INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Seth Beer became just the ninth Indians batter in franchise history to hit three home runs in a single game as Indianapolis slugged its way to a 13-6 series-opening victory over the Iowa Cubs on Tuesday night at Principal Park. After the Indians took a 2-0 lead in the top of the first inning, Seth Beer launched his first long ball of the night in the second to erase a leadoff shot by Owen Caissie. The game quickly was knotted at three runs apiece, with the I-Cubs scoring in each of their first three frames. Beer's second blast in the fourth broke the tie for good. Jake Lamb followed in the fifth, cashing in back-to-back leadoff singles by Alike Williams and Ji Hwan Bae with a three-run shot over the wall in left-center field to extend the lead to 7-3. Iowa inched back with one run in the bottom of the fifth, but a two-run single by Henry Davis highlighted the Indians second of three consecutive three-run frames in the top of the sixth. Following back-to-back free bases to kick off the seventh, Beer clinched his three-homer performance with a long ball to center field, capping the scoring for the Indians.

THREE BEERS, PLEASE: Seth Beer made history last night, becoming the ninth Indians batter in franchise history and the second in the Victory Field era to hit three home runs in a single game. Beer, who went 4-for-5 with four runs, three homers and five RBI in the statement victory, is the first Indian to log a three-homer game since Micah Franklin on Sept. 1, 2001, vs. Toledo, and the first to do so on the road since Willie Greene on Aug. 22, 1995, at Omaha. The feat ties his career high in homers, following his first three-homer game on Sept. 1, 2023, with Double-A Amarillo vs. Midland. He also tied his career highs in runs (last: Sept. 2, 2021, with Triple-A Reno vs. Tacoma) and RBI (also: Aug. 23, 2018, with High-A Buies Creek at Carolina). Beer has now hit safely in each of his last seven games, drove in an RBI in each of his last four and homered in his last two.

RAKE LAMB: Jake Lamb joined Seth Beer's tear last night, launching a three-run homer in the fifth inning as the first of three consecutive three-hit frames for the Indians offense. It was his second homer in four games since driving in two on a dinger on Friday at Omaha. Lamb now has six homers with the Indians this season, three of which came in his first 18 games. Making up for the lack of the long ball has been Lamb's ability to put the ball in play and get on base, drawing 31 walks to only 57 strikeouts in 286 plate appearances. In total, he is hitting .282 (69-for-245) with 15 doubles and 39 RBI in 69 games with Indianapolis.

GERMÁN GOES FOR FIVE: Domingo Germán extended his winning streak to five games since June 18 with 5.0 innings, four runs allowed and six strikeouts to defeat the I-Cubs. He was backed by the Indians offensive outpouring of 13 runs on 15 hits. He has now tossed at least 5.0 innings in nine of 11 starts with Indianapolis. During his winning streak, he has a 4.40 ERA (15er/30.2ip) and 31 strikeouts with two-or-less runs allowed in four of those six starts.

TODAY: The Indians continue a nine-game road trip with a six-game series at Iowa beginning tonight at 7:38 PM ET. The Indians mashed at Principal Park over six games in May, launching a staggering 14 home runs (see below). In 13 total games vs. Iowa, the Indians are 8-5 after winning a six-game set at Victory Field from June 18-23. Continuing the six-game set for Indianapolis today is LHP Bailey Falter (0-0, --), who is making his first start of a rehab assignment with the Indians. Countering for the I-Cubs is RHP Dan Straily (1-6, 4.88), who is 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA (6er/9.0ip) and six strikeouts against Indy in two starts this season.

MASHING VS. THE I-CUBS: The Indians have launched 21 of their 86 home runs in 13 total games against the Iowa Cubs, their most home runs against a single opponent this season. Fourteen of those home runs came during a six-game series at Principal Park from May 21-26, with the Indians launching a season-high six long balls on May 23. Including last night's four-homer outburst, three of the Indians four games with four-plus home runs this season have come against the I-Cubs. Individually, Matt Gorski leads the pack with five homers in 12 games against Iowa. Below is a list of the hottest Indians hitters against the I-Cubs and their stats.

NO FALTERING: The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that left-handed starting pitcher Bailey Falter will begin a rehab assignment as the Indianapolis Indians starting pitcher at Principal Park, home of the Iowa Cubs, today at 1:08 PM ET. The 27-year-old was placed on the 15-day injured list on July 7 with left triceps tendinitis. He began the season on Pittsburgh's Opening Day roster and went 4-7 with a 4.08 ERA (41er/90.1ip) and 61 strikeouts in 17 games (17 starts). The southpaw was assigned to Indianapolis after being traded to Pittsburgh from Philadelphia on Aug. 1, 2023, in exchange for infielder Rodolfo Castro, but was recalled prior to making an appearance. He spent part of three seasons with Triple-A Lehigh Valley, going 8-2 with a 2.74 ERA (38er/124.2ip) and 128 strikeouts in 28 appearances (26 starts). Falter was originally selected by the Phillies in the fifth round (144th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Chino Hills (Calif.) High School. He made his MLB debut on April 25, 2021, at Colorado.

THIS DATE IN 1959: Left-hander Gary Peters tossed a no-hitter against Minneapolis at old Victory Field in a 5-0 Indy triumph. He walked five and fanned four batters. It was the fifth no-hitter thrown in franchise history and the first of three tossed by an Indians pitcher in old Victory Field/Bush Stadium. Second baseman Jim Snyder, who later managed the Indians in 1976, saved the no-hit bid with a leaping catch on a line drive for the final out of the game.
