Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Columbus Clippers play game two of a six-game series tonight at Huntington Park. Nashville won last night's series opener, 8-2, behind three home runs and solid performance by Wade LeBlanc. Tonight, left-hander Blaine Hardy starts for Nashville against right-hander Kevin Herget for Columbus.

Blaine Hardy: 34-year-old Blaine Hardy makes his third start of the season and fifth appearance overall. Hardy is 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA in 11.1 innings. He has allowed 4 runs on 8 hits and 4 walks to go along with 13 strikeouts. The last time out, Hardy went 1.0 inning out of the bullpen against Gwinnett on May 23. The left-hander went 1-1 with a 4.47 ERA in 39 games with Detroit in 2019. He spent nearly three weeks on the injured list from April 22-May 10 with a left forearm strain and was placed on the 60-day injured list on August 8 with a left elbow injury.

Kevin Herget: 30-year-old Kevin Herget gets the ball for the Clippers in game two of the series. The right-hander is making his 2021 debut after being signed to a minor league deal by Cleveland just yesterday. Herget last pitched in 2019 when he was with the St. Louis Cardinals organization. He only appeared in two games for the GCL Cardinals after spending majority of the season on the injured list. In 2018 he went 9-11 with a 4.61 ERA in 28 games (22 starts) with Triple-A Memphis. Herget was a 39th round pick by St. Louis in the 2013 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 1, Second: 5, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

First Place Sounds: For the first time in the 2021 season the Nashville Sounds sit in first place in the Triple-A East Southeast Division. Nashville surpassed Jacksonville with its win and Jacksonville's loss last night. The Sounds are a half-game ahead of both Jacksonville and Durham who are both 13-6.

LeBlanc's Quality Outing: Last night's starter Wade LeBlanc accomplished two feats a Nashville pitcher had not yet done in 2021. The southpaw is the first Nashville starter to log a quality start and he's the first to go to at least 6.0 innings.

On a Roll: Nashville's 7-game winning streak is their longest the club has had in nearly three years and is also tied for the longest active winning streak in Minor League Baseball. The Double-A Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees) have also won seven straight games. The last time a Sounds team won six or more games was the 15-game winning streak that matched a franchise record from July 29-August 14, 2018.

Pitching In: Since Nashville allowed eight runs to Gwinnett in a 9-8 win on May 18, the pitching staff has been on a roll. In the six games since, Nashville hurlers have posted a 1.47 ERA (9 ER/55.0 IP). In the 55.0 innings, they have yielded only 26 hits and 19 walks to go along with 55 strikeouts.

Clutch Long Ball: Out of the 27 total home runs the Sounds have hit, 11 of them have been game-tying or go-ahead homers. Keston Hiura's go-ahead homer in the second inning of Sunday's game held up in the 1-0 win.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

Top Prospects: Nashville opened the 2021 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 5 prospect, left-handed pitcher Aaron Ashby is the No. 7 prospect, outfielder Corey Ray is the No. 24 prospect and left-handed pitcher Clayton Andrews is the No. 25 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,040-1,926. The 2,040 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 2019 the Sounds collected 16 hits on their way to a 9-5 win over the Round Rock Express. Matt Davidson, Hunter Cole and Jett Bandy hit home runs. Jose Altuve, Kyle Tucker and Yordan Alvarez were in the Round Rock lineup.
