FRISCO STOMPS AMARILLO IN MONSTER OFFENSIVE DAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Amarillo Sod Poodles 15-5 on Friday evening from HODGETOWN. Frisco (38-29, 82-54) started the scoring against Amarillo (28-38, 58-77) starter Billy Corcoran (6-8) in the top of the first when **Sebastian Walcott** delivered a two-out RBI single, plating **Alejandro Osuna** to give the Riders a 1-0 lead. In the visiting portion of the fourth inning, the RoughRiders sent 10 batters to the plate as they erupted for seven runs. The Riders first four batters of the inning picked up each leg of the cycle. **Luis Mieses** started the scoring with a two-run homer that allowed **Keyber Rodriguez**, who opened the inning with a triple, to score. **Cody Freeman** added a run with a sacrifice fly before a three-run homer from **Cooper Johnson** gave Frisco an 8-0 advantage. **Kohl Drake** spun 3.0 scoreless, one-hit frames with no walks and a pair of strikeouts before handing the ball to **Andy Rodriguez** (4-2). After a scoreless bottom of the third inning, Caleb Roberts put the Sod Poodles on the board with a solo homer. In the top of the sixth inning, Frisco added four more runs as **Abimelec Ortiz** belted his 15th homer of the season. An RBI double by **Aaron Zavala** followed by a two-run homer from Rodriguez pushed the Riders lead to 12-1. **Maximo Acosta**, who set a career-high with five hits, doubled to open the seventh inning and later scored on a two-run homer by Ortiz that made it 14-1. The home run marked the first Double-A multi-homer game for Ortiz. Kristian Robinson hammered a three-run shot to left to cut the deficit to 14-4. Rodriguez finished after 4.0 innings, allowing four runs on five hits and a walk while fanning two. The Riders finished off their scoring in the top of the eighth inning where Mieses mashed his second homer of the night. **Jackson Kelley** worked a scoreless eighth inning before handing the ball to **Larson Kindreich** who allowed one run on one hit and two walks while striking out one. Offensively, each of the nine starters for Frisco collected at least one hit as seven different players recorded multi-hit games. The 15 runs, 20 hits and six homers each set new season highs for the Riders.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Riders infielder **Max Acosta** has been en fuego at the plate, hitting .341 (59-for-173)/.404/.526/.930 over his last 44 games. Since July 10th, in those last 44 games, he is second in the league in average (.341) and fifth in OPS (.930). In his last 31 games, he is hitting .363 (45-for-124)/.430/.565/.995. He has hits in 12 of his last 13 games, batting .449/.550/.796/1.346. Acosta now has a career-best in all slashline categories and is one of five qualified players in the Texas League this year who is 21-year-old or younger.

CHASING RECORDS:

The RoughRiders are within reach of the franchise record for the best winning percentage (.607, 2007). The Riders need to finish 2-0 in their last two games to get the winning percentage record. On the pitching side, they are on pace to allow the fewest hits in a full season (not including the 119-game 2021 season), with 1,036 and the lowest batting average against in a full season (.231).

HATCHIN HOMERS:

Josh Hatcher has been one of the hotter hitters in the Texas League recently, batting .325/.384/.475/.859 over his last 40 games with nine doubles, four home runs and 22 RBIs. In his last 13 games, he is hitting .340 (18-for-53)/.386/.547/.933 with five doubles, two home runs, eight RBIs, seven runs scored.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 46 games, Ortiz is hitting .303/.399/.554/.953 with nine doubles, 11 home runs, 33 RBIs, 33 runs scored and 27 walks. Since July 10th, in those 45 games, he is fourth in average (.303), first in OPS (.953), tied for fourth in RBIs (33) and fourth in home runs (11). In his last 27 games, he is batting .337 (34-for-101)/.451/.644/1.095 with five doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBIs, 20 walks, 23 strikeouts and 23 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .291 with an .908 OPS, raising his batting average to .234 and a .732 OPS.

HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 33 home runs in the last 25 games, with those 33 home runs being second in the Texas League over the last 25 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 109 across their 136 games.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders were fantastic at home this year, going 44-24 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco had a +69 run differential, a 3.88 ERA and is averaging 5.2 runs per game with a .743 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 38-30 with a 3.55 ERA, but a +33 run differential while averaging 4.3 runs per game and owning a .681 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 14 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .303/.392/.524/.916 at home.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

-From 2017 through 2021, Chi spent four seasons with Industriales de La Habana of the Cuban National Series. Went 12-11 with a 3.74 ERA. Had 137 K/93 BB over 51 games with 33 starts.

-Chi left the Cuban National Team in Oct. 2021 following the U-23 World Baseball Championship in Obregón, Mexico where he posted a 1-2 record, 4.45 ERA and 11 strikeouts.

-MLB Commissioner's Office declared Chi a free agent in January of 2022.

2024 SEASON

-After starting in High-A Hickory, joined the Riders for one game in April. Returned to Frisco for good in May.

-In best outing of the season, struck out a career-best tying seven over 4.0 innings against Tulsa on July 25th.
