When Saints Score 3 or Less... Saints Get 10+ Hits

ALL HANDS ON DECK: Twins No. 3 prospect Luke Keaschall touched off for his first Triple-A home run and Carson McCusker roped his second game-winning longball in the past three days while the Saints leaned on a bullpen by committee approach to edge the Stormchasers 6-4 on Friday night at CHS Field. All five available Saints bullpen arms combined for a season-high 15 strikeouts on a night when David Festa was originally slated to start, but was called up to pitch for the Twins in Minneapolis. Alex Speas shined in his second appearance for St. Paul, fanning five of six hitters faced and being credited with the winning decision. Kyle Bischoff threw 43 pitches, a career-high for him in a relief outing, and fired two scoreless to close the night. The Saints have now won three straight following a five-game losing skid.

RISP MANAGEMENT: Since going 9-for-20 in their season-opening win with runners in 0-1 in such situations from March 28 against Indianapolis, the Saints hit just .140 (8-for-57) in such situations from March 29-April 10, the worst in the International League and the 2nd-worst in Triple-A in that span. St. Paul broke that trend by going 10-for-28 with runners in scoring position on Thursday and a 1-for-7 on Friday; St. Paul now ranks 9th/20 in the International League in that category, hitting .250 (28-112).

Mccusker Mashing: Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 1st in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the season (see below), averaging 99.3 mph on his batted balls this year. The 6-8 slugger has crushed two game-winning homers, his first two of the season, during the homestand and also tallied a single that was tatooed for an exit velocity of 112.9 mph, the third hardest-hit ball by a Saint so far this season. McCusker now has three of the top-5 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and four of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity in Saints history. Since making his Triple-A debut on August 24 last season, his average exit velo is tops among Saints hitters with at least 25 AB during that stretch (92.0). Now just 31 games into his short Triple-A tenure, he already has seven batted balls registered at 110 mph or harder (three so far this season). 2025 TRIPLE-A LEADERS Avg Evit Velocity (min 10 PA)

NO CHEAP ONES: After producing six "hard hit" balls on Friday night against Omaha, the Saints now rank 6th in the International League in average exit velocity with an 88.7 mph average as a team. In Friday, March 28th's season opener, the Saints lineup produced a season-high 14 "hard-hit" balls and have had at least 6 in 9-of-10 contests so far this year. Carson McCusker (3x), Emmanuel Rodriguez, and Jair Camargo (2x) have all have peaked with exit velocities over 110 mph already this year, all ranking among the top-100 hardest hit balls in the International League this season

GET IN THE GAP, BALL!!: Despite the Saints' eye-popping exit velos (see above), it hasn't necessarily translated to a ton of power yet this season. Before Thursday, the Saints ranked second-to-last in the International League with 15 extra-base hits and 14th/20 in slugging% (.340). After cracking a season-high six extra base hits (all doubles) in Thursday's win and a pair of homers on Friday, the Saints still rank just third-to-last in the IL in XBH (23) and 10th in SLG% (.381). The Saints are tied with Rochester and Syracuse for the fewest home runs in the league (5) even after hitting four out of the ballpark the past three games entering Saturday. The Saints are 5th-to-last in the IL in runs scored (43) even after Thursday's 13-run outburst. St. Paul had scored just eight runs in their previous six games (1.3/game) before hanging the 13-spot Thursday.

START ME UP: The Saints starting rotation has gotten off to a tremendous start to the year, spinning a 1.83 ERA among starters that ranks first in Triple-A. Saints starters have struck out 42 batters (26% K-rate) against 14 walks (9% BB-rate) in 39.1 innings this year. If you throw out David Festa's rocky outing last Friday in game two of a doubleheader in Columbus (3.1 IP, 5 ER), the Saints starting staff have a 0.75 ERA (3 ER, 36.0 IP). The rotation went off with a bang to start the season when David Festa, Zebby Matthews, and then Andrew Morris all went at least 5.0 shutout in three consecutive starts, the first time in Saints history that three consecutive St. Paul starters have done so (It's only the second time ever that Saints starters did not allowed a run in three consecutive games with the last coming from June 29-July 1, 2023 when Randy Dobnak and Blayne Enlow threw 5.0 shutout in back-to-back games before Dallas Kuechel went 4.1 scoreless the following night, all against Gwinnett).

HOME SWEET HOME: During the past five seasons as a Triple-A club (2021-25), the Saints are fifth in all of Minor League baseball with 167 home wins, trailing only Nashville (182), Bowling Green (175), Durham (174), and Tacoma (170). Their .574 Win% at home is third-best in Triple-A and third in the IL in that span. Last year's 35-38 record was the 1st season the Saints played below .500 at home in 4 years as a Triple-A club.

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints Opening Day roster features nine of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and ten according to Baseball Minimesota's 109-30 prospects according to MLB.com and ten according to Basebaia. America while also touting five of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No 2. MLB.com, No. 2 BA), INF Luke Keaschall (3/3), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Both Rodriguez (19/37) and Keaschall (45/60) rank among the top-100 overall lists of both publications.

LAST APPEARANCE: Fired 5.0 scoreless innings in his Saints debut following a Big League relief outing seven days prior in St. Louis. Worked around traffic in every inning and induced only six swingsand-misses, including three from his sinker and two from the slider. Threw 23 sinkers, 22 sliders, 19 four-search, and 11 changeups. Limited hard contact, allowing just three batted balls in play over 95 mph (all three were outs).

THAT'S MISTER SAINT TO YOU: In 2024, Dobnak eclipsed several single-season pitching records for the Saints franchise. Both Caleb Boushley (134.1) and Dobnak (133.1) exceeded the previous record for innings thrown in a single-season (126.1 by Dobnak in '23), while Dobnak set new single-season franchise marks with 12 wins and 134 strikeouts. Dobnak still holds the single season mark for starts in a season, when he began 33 games on the bump in 2023, four more than Simeon Woods-Richardson's total that same season. Dobnak's 281 Career Strikeouts and 297.2 IP in a St. Paul uniform are both the most in the club's short Triple. A history entering 2025. short Triple-A history entering 2025.

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often fo to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield State.

TWILIGHT SPARKLE, MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBL.

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-ster ratings with the exception one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

NOTE QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019 never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancées in full attire.
