JACKSONVILLE FALLS TO DURHAM 9-5

Home runs by Jerar Encarnacion and Dane Myers were not enough as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp dropped Sunday's contest to the Durham Bulls 9-5 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Durham put up four runs in the first inning and added one in the top of the second to take a 5-0 lead. Encarnacion's first home run came in the second to cut it to a four-run game. The Bulls added a run in the third. Trailing 6-1, the Jumbo Shrimp plated two runs in the bottom of the sixth to make it 6-3 but Durham was able to tally three more runs taking a 9-3 lead. Jacksonville's final runs came in the eighth and ninth as they fell 9-5.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 35 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 37-for-117 (.316/.394/.726/1.120) at the plate with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 29 RBIs and 24 runs scored. With three home runs at home last night, he became the first Jacksonville player since 2010 to homer three times at home and the first Jumbo Shrimp player since 2021 to blast three home runs in a single game.

YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 35-44 record is 17th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-two of the club's 79 games, or 65.8 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is tied for the most in the league with Gwinnett (52). On the flip side, Durham has had a relatively easy schedule. The reigning Triple-A Champs are 10-18 vs. teams with a record above .500, they are 32-19 vs. teams below .500.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Friday's 15-5 win by Durham snapped a five-game stretch in which Jacksonville played games decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 79 games played thus far in 2023, 44 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 21-23 (.477) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer.

APRIL SHOWERS HAVEN'T BROUGHT FLOWERS

Jacksonville finds themselves near the cellar of the International League. After finishing the first month of the season with a 13-12 record, the Jumbo Shrimp haven't found a spark, going 22-31 since May 1. The club posted the sixth-best ERA through the first month of the season at 4.47 in 227.1 innings. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 289 earned runs in 457.0 innings for a 5.69 ERA that ranks 15th in the IL. Offensively, the club is hitting just .248/.334/.408/.742, figures that all rank 19th, 20th, 18th and 20th in the circuit, respectively. Relatedly, the club's 255 runs scored place 19th.

BULL****

Since returning to the International League in 2021, Jacksonville has failed to find an answer on beating the Durham Bulls. Since 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp own a .390 winning percentage against the Bulls, the lowest winning percentage against a team they've faced in multiple series'. Last year, Jacksonville matched up against Durham 24 times, winning just nine contests. This year, the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff owns a 6.29 ERA against Durham while the Bulls have posted a 3.69 ERA, allowing just 75 runs in 148.2 innings. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 114-75, an average of 6.7 runs/game to 4.4 runs/game.

SERIES 7 CIRCUIT

After falling in the first two games of their series at Memphis on May 2-3, Jacksonville rallied to win the series, taking the final four games. After that, though, the Jumbo Shrimp lost four consecutive sets before finally splitting a pair of series with Nashville and Memphis. After losing four of six at Gwinnett from June 20-25, Jacksonville has gone seven sets without a series win, their longest drought since June 11-August 11, 2015, when they went 12 consecutive series' without a win in what turned out to be a 57-81 (.413) campaign.

SHRIMP BITES

Charles Leblanc has caught fire recently, tying his season-high hitting streak at five. Since 6/22, the Laval, Quebec is 8-for-16 (.500/.600/.563/1.163) with one double and two RBIs. ... Xavier Edwards is hitting .348 with an .827 OPS in his last 22 games.

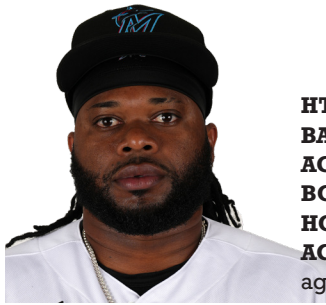

-A two-time All-Star and member of the 2015 World Series champion Kansas City Royals, Cueto has gone 143-108 with a 3.46 ERA over 356 MLB appearances, including 354 starts, in a 16-year career with the Cincinnati Reds, San Francisco Giants, Royals, Chicago White Sox and Marlins.
