: Added to Saints Opening Day Roster...Enters the year as the Twins' No. 2 prospect by MLB.com, No. 3 by Baseball America...No. 52 overall preseason prospect by MLB

Singled in first Triple-A at-bat on 3/27 @IND facing Noah Davis (finished 3-5)...hit first Triple-A HR and first for Saints lineup on 3/28 @IND...

2025 Season: Named the Twins' Minor League Player of the Year after slashing .289/.375/.469 (.844 OPS), 20 HR, 64 RBI, 25 SB in 113 games between AA-Wichita & A+-Cedar Rapids

- >Ranked 4th among qualified Twins farmhands in batting average, 5th in OPS, and 2nd only to Gabby Gonzalez in total hits (131) and wRC+ (138)
- >Was 1-of-3 Minnesota minor leaguers to post a 20 HR-20 SB season (also Kyle Fedko-28/38 & Kala'i Rosario-25/32)

Opened the year with High-A Cedar Rapids and hit .293, 9 HR, 34 RBI and an .864 OPS in 54 games with the Kernels

- >Helped Cedar Rapids clinch the Midwest League first-half title with a record of 40-26...was promoted for his Double-A debut to start the second-half on June 20

After his Double-A promotion, hit .285, 11 HR, 30 RBI and posted an .827 OPS in 59 games with the Wind Surge

- >11 HR were t-6th most in the Texas League in the 2nd-half and trailed only Kala'i Rosario (18) for the team-lead in that stretch...OPS ranked 10th (min 200 AB)
- Raised his batting average 47 points and his OPS 120 points from his first season in the minors the year prior

Career Notes: Last season marked Culpepper's first full-season in the minors after being taken 21st overall in the 2024 Draft out of Kansas State

In 2024, hit .242 (24-99) with 3 HR, 12 RBI, and a .724 OPS in 26 games after the Draft, splitting his first time in pro ball between Low-A Fort Myers & High-A Cedar Rapids

- >Collected hits in each of his first four professional games, starting out 6-for-17, HR, 3 doubles, 4 RBI with the Mighty Mussels

Is the sixth shortstop selected by the Twins in the first round since 2014 (Nick Gordon-2014, Royce Lewis-2017, Keoni Cavaco-2019, Noah Miller-2021, Brooks Lee-2022)

Played three years of college ball at Kansas State (2022-24), where he was a 2nd-Team All-American by D1Baseball.com & a 2nd-Team All-Big 12 Selection as a Junior

- >Moved from third base to shortstop as a junior for the Wildcats...was named the Fayetteville Regional MVP after going 9-for-19 (.474), 2 HR, 6 XBH & 10 RBI
- >Became the fourth player in K-State history to hit for the cycle, doing so to lead the Cats to a 19-4 win over No. 2 seed Louisiana Tech in the Regional Final


Is just the fourth player in K-State history to be drafted in the first-round, joining Charles Coe (1971), Bob Lesslie (1972), and Jorand Wicks (2021)

- >Matched Wicks at No. 21 overall as the highest draft pick in school history...Wicks (Cubs) is the only previous K-State first-rounder to have reached the big leagues

Personal: Says he used to sleep with his glove when he was a kid and named it "Lucy"...older brother, Tyler, played two seasons of college ball at Jackson State (2018-19)

Is a product of St. Benedict Auburndale (TN) HS, where he was a two-sport athlete in both baseball and basketball...1st Team All-State selection as a senior in baseball


