Back on the Road

The Fightin Phils are back on the road to continue a six-game series at the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It is the fifth-of-nine matchups between the teams this season and fifth-of-six at People's Natural Gas Field in Altoona. Following this week, Altoona makes its first trip to Reading since 2023 from July 17-19 for a three-game series out of the All-Star Break. The teams split their lone series in 2025 in Altoona, and the two teams have started the 2026 season series in a 2-2 deadlock.

Fightin' Back Into the Win Column

The Reading Fightin Phils claimed their second consecutive win with a wire-to-wire 9-1 victory on Friday evening. Reading faced early controversy, as Fightin Phils starter Adam Seminaris took a line drive off of his left wrist with one out in the fourth inning. The bullpen came in clutch, combining for 5.2 innings of one-run ball to push this game to the finish line. Phillies' fourth-ranked prospect Aaron Escobar (5) hit a no-doubt three-run home run. Erick Brito and Riley Tirotta each logged three hits on a night where the Fightins put up 14 base knocks in total. Alex Binelas swatted a double to extend his on-base streak to 17 games.

Bryan Gets on Base

With a pair of hits on Thursday night, Bryan Rincon extended his season-best on-base streak to 22 games. The Phillies' 27th ranked prospect's on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phil this season and is the second-longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League amongst players who are still playing for their teams. Rincon's 22-game on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phil since Keaton Anthony had a 25 game on-base streak from May 11-June 10, 2025. It was a streak that never ended as Anthony was promoted to Lehigh Valley (AAA) on June 11, 2025. Rincon got the night off yesterday and will aim to inch closer to Anthony's mark this weekend.

Binelas Bombs Away

Alex Binelas clubbed his team-leading 17th home run of the season on Thursday night, a mark that is third most in the Eastern League entering play on Thursday. Binelas holds a tie for first in homers amongst Phillies Minor Leaguers, as he's knotted up with 2025 Eastern League MVP Felix Reyes.. After hitting nine home runs in April, Binelas was held to just one home run in May. But, since the calendar has turned to June, Binelas has lifted seven home runs, all coming over the last 16 games he's played in. Binelas' single-season career-high in home runs was 25 back in 2022. He hit eight homers over 68 games with Reading in 2025. Binelas is also currently riding a 17-game on-base streak, dating back to June 7, and is slashing .274/.392/.661 (1.053 OPS), along with seven home runs and nine RBI.

Raking Raylin

Phillies 30th-ranked prospect Raylin Heredia posted another impressive performance last night, going 2-for-5 in the win. Heredia also turned in an excellent two-week homestand, which featured his second-career two home run game last Thursday against Hartford. The 22-year old has already hit 12 home runs this season, which is a single-season career-high, surpassing his previous best of eight. Over the 12 games during the homestand, Heredia slashed .319/.373/.681 (1.054 OPS), along with six runs, two doubles, five home runs and nine RBI. Entering play on Thursday, Heredia leads the Eastern League with 21 doubles, while also ranking third with 74 hits, tied for second with 34 extra-base hits and third with 132 total bases.

León Looks Legit!

Pedro León has stormed onto the scene, making an immediate impact since making his Fightin Phils debut on June 12. He is 7-for-19 this series with a home run, a double, three RBI and a pair of walks. The former Houston Astros outfielder is hitting .305 with three home runs, 10 RBI and seven extra base hits in 13 games with Reading thus far.

Going, Going, Gone

The Fightin Phils are back to hitting home runs at a torrid pace, as they have hit a league-best 24 since June 9. Through 72 games, Reading has hit 91 home runs, which ranks as second most in the Eastern League and they are on pace for 172 this season, which comes after Reading hit 118 in 2025.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 27, 2004: At Harrisburg, Ryan Howard goes 3-for-5 with two HR and five RBI for the second straight game, but Reading falls to the Senators, 12-11, in 11 innings. It is Howard's sixth multi-HR game of the year and third in four days. Kevin Barker has his second five-hit game in six days, going 5-for-6 with three doubles, a home run, three RBI and three runs.

Curve Baseball

Altoona finished the season's first half with a 31-38 record, which was fifth in the Eastern League's Southwest Division standings. The Curve started the season 0-12, but since they got their first win on Apr. 16, they went 31-26 over the remainder of the season's first half. Altoona most recently split a six-game series at Akron last week and following this week, head north to Portland. The Curve's roster features four of the Pittsburgh Pirates Top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: Omar Alfonzo (14), Jack Brannigan (22), Duce Gourson (26) and Callan Moss (28).

Altoona's Friday Tone Setter

Right-handed pitcher Peyton Stumbo will toe the rubber for the Curve in game five of this six-game series. Stumbo is 1-5 with a 5.14 earned run average over 14 appearances (13 starts) this season. He was originally a 20th round pick in the 2023 MLB Draft, the same draft class as fellow Pirates pitcher and no. 1 overall pick Paul Skenes. He has profiled as a pitch-to-contact hurler since college, logging 113 punchouts over 132 collegiate innings at Nevada. Stumbo's last outing was on June 21, when he spun 4.1 innings of three-run ball, allowing four hits, walking four and striking out three in a no-decision against the Akron Rubberducks.
