TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a nine-game road trip out of the All-Star break with a six-game set at Erie.

LAST TIME OUT: Bubba Chandler struck out 7 in 4.2 innings, but Altoona dropped a 5-1 decision on Saturday at Erie.

A TRIP TO FORGET: Coming out of the All-Star break, Altoona has dropped 7-of-8 games on their road trip to Somerset and Erie. Offense has been the main culprit with the team averaging just 2.4 runs per game and batting 169 with runners in scoring position

BUBBA'S BURGERS: Bubba Chandler has hit his stride since returning from the injured list on May 29. Chandler has walked just 8 batters in 48.2 IP with 57 strikeouts, recording a 4-4 record with a 2.96 ERA (16 ER / 48.2 IP) with a 0.86 WHIP. Since June 21, he ranks 2nd in the Eastern League in BAA (.253), 2nd in WHIP (0.70), 7th in IP (33.0) and 3rd in strikeouts (40). Chandler has struck out at least 7 batters in 5 of

THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS: Righty Thomas Harrington has emerged as one of Double-A's best pitchers in the month of June. He leads all Double-A hurlers in ERA (0.70) and strikeouts (32), he's allowed just two runs in 25.2 innings this month. Harrington has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 11-of-13 outings with Altoona this year and his 57 strikeouts since June 1 are T-2nd-most by a Double-A pitcher pitcher.

WILL TAKE (AT LEAST) TEN PUNCHIES: The Curve are one of five teams in the affiliated minors and the only Double-A team to have three different pitchers (Thomas Harrington, Bubba Chandler and Braxton Ashcraft) strike out at least 11 batters in a game. The Curve are one of nine teams in the affiliated minors, one of two at Double-A (Binghamton) to have at least six 10-K games this season. The six 10-strikeout games this season are the most in a single-season in franchise history (35 total in first 24 years of the franchise).

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as of late. Chen has allowed one run or fewer 7 times in his last 11 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.13 ERA (16 ER / 67.2 IP) with 55 strikeouts.

THREE OUTS FOR THE PRICE OF ONE PITCH: For the third time in Altoona's franchise history, first since 2010 by Chase d'Arnaud, the Curve turned a triple play on Wednesday, July 24 at Erie. With runners on first and second after a walk by Emmanuel Ćhapman and an error com-mitted by Charles McAdoo, Erie's Julio Rodriguez hit a hard ground ball to third where McAdoo picked it up, touched third base and then threw to second where Kervin Pichardo made the quick turn for the triple play.

HE WILL McADOO: Infielder Charles McAdoo, one of the top hitters in the Pirates minor league system this year has solidified the middle of The Order for the Curve since his promotion on June 22. McAdoo has reached base safety in 21-of-26 games since joining the Curve with 7 multi-hit games, batting .280/.360/.510/.870 with 6 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 11 RBI, 13 BB, and 26 K. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (103), 2B (21), RBI (63), T-3rd in SB (17), and 2nd in OPS (.947), min. 150 PA's in minor leagues.

SOME NEW FACES: Coming out of the All-Star break, the Curve added two more key pieces from High-A Greensboro in INF/C Nick Cimillo and LHP Hunter Barco. Cimillo batted .293/.419/.619/1.038 OPS with 8 2B, 17 HR and 48 RBI in 52 games with the Grasshoppers this year. His 17 HR led the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion and ranked T-2nd with teammate Shaun Ross in all of High-A. Barco wen 4-1 with a 3.34 ERA in 16G/14 starts at High-A this season. In 62.0 IP, he allowed just 46 hits, 22 walks and struck out 77.

A BIG ADDITION: Utilityman Yoyner Fajardo reached base safely in 23 straight games from June 13-July 13, during which he batted .360/.446/.419 with 5 2B, 6 RBI, 13 BB, 10-11 SB. Since June 1, his .297 batting average is 12th in the Eastern League and his .397 on-base percentage ranks 7th in the circuit. Fajardo's on-base streak was the 3rd-longest by an Eastern League player this season.

QUITE A START: From June 21-July 11 (18 games) Altoona starters have been the backbone of the team's success, 9 times in the 18 game Stretch, a Curve starter threw a quality start (6.0 IP+ and 3 ER or fewer) with 7 outings lasting 7.0 innings or longer. Altoona's 3.26 ERA since June 21 was 5th-best among Double-A teams. Curve starters went 8-5 with a 2.64 ERA (30 ER / 102.1 IP) allowing 70 hits, 28 walks (0.96 WHIP) and 97 strikeouts from June 21-July 11.

THE 'WOLVES OF THE SEA: Gabe Alvarez helms the SeaWolves for a third straight year, after leading them to an Eastern League Championship in 2023 where they defeated Somerset. Top Tigers prospects on their roster according to MLB Pipleline include: No. 1 RHP Jackson Jobe (IL), No. 10 RHP Troy Melton, No. 13 INF Hao-Yu Lee, No. 27 RHP Tyler Mattison and OF No. 30 Trei Cruz.

THE FIRST HOWLER: Troy Melton makes his second start of the series today. Melton was Detroit's 4th round pick in 2022 out of San Diego State where he was collegiate teammates with Pirates farmhands Mike Jarvis and Wyatt Hendrie. He was the Mountain West's Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2022 and he shared the award with Air Force's Paul Skenes. Melton has a 4.64 ERA through 17 starts this season for the 'Wolves, he allowed 3 runs in 5.0 innings against the Curve on Tuesday. Melton's father, Charles, played college soccer at the University of Arizona and growing up in the Anaheim-area, he told SDSU Sports Information that his favorite athlete while growing up was Mike Trout.
